## ONLY-IN-SANTA FE ATTRACTIONS

### THE SANTA FE PLAZA

The heart of downtown Santa Fe for more than 400 years, the Plaza hosts art markets, community gatherings, concerts and more.

### CANYON ROAD

One of Santa Fe's oldest roads, Canyon Road packs more than 80 galleries along a half-mile stretch.

### PALACE OF THE GOVERNORS

Built by the Spanish as a government building in 1610, the Palace remains the country's oldest continuously occupied public building and serves as a history museum.

### GEORGIA O'KEEFE MUSEUM

The Georgia O'Keeffe Museum is the single largest repository of O'Keeffe's work in the world.

### THE RAILYARD

Once a stop along the famed Burlington Santa Fe Railroad, The Railyard is now one of Santa Fe's premier mixed-use areas with contemporary galleries, live performances, retail shopping and innovative dining.

### THE SANTA FE OPERA

World-renown productions take place at the Opera's famed outdoor theater with breathtaking 360-degree vistas.

### MUSEUM HILL

Museum Hill is home to four of Santa Fe's marquee museums: The Museum of Indian Arts and Culture, the Wheelwright Museum of the American Indian, The Museum of Spanish Colonial Arts, and The Museum of International Folk Art.

### MEOW WOLF

The Meow Wolf Art Complex is home to Meow Wolf's first permanent installation, *House of Eternal Return*.

## MEETING SPACES

The Santa Fe Community Convention Center is a highly-adaptable, LEED-certified, state-of-the-art facility. The center boasts more than 40,000 square feet of indoor/outdoor meeting areas, fireplaces in communal areas, 500 underground parking spaces, an open interior courtyard, wireless connectivity and high-speed data lines, all flexible enough to satisfy your meeting needs. Area hotels, museums and restaurants also offer a range of meeting venues from intimate meeting spaces to large-scale ballrooms, certain to fit every aesthetic and every price range.

## HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Santa Fe offers 5,600 sleeping rooms per night, with approximately 2,000 within a five-block radius of the downtown convention center. From historic, four-star hotels to branded national properties to cozy bed-and-breakfasts, Santa Fe offers a full spectrum of accommodations to fit every preference and budget.

## EASY ACCESS

### THE ALBUQUERQUE INTERNATIONAL SUNPORT

A 65-mile drive, train or shuttle ride to Santa Fe, the Sunport offers nonstop service to 22 cities on six major commercial carriers. The Santa Fe Pick-Up provides free shuttle service to Santa Fe's most popular locations, including the Railrunner Express train, Canyon Road, the Plaza and the convention center.

### THE SANTA FE REGIONAL AIRPORT

Fly directly into Santa Fe aboard American from Dallas / Fort Worth and Phoenix or fly nonstop jet service from Denver aboard United.

Rental car service is available at both airports.
