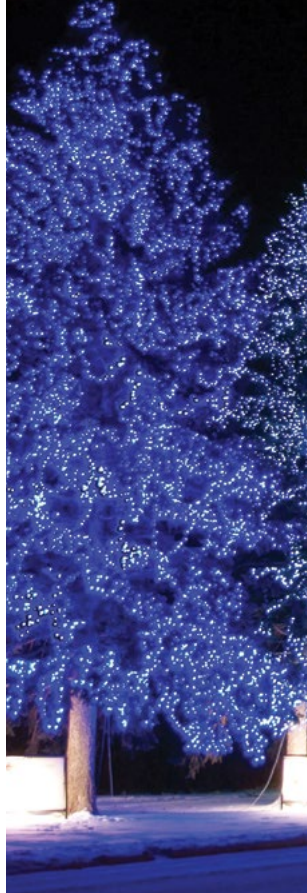

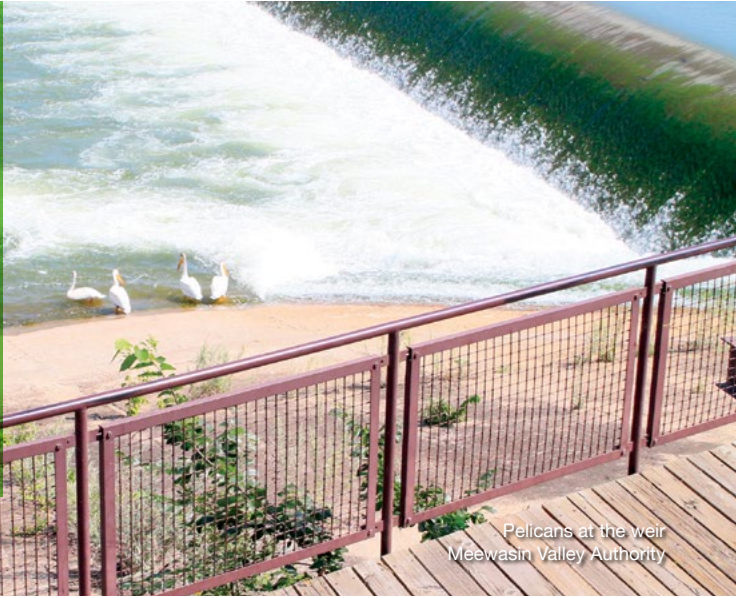

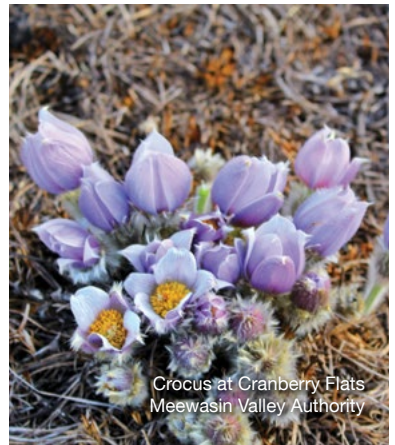

Spring

Spring! The air doesn't hurt your face anymore, the river is back to flowing like a liquid, and the plants and animals begin their return for the warm prairie season. One of the most anticipated arrivals is the American White Pelican, which has been returning from places like California, Mexico and Guatemala since the late 1970s. The Meewasin Riverworks boardwalk is a great place to view these fishing flocks. Get a great 'birds-eye' view of the pelicans and the breathtaking Meewasin Valley from the top of the CPR Train Bridge.

The city begins to bloom alongside one of the first native Saskatchewan flowers, the Prairie Crocuses. Here's a tip: the best places to view these are actually where there has been a disturbance to the earth, such as Meewasin's prescribed burns. These burns help local native wild species by reinvigorating the earth and opening up native prairie for new growth. Check out Cranberry Flats as an example.

Spring also brings the **NatureCity Festival** (May 19 – 24, 2020), which is a week full of activities that focus on the wild side of Saskatoon! From scavenger hunts to outdoor yoga and nature walks – there are tons of ways to get involved and explore the natural areas of Saskatoon.

Summer

There is no better time to experience Saskatoon than in the summer. A city ranked as one of the sunniest in Canada that surrounds a river valley and many kilometers of trails gives great opportunities to go for relaxing walks or runs with stunning views. Afterwards, cool off by wading in the river or grabbing a treat from **Fable Ice Cream** – right off the Meewasin Trail in Victoria Park. If you're looking for a full-on beach day experience, plan a picnic at one of Meewasin's rural beach sites. Check out any of the following between sunrise and sunset: **Fred Heal Canoe Launch, Paradise Beach, and Poplar Bluff Canoe Launch.**

Looking for a wilder side of things to experience this summer? Take a hike through Meewasin's Northeast Swale or Saskatoon Natural Grasslands for the true prairie experience! Both remnant fescue prairie areas of ancient river channels, these ecologically sensitive areas are thriving with native plant species and wildlife. Hint: go at dusk or dawn to catch the most active time for many wildlife species, including majestic deer!



River Landing, near downtown, is another amazing place to spend a summer day with a balance of nature and culture in Saskatoon. **River Landing Spray Park** helps entertain and keep the kids cool while teaching them about the Saskatchewan River Basin. Up for an adventure? **Eco Glide** Segway tours and stand up paddleboard tours from **Escape Sports** are available to book.

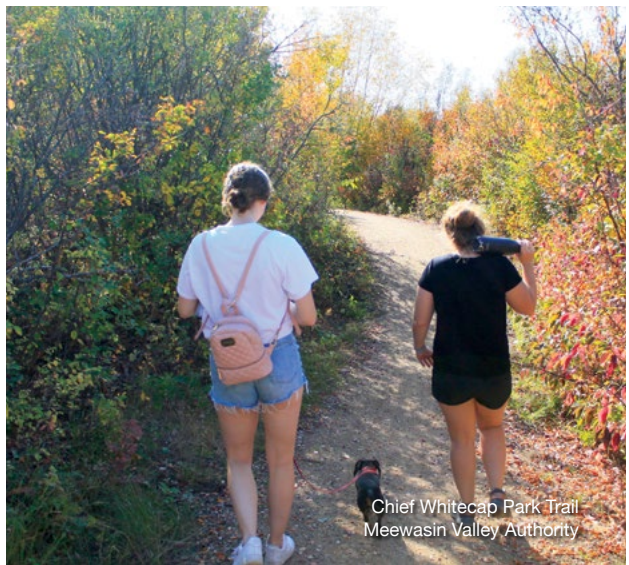

Fall

Hearing the crunch under your feet as you walk, the nostalgic autumn smells and gorgeous sights of leaves changing colour means fall is ahead. What most Saskatchewanians will tell you about the harvest season is that it goes by fast – so enjoy it while it lasts! Areas like the hikes from **Gabriel Dumont Park**, **Diefenbaker Park** and **Chief Whitecap Park** give endless opportunities to branch out and watch the season change before your eyes.

Oftentimes you'll catch sight of paddlers, the **Prairie Lily riverboat**, and the **Shakespeare on the Saskatchewan** site across the river.

There are so many explorations to take, but please remember that all you should take from the sites are pictures, and that you should try to leave your adventure spots in better shape than you found them – don't litter to keep the areas healthy and vibrant!

Winter

Temperatures begin to drop, the frost naturally decorates the leafless trees, and bikers get their 'fat tires' on – the signs that winter is coming. Thankfully, there's still lots to do in Saskatoon in the chilly season. One of our favourites is the skating activities at the **Cameco Meewasin Rink at Nutrien Plaza**, which serves great views of the South Saskatchewan River with a bonfire to keep you warm. Hop across the street to **Scarlet Kitchen in the Sheraton** and indulge in a hot chocolate while you watch the other skaters.

Morning

I awake, and for the first time in 10 years I am well-rested. Despite my vim and vigour, I am still nothing without my morning coffee (even in an alternate universe). **Venn Coffee** is a stone's throw from my house, and they concoct the most perfect oat milk latte (hot or iced). I like it very much, or rather "beary" much! (see right)



My appetite awakens alongside me and I must seek sustenance. Only the best breakfast will do, so I mosey on over to Riversdale and take up a booth at **HomeQuarter Coffeehouse**. There, I am properly rewarded for my morning efforts with 1) more coffee and 2) a roasted vegetable quiche. It's a hearty healthy way for me to tackle my morning and I've got a lot of ground to cover.

From here I decide to take in one of Saskatoon's most popular attractions: the South Saskatchewan River. The river is one of the wonders of our fair city and walking along its banks provides endless views and notable sites. Wander the path at **River Landing** named for one of Saskatoon's most famous residents - Joni Mitchell. Joni spent some of her formative years in Saskatoon. The river served as an inspiration for some of her biggest tunes and one of her most famous paintings, "Clouds". She walked the same stretch of riverbank which has now been named The Joni Mitchell Promenade in her honour.

Afternoon

Feeling so inspired, I make a necessary stop at the **Remai Modern**. Never has an institution brought me so much pride. Here in Saskatoon, we host world-renowned exhibitions of modern art thanks to the Remai Modern. In this contemporary goliath on the banks of the river, legends such as Picasso and Lawren Harris are housed alongside local, emerging, and Indigenous artists. The building itself is a sight to behold. Cantilevered over the river, you get impressive views and spots to reflect. There are as many breathtaking sights inside as there are outside.

Sensing my desire for a tonic, **Three Treasures** appears before me! Just kidding, it's always downtown, but this place definitely has a sort of Room of Requirement vibe (for all you Potter fans). This place is one part hip and happening café blended with two parts chill hang out. They serve up supplements and delicious beverages intended to fill you with health, mirth and happiness. Also, herbal remedies....and acupuncture? I settle up at the bar and read over the menu. I don't just want an elixir, I NEED one. Extra ground ants, please!



Three Treasures

Enlivened, my goal now is to explore history. As much as possible. When you explore history in Saskatoon, there are two places you must go. To explore Saskatoon's pioneering history in the 1900s, head to the **Western Development Museum**. No matter how many times I visit, I am: 1) spooked by life-like mannequins in the full-sized 1910 Boomtown Street re-creation, and 2) blown away by this city's early settlers and their way of life. Blacksmithing looks fun (they do live demos on certain days), but it's not a career I picture myself excelling at. I celebrate my good fortune with some saskatoon berry pie at Boomtown Café, also a charming part of the re-creation.

But I want to go even further back. The richness of Indigenous culture is alive and vibrant in Saskatoon and can be experienced at **Wanuskewin Heritage Park**. 6,000 years of history is brought to life before my eyes. This building is spectacular; the glass roof shaped like a tipi allows the sun to shine through at specific times of day. As I walk into the Opimihaw Valley I can roast bannock over the fire sitting amongst the tipis. The world's longest-running archeological dig is just steps away - there's so much history right at my fingertips! At the amphitheatre, a spectacular jingle dress dancer is sharing the stories of her dance and the tradition behind it. On my way out I take a quick look at Wanuskewin's restaurant menu - bison burgers and Northern Pike tacos with juniper berry coleslaw!

Evening

All this history has worked up an appetite. Luckily, there is no shortage of good eatin' to be found in Saskatoon. Like every day, I'm craving pasta, but unlike any other day, I will eat a good meal and not have to unbutton my pants afterwards (hey a boy can dream, right?). One of my fav spots is **Bar Gusto** on Broadway. There, I can sip a cocktail while practicing (read: butchering) Italian – this menu is *molto bene!* I recommend anything saucy, like a Bolognese or a mushroom risotto. The portions are reasonable, and since I am unreasonable, I suggest getting two. Nothing else is as good a chaser to good pasta like more pasta.

Heading back into the city, I've arranged for another confluence of events. First, I will rock out at the **SaskTel Saskatchewan Jazz Festival**. Located behind the iconic Delta Bessborough Hotel in downtown Saskatoon, this live music festival is one of the highlights of the summer in our city. Then I'll venture to the **Broadway Theatre** and laugh till my sides hurt at the **Saskatoon Soaps Improv** comedy show (starting at 9:30 p.m. on select Friday nights). This brigade of comedians will have you in stitches as they perform sketch after sketch of wildly absurd comedy.

To celebrate my day of bliss, and because I've eaten my weight in pasta, I wander back downtown – this city is so walkable! And guess what. The cat is lit. No euphemism intended, **Parlour Room 306** is a speakeasy in downtown Saskatoon, located above the **St. Tropez Bistro**. In the window facing the street is a neon blue cat and when it's lit, the bar is open. And there, amid the bustling city I love, I raise my glass and cheers the perfect Saskatooning day.

Saskatoon: From Farm to Fork

The breadbasket of Canada lies just minutes beyond Saskatoon's city limits. More than 40 percent of all the farmland in Canada is in Saskatchewan and it is helping to fuel a farm to fork movement that the city has not seen before. The fields are lush with grain, seed, and pulse crops; orchards are bursting with sour cherries, haskaps, apples, sea buckthorn, and yes, the beloved saskatoon berry. Farmers are ethically raising pigs, chickens, cows, and bison on sustainably-managed land. For those of us who love to eat and drink, there has never been a better time to do so in Saskatoon.

6 NOTABLE Farm to Fork Eateries

Hearth

Chefs/owners Beth Rogers and Thayne Robstad opened Hearth in 2018. Their farm-to-table restaurant is a love letter to Saskatchewan, with a menu that leans heavily on local ingredients, some foraged by the couple themselves. Be sure to try the appetizer of wild and cultivated mushrooms with melty cheese and reindeer moss.

Odlá

Farmer Arlie LaRoche owns Odlá along with chef Scott Dicks and sommelier/general manager Lacey Sellinger, and they want to reconnect you with the food you eat. LaRoche raises pastured chickens, pigs, sheep and cattle at Farm One Forty, west of Saskatoon – and the meat from those animals is on Odlá's menu, along with homegrown fruits and vegetables and honey from the apiary.

Primal/The Hollows

Chefs/owners Christie Peters and Kyle Michael bring their love of all things local and enviable culinary skills to a menu that focuses on whole animal butchery and seasonal Italian cuisine. Open since 2015, their pasta is made from Saskatchewan heritage grains. The chefs also own The Hollows, the renowned hyper-local Riversdale restaurant. A horticulturalist is employed to grow vegetables for the restaurants, and they even make their own preserves, tea, and soap.

Calories

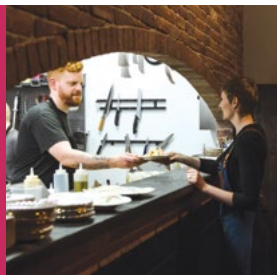
This cozy spot on Broadway has been serving up delectable prairie-inspired cuisine for over three decades. Long before “local” was a culinary buzzword, Calories was sourcing ingredients from local growers and suppliers. They take pride in building their menu around the seasons with an emphasis on real, simple, delicious food. Some of the best desserts in the city can be found in their bake case, so you must save room for something sweet.

Shift

A visit to the stunning Remai Modern is a must for anyone touring Saskatoon. While you're there, have a seat in Shift Restaurant. Co-chefs Jonathan Harris and Suyeon Myeong have created a long list of contemporary Saskatchewan cuisine through their use of homegrown, seasonal ingredients. The chickpea fries with smoked paprika aioli and pan-seared Diefenbaker trout are particularly pleasing.

Ayden Kitchen and Bar

This popular downtown spot from celebrity chef Dale MacKay is an excellent choice for dinner and a hand-crafted cocktail. Globally inspired comfort food using local and seasonal ingredients is their forte with an open kitchen design. MacKay's other ventures include the Italian-inspired Little Grouse on the Prairie and the pan-Asian Sticks and Stones.

Experiential Dining Events

Saskatoon is fortunate to have these unforgettable dinner events that combine education with sensational prairie cuisine.

Wanuskewin Heritage Park

Held monthly from May to September, the Han Wi Moon Dinner is a multi-course meal consisting of foraged wild foods, locally-sourced vegetables and bison, skillfully cooked on a grassy hilltop with stunning sunset views of the South Saskatchewan River and Opimihaw Valley. Executive chef Jenni Lessard prepares the Han Wi Moon Dinners not only as a way to educate guests about the history of Wanuskewin but to take that history and use it in a one-of-a-kind dinner experience that fuses traditional Indigenous cuisine with contemporary culinary techniques.

Farm One Forty

Every August, Farm One Forty and chef Scott Dicks create a signature dining event that is as informative as it is delicious. You'll get the opportunity to stroll out to the pasture to visit the animals, walk through the gardens to see where most of the ingredients that you will eat for supper were grown and harvested and ask questions about food production on the farm. The menu depends on what is available in the garden and the cellar, but you can bet your boots it will be super fresh and memorable. After supper, settle in for a bonfire and musical entertainment.
