

With attractions including naturally carbonated mineral spas, harness racing, 15 golf courses around the county, 10 historic museums, and an award-winning downtown, it's no wonder Saratoga Springs is a nationally recognized destination. There's something to enjoy for everyone—including, of course, America's oldest and most popular thoroughbred race course that attracts over 1 million people during the summer season.

Where can you park?

Saratoga is a bustling city with a steady stream of visitors and locals driving downtown to experience the best dining, shopping and events. Parking garages, parking lots and ample street parking options are conveniently located throughout downtown Saratoga.

What about transportation?

Albany International Airport is 30 minutes south of Saratoga Springs with access to ride sharing, cabs and car rentals. Multiple bus and tour operators have regularly scheduled services throughout New York State and Canada. Capital District Transportation Authority (CDTA) offers direct or connecting services

to Saratoga Springs, Albany, Lake George, Glens Falls, Montreal, Boston and more.

Saratoga Springs is also easily accessible by rail. Amtrak's Albany/Rensselaer station is a 40-minute drive away, and the Saratoga Springs station is located less than two miles from downtown.

Under the direction of the Saratoga Convention & Tourism Bureau, the visitor center offers:

- An information center with city and regional maps, guides, event calendars and informational brochures. The Visitor Center offers wonderful FREE information about Saratoga Springs attractions, restaurants, accommodations, architecture, horse racing, recreation, and self-guided tours of the many historic districts.
- A friendly staff to answer questions, provide referrals, and share a wealth of knowledge. Whether you have two hours, two days, or two weeks, let us help plan your time in Saratoga Springs and the region. If you are new to our community, we can help you find the resources you need to get settled in, and can be your source for information on entertainment, attractions, events and the community.
- An event space for your life and business events. We offer a variety of rental spaces and options for business meetings, seminars, galas, receptions, anniversaries, etc. Stop in to see our space and discuss how our historic building can be yours for a day.
- A shaded outdoor garden area with picnic tables that can accommodate groups - an oasis of greenery in downtown Saratoga.

This space is open to the public and features a beautiful garden maintained by the Heritage Garden Club and is a yearly stop on the Annual Soroptimists Secret Garden Tour each July!

- Educational programs at the Visitor Center and in the community, such as walking tours, school tours and the Brown Bag Lunch Lecture Series.
- The Saratoga Summer Concert Series in Congress Park - held Sundays in July and Tuesdays in August, these free concerts draw thousands of Saratoga Springs residents and visitors and feature a variety of regional musicians. The Summer Concert Series program is free and open to all.
- Gallery space for work by contemporary artists with new exhibits on a regular basis.
- Volunteer opportunities at the Visitor Center and at community events throughout the year.
- Guided walking tours in season. Private tours can be arranged for groups of 10 or more by reservation.
- Step-on Tour Guides available upon request for chartered groups.
- Hosts of the Brown Bag Lunch Lecture Series - A free community educational program that highlights the rich history, culture, and traditions of our city and heritage area. Produced by the Visitor Center in cooperation with the Saratoga Springs Public Library, this program takes place eight times a year.



Q&A with UPH's Teddy Foster

How did Universal Preservation Hall begin and how long have you been involved?

Universal Preservation Hall is a former Methodist Church that was built in 1871. In 1976, the Methodists sold the building to the Universal Baptist Church who occupied it until 2000. At that time, the building had fallen into very bad disrepair, was condemned and slated for demolition. A group of caring citizens raised \$3 million to salvage and save the building, and the nonprofit UPH was formed. I joined the board in 2006. Became Board President in 2009 until I led the campaign beginning in 2015 for the final restoration of the beautiful UPH.

What's the cultural scene like in Saratoga?

The cultural scene in Saratoga is vibrant and with the addition of UPH the city has been elevated to a sought after, year-round cultural destination.

What was it like on opening night after the year and a half renovation?

February 29, 2020 was a most special day with the grand opening of UPH. It was a night of spectacular music by Rosanne Cash and her band. The sound and lighting were perfect and enjoyed by all. For me personally, all I could do

was smile because I was the leader who hung in there for all these years to make it happen. A very proud and joyful evening for me and my family.

How has music impacted your life?

I have always been a lover of music and play the piano. Going to music concerts of all kinds (but especially jazz) is one of my favorite things to do. I am so grateful to be part of the team that brings all kinds of music to a beautiful venue in the heart of downtown.

What kind of music can one expect to hear at UPH?

Jazz, Classical, Americana, Broadway cabaret, Rock, Blues, world music and more. Also, comedy, children's programming & circus.

What makes UPH so special?
