Park Projects Update

ARENA AND RACETRACK FOOTING— The RFP is expected to be issued soon. The soil analysis has been completed and the contract is expected to be issued by the end of July. Work schedule will depend on events days—The indoor arena is booked until October, but will begin work immediately after the last event.

STORM DRAIN— All of the maintenance work on the existing storm drains throughout the Park has been completed. Salt Lake County Public Works has re-graded the entire property. Construction bid is expected in July with the bid expected to be awarded by August. The expanded storm drain installation could begin in September.

RV PARKING— The storm drain project has to be completed before the Park can move forward on further design work for the RV parking area.

RESTROOM / SHOWER BUILDING— The Kennel Association has donated \$25,000 towards this project. Architectural Nexus suggested siting the building either inside the covered arena or on the north side of the proposed RV parking area. After consideration, the indoor covered arena site was selected. The architectural firm is finalizing the floor plan and the cost estimate.

400—600 BARN PROJECT— The removal and replacement of metal stalls in the 400 – 600 barns awaits the completion of the gutter and downspout project. Cost of the material has been submitted and the project has been approved. Schedule TBD.

BARNS A—D— Architectural Nexus has studied two options for this project: removal or replacement. They have also added for consideration a pre-fab barn option. All options are under review.

SOUND SYSTEM UPGRADE— Components should be installed in the covered arena and the 700-900 barns by the end of July.

PANEL UPGRADE— Two vendors have been selected for the project: IFA and Steve Regan. Staff has identified areas where upgrades are needed. Delivery is expected soon.
