## **Consideration for the ARPA Grassroots Grant Funds**

Hunter Safrit was the facilitator for the ARPA Grassroots Grant panel that met on March 13, 2023. The panel consisted of Cheryl Goins, Ed Hull, Charlton Jackson, Cindy Morgan, and RAC Board Rep. Emily Perry. Safrit reported there were nine grant applications received. The panel spoke to each applicant/organization and reviewed their application prior to the panel meeting. Each panelist then presented the information from each application during the panel meeting.

2022-23 ARPA Grassroots Grant Funds recommendations are as follows:

Center for Faith & the Arts - \$4,792 Downtown Salisbury, Inc. - \$7,625 NC Museum of Dolls & Toys, & Miniatures - \$4,791 Happy Roots - \$5,500 Right Brain 2 - \$4,792 Town of Spencer - \$4,426 Lee Street Theatre - \$7,000 Piedmont Players, Inc - \$7,000 Salisbury Symphony Orchestra - \$7,000 Waterworks Visual Arts Center - \$7,000 The remaining \$10,000 was allocated to Rowan Arts Council to be utilized in the Arts & Cultural Development Grants.

A recommendation to approve the distribution came as a motion from the ARPA Grassroots Grant Panel and seconded by Dan Mikkelson.
