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Join Andreotti Family Farms at their First-Ever "Farm to Table Lunch" Fundraiser

Proceeds will help rebuild the historic barn that was destroyed by fire in February

Burlingame, CA - On October 23-24, 2021, <u>Andreotti Family Farms</u> will host their first-ever <u>"Farm to Table Lunch,"</u> which will raise funds for their historic barn that was destroyed by fire earlier this year. The Andreotti family has farmed on their Half Moon Bay property since 1926. The San Mateo County/Silicon Valley Convention & Visitors Bureau is proud to be sponsoring the keepsake glassware for the event.

In February, the fire destroyed not only the structure but also the farm's dry crops and heritage seeds. All proceeds from the weekend event will go to rebuilding the historic 150+ year-old barn.

"We are touched by the outpouring of support from our community since the fire and for the four generations that our family has been stewards of this land," said Dawn Dillman of Andreotti Family Farms. "The barn meant the world to us, but we also know that so many in this community have memories of the landmark and we are going to bring it back, better and stronger."

Attendees will enjoy an elegant, three-course lunch served by <u>California Girl Catering</u>, featuring produce directly from the farm, wine offerings from <u>Barterra Winery</u>, Beer from S27 Brewery, and Farm to Table Libations from bar consultant and master mixologist @crazybarlady.

"We are honored to support the fundraising efforts of the Andreotti Family, which is just one example of our county's rich agricultural history," said John Hutar, President and CEO of the San Mateo County/Silicon Valley Convention & Visitors Bureau. "Our area farmers are the reason we can proudly say San Mateo County is as fresh as it gets and our local products are a huge part of the community."

The fundraising event at Andreotti's Living Dining Room at 800 Cabrillo Hwy North in Half Moon Bay, will start at 12:00 p.m. each day, followed by a welcome and farm introduction by The Farmer's Wife. The first course will be served at 12:45 p.m., with the event concluding at 3:00 p.m.

Tickets are <u>available now</u> and start at \$100 per single seat at the table, \$900 for a whole table with ten seats and \$1,200 for a whole table with drink tickets. Tickets must be purchased before midnight October 18, 2021, however, donations to the recovery effort can be made at any time on their <u>GoFundMe</u> page.
