BELMONT STAKES IN SARATOGA: Due to renovations at Belmont Park, the third leg of the Triple Crown has moved to Saratoga Race Course, the oldest continuously operating race track in the country. This is a historic first in the world of thoroughbred racing, as Belmont Park on Long Island has hosted the race for more than a century. A four-day festival will mark the occasion.

HISTORIC & HEALING WATERS: Take a self-guided tasting tour of the 21 public mineral springs that give Saratoga Springs its name. Believed to help aid in digestion, increase appetite and relieve sinus congestion, people drink the water for its healing properties – and soak in it at The Roosevelt Baths.

community connection through music: Saratoga County's vibrant music and entertainment scene is alive in a wide range of venues. Saratoga Performing Arts Center (SPAC) welcomes 25 Live Nation concerts a summer and hosts the Philadelphia Orchestra and New York City Ballet. More intimate performances can be found at Caffe Lena, the longest continuously operating folk music venue in the country, Universal Preservation Hall and Saratoga Opera.

250TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BATTLES OF SARATOGA: Deemed one of the 10 most important battles in world history, the Battles of Saratoga altered the course of the Revolutionary War by shifting momentum to the colonies and therefore, changing the world forever. Visit the Saratoga National Historical Park and walk the path of history, with special events taking place now through 2027, marking the 250th anniversary of the Battles.

UNMATCHED LOCAL CUISINE: Rivaling that of major cities, Saratoga's culinary scene ranges from the simple to the sublime and features flavors from around the world. The endless selection of locally crafted cuisine includes Saratoga candy, crackers, peanut butter, potato chips, olive oil and tea!

FAMILY FRIENDLY: From the Children's Museum at Saratoga, where kids 0 to 10 will have a ball learning about real-life occupations – to Congress Park, with its historic wooden carousel and duck pond, the whole family will find something fun to do in Saratoga! Don't forget a visit to Northshire Books with an entire second floor dedicated to children.

GIRLFRIEND GETAWAY: Saratoga Springs is the perfect destination for a girl's trip or solo bachelorette. Hours can be spent on Broadway shopping at local boutiques with hand-crafted goods and designer products. The popular downtown is also filled with local bars and restaurants featuring tasty, Instagram-worthy cocktails. Cooking classes, yoga, live music and tiki boat tours on Saratoga Lake round out a perfect weekend with the girls.

ART FORMS: The history and the heart of Saratoga can be found in the form of art in every corner of the county. Walk the streets downtown and admire a mural, hand-painted horse or ballet slipper with unique Saratogainspired designs. Stay at the Gideon Putnam and you'll find a Saratogainspired mural on every floor. Drive through the neighborhoods and spot the hand-painted jockeys on people's front lawns.
