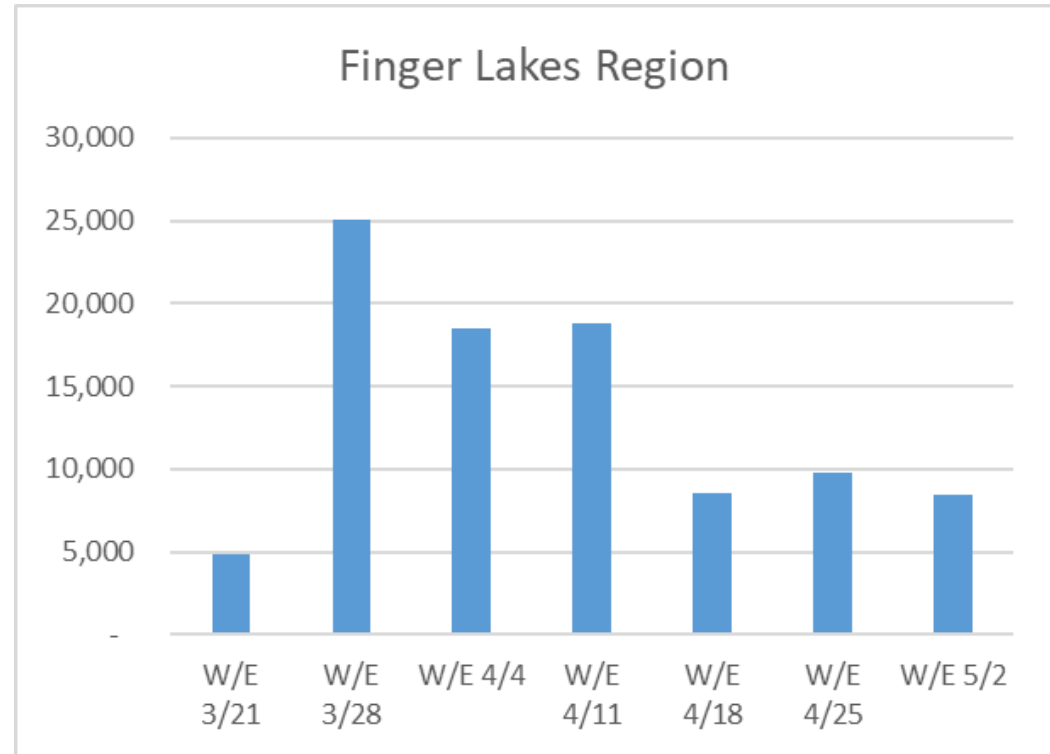
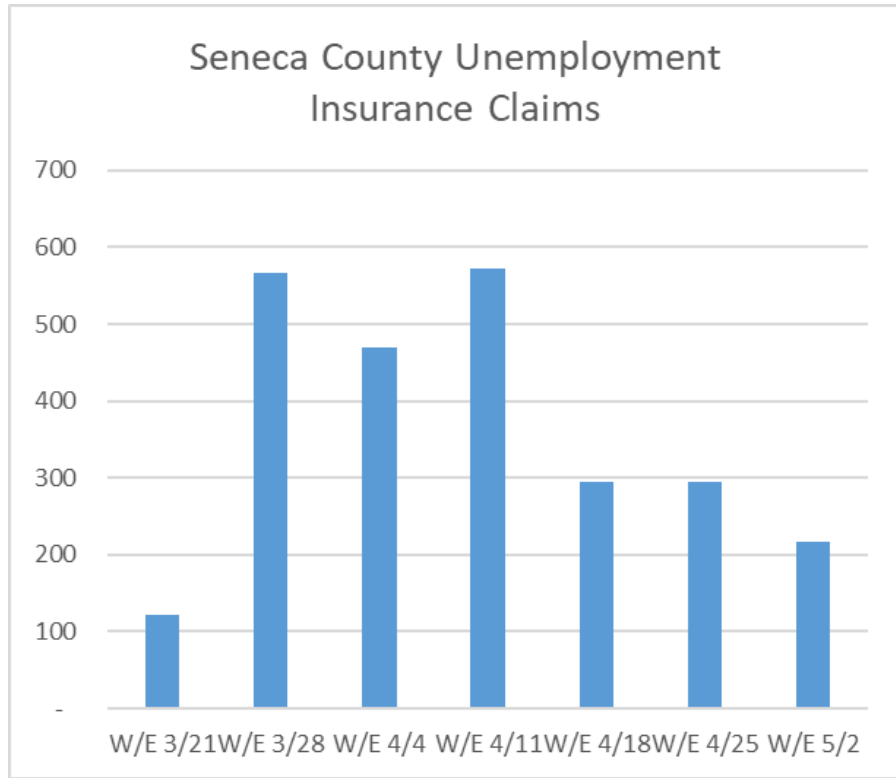


**Impact of Covid-19 Pandemic on
Seneca County Businesses**

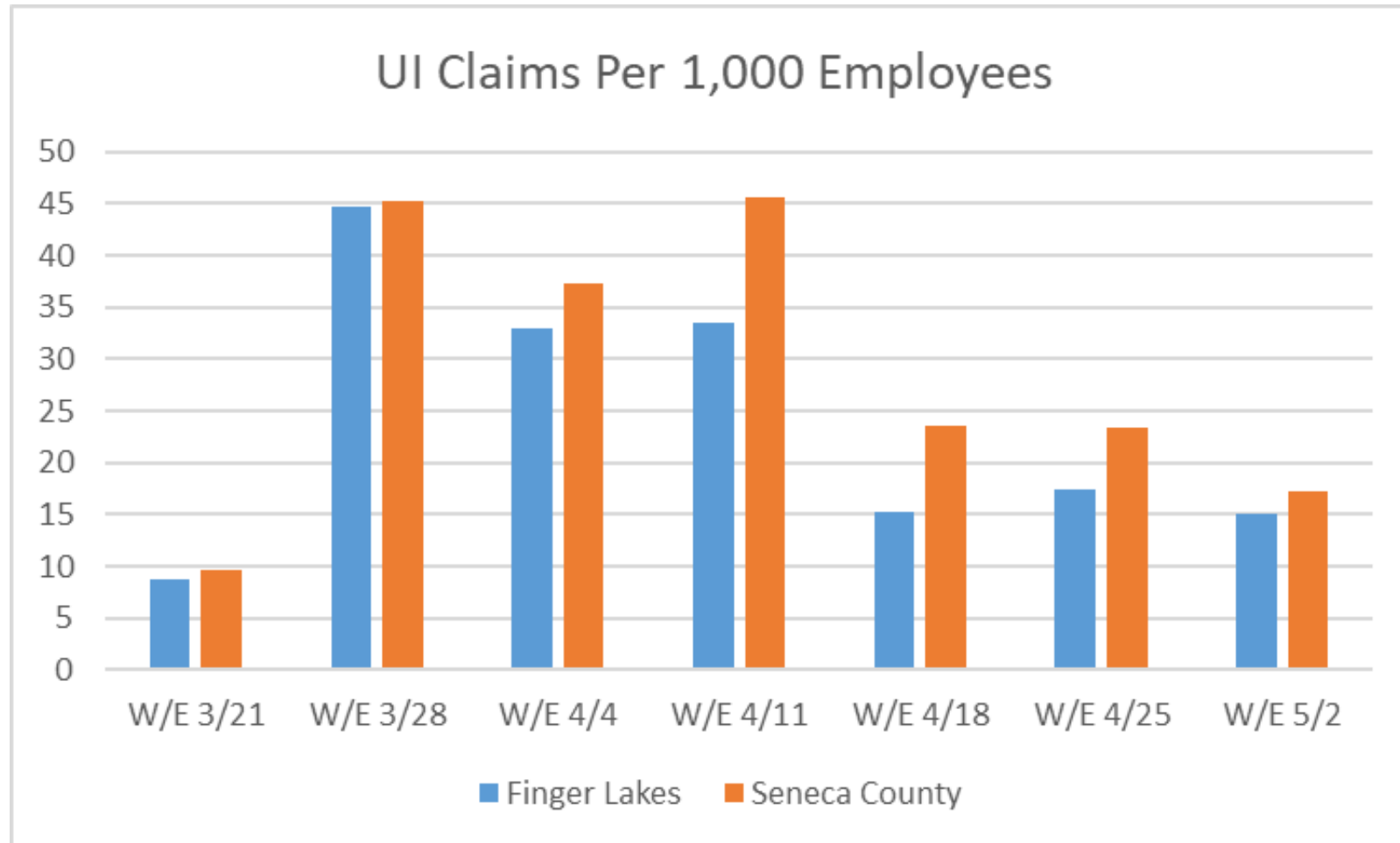
Data to Support Plans to Sensibly Re-Open the County's Economy

The number of workers filing unemployment insurance claims tracks the course of the pandemic



The number of workers filing unemployment insurance claims when adjusted for employment levels is approximately the same for the Finger Lakes Region and for Seneca County



If we knew precisely which industries and which companies experienced the greatest number of unemployment claims, then we could concentrate our efforts on ensuring these companies can open safely to bring their employees back to work.

The data to the right is for New York State as a whole. **It would be helpful if the NYS DOL could produce comparable data on a county-by-county basis.**
