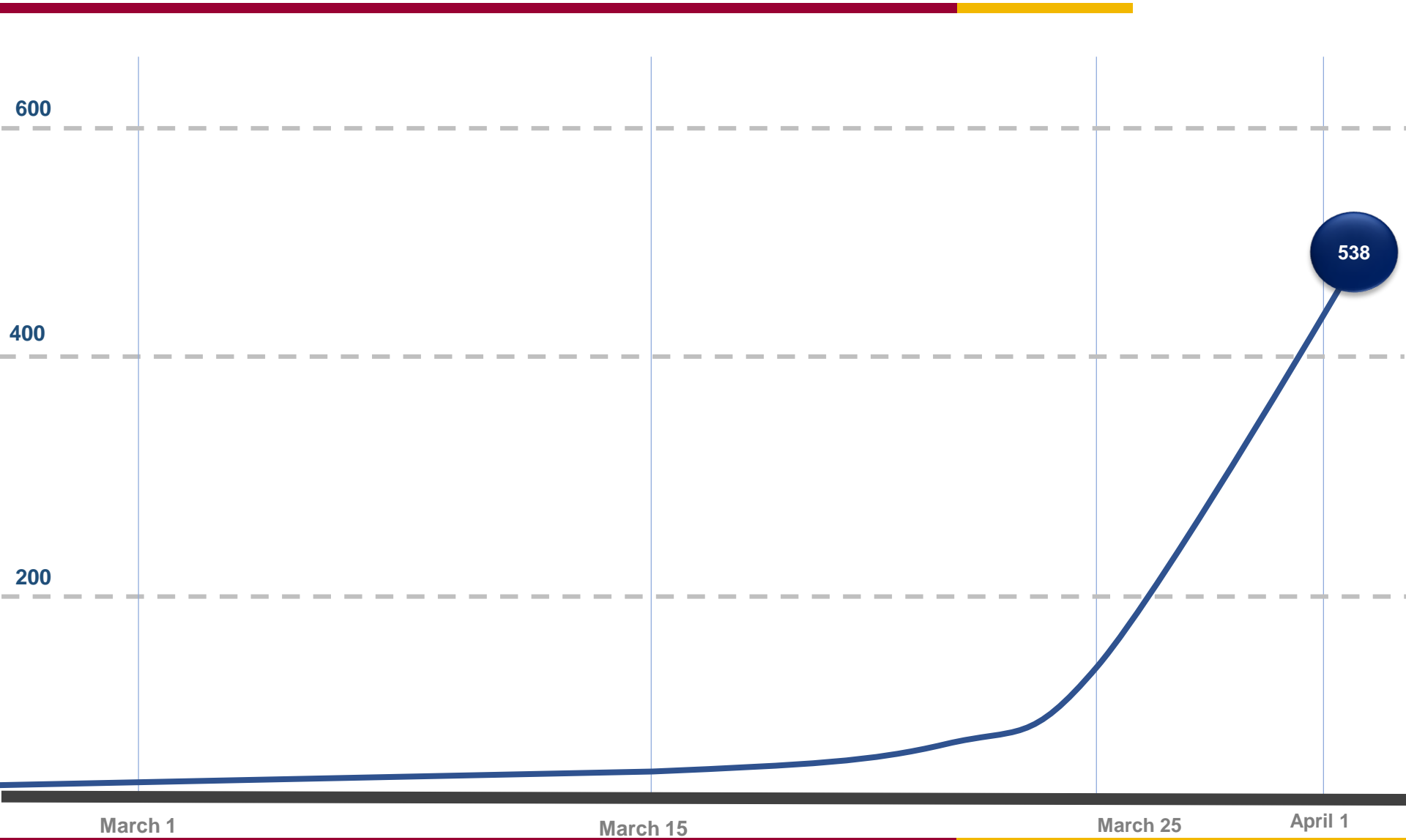
About Salt Lake County Intelligence Section

- Supports Salt Lake County Unified Command in making **evidence-based decisions** through research, data collection, modeling, and analysis of trends.
- While national trends are considered, Intelligence Section developed a **local model** informed Salt Lake County communities, case rate increase, doubling rates, and other Salt Lake County-centric data sets.
- Salt Lake County's significance as home of the state's medical system and its economic heart are also recognized when modeling and analyzing COVID-19's impact.
- Intelligence Section **collaborates daily with state, medical system, public and private sector partners** to ensure that intelligence products help others develop action plans to **mitigate COVID-19's impact across Salt Lake County** and the State of Utah.

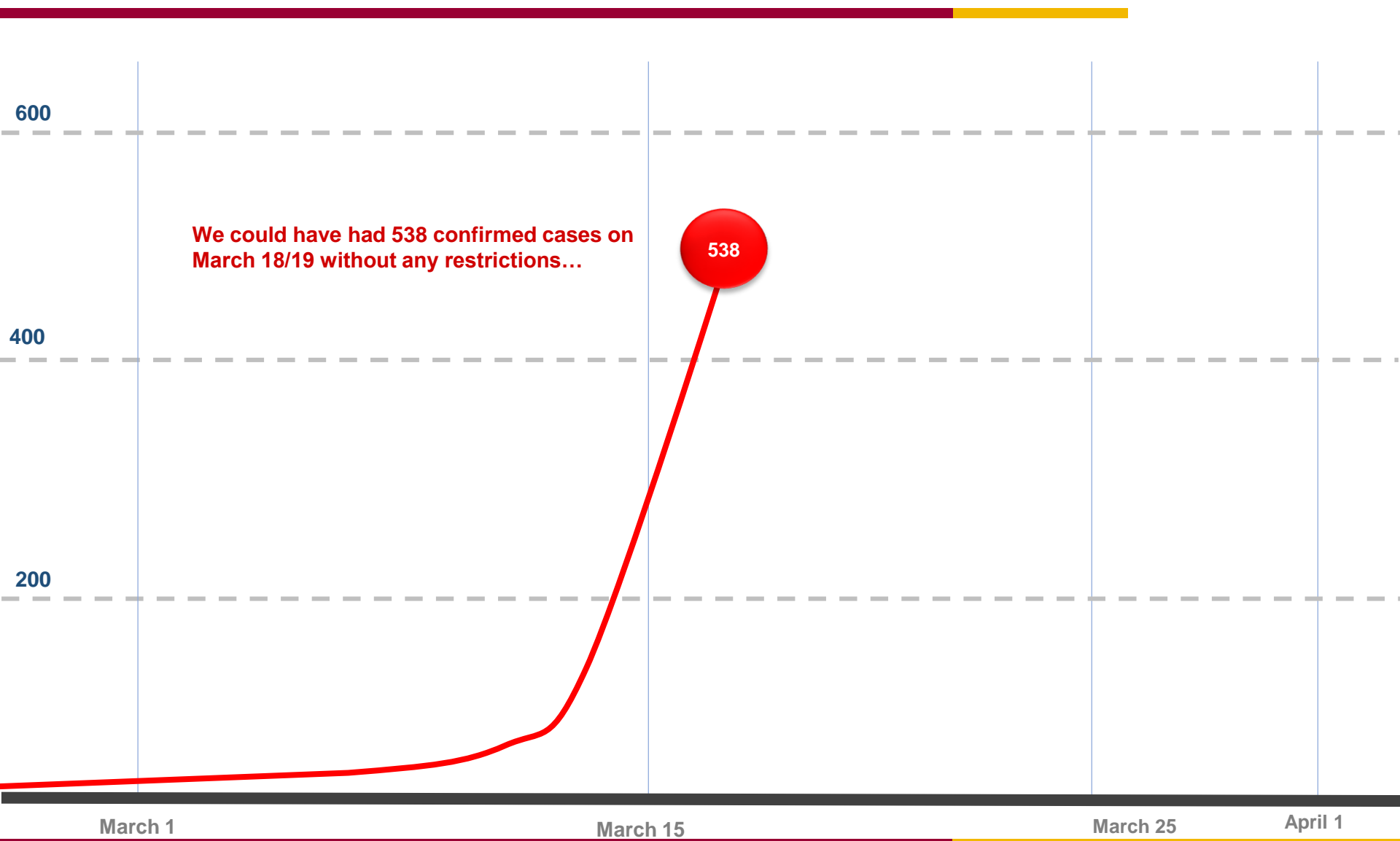
Salt Lake County's Modeling Efforts

- Due to the characteristics of novel coronavirus and COVID-19, forecasting is a challenge requiring a **daily re-assessment**. The numbers are not static.
- **Localized outbreaks and mitigation efforts** affect the glide path of the epidemic curve.
- Key components of modeling include:
 - Number of new confirmed cases
 - Case rate increase
 - Doubling rate
 - Testing efforts and contact tracing important factors in understanding span of COVID-19 across any community
- Intelligence Section and their partners develop and analyze models daily to ensure that **policy-level decisions are informed by evidence**.

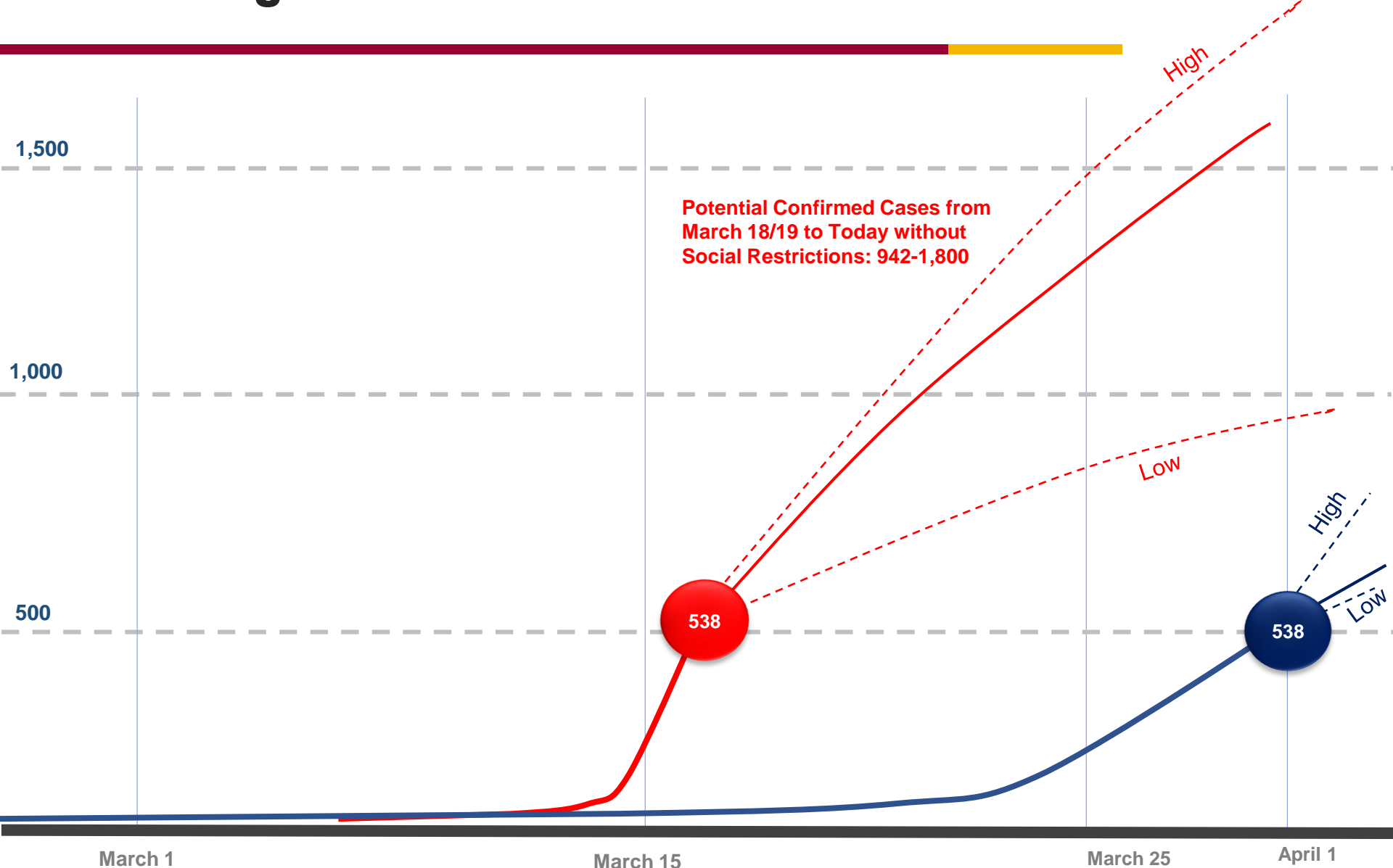
Where Salt Lake County is Along the Curve of Total Confirmed Cases
