

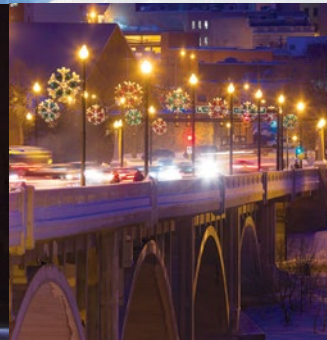

Warhol, Lichtenstein and Koons come to Saskatoon

On October 5, Remai Modern is thrilled to present the largest showing of international modern and contemporary art ever in Saskatchewan. The Sonnabend Collection at Remai Modern features more than 100 pieces by 67 artists, including iconic works by Roy Lichtenstein, Andy Warhol, Jeff Koons and Candida Höfer.

This will be the collection's first exposure in Canada, and its most comprehensive presentation to date in North America. The exhibition traces key developments in art including Pop, Minimalism, Conceptualism, Neo-Geo and more.

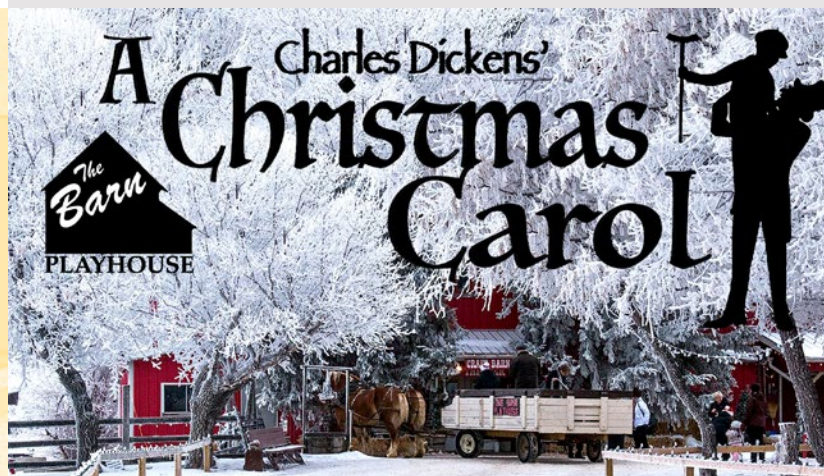
