California's Stages of Reopening:

- **Phase I** – Current Shelter in Place Order – focus is on medical crisis; building out testing and tracing systems. Only essential services are allowed (grocery stores, pharmacies, take-out food, etc.)
- **Phase II** – Lower risk businesses and public spaces can re-open with modifications to allow for social distancing. Factories, non-grocery retail stores via curbside pick-up, schools and childcare facilities.
- **Phase III** – Higher risk businesses can re-open with modifications. Nail and hair salons, gyms, movie theaters, sports without live audiences, in-person religious services.
- **Phase IV** – Ends the Stay at Home Order. Concerts, conventions, sports with live audiences will be allowed to open.

- The Public Health Department makes the following recommendations for sanitizing hotel/motel rooms:
 - After checkout, all rooms should be left vacant for at least 24 hours before cleaning begins.
 - Cleaning should be conducted in accordance with CDC recommendations.
 - Upon cleaning, all outside doors and windows should be opened to increase air circulation.
 - Cleaning should be provided by regular cleaning staff wearing gown and gloves. If gowns are not available, coveralls, aprons or work uniforms can be worn during cleaning and disinfecting. Reusable (washable) clothing should be laundered afterwards. Clean hands after handling dirty laundry.
 - Staff should perform hand hygiene after cleaning.
- **Gatherings and Events:** (*Effective 5/4*), "All public and private gatherings of any number of people occurring outside a single household or living unit are prohibited, except for the limited purposes expressly permitted in this Order." Shelter in Place Order:
