



- Baily's Beads






What Happens if it is Cloudy?




What Happens if it is Cloudy?

It will still get dark!

April 8, 2024 - Total Eclipse of the Sun in Rochester!

99.9% Coverage of the Sun is NOT Totality

Why is this important now?



Learning from August, 2017

- Huge tourism opportunity
- Huge public infrastructure and planning effort

- It had been 38 years since last total solar eclipse in US.

January 24, 1925

Last Total Solar Eclipse in United States

August 21, 2017

69.72% coverage of Sun



Next Total Solar Eclipse in US

August 12, 2045

(21 years from 2024 Eclipse)

50.34% of the Sun Covered

Next Total Solar Eclipse in NYS

May 1, 2079

(55 years from 2024 Eclipse)

Crowds and Traffic



Expect huge crowds coming from the east and south will be driving

- People from NYC, Washington DC, Binghamton, etc.
- **390**, **86**, and **90** will see heavy traffic
- People will arrive over 1-4 days pre-eclipse
- If 2017 is a guide, most people will want to depart in the 2 hours post-totality,
- Majority leave right after the first 15 minutes post totality
- THIS is the biggest issue!
- Traffic jams should be expected on all roads leading out of the region - particularly East and South -Can't go NORTH!

Safety



Eye Wear

- You MUST wear Eclipse Glasses to directly view the eclipse.
 - Sun glasses do NOT work.
- Never look directly at the sun!
- There are other methods to observe the eclipse while not looking at the sun (pinhole projectors, shadows)
- ISO 12312-2:2015
- Counterfeit glasses from Amazon were a big issue back in 2017

Other safety considerations



- Activate Emergency Operations Centers?
- Mass gathering/crowds
- Distributed sites
- Multiple sites in each County
- Sanctioned and unofficial gatherings
- Closed streets and bridges (event related)
- Construction/Lane Closures
- Planned emergency routes for Police, Fire, EMS
- Unsafe driver behavior
- Distracted driving
- People stopping in travel lanes
- Pulling over in non designated areas
- Pre-deployed assets such as Ambulances, HELP vehicles, and Tow Trucks

- Trucks and Oversized loads
- Increased GA airport traffic
- Active Shooters, bomb threat, terrorist activity
- Overloaded cell towers impact on emergency communications
- Use of COWs (Cell on Wheels)
- Weather/environmental related issues
 - Wind, heat, cold
 - Flooding
 - Mud related issues (cars and/or people stuck)
- Misinformation will occur!

- Worried about kids getting stuck after totality



 - Create your own pinhole viewer
 - Moon phase calendar
 - String art
 - Button Making
- Telescope with solar filter for viewing
- "Expert" to answer questions about the eclipse

- Facilities
- Speakers related to space
- Area dedicated to those photographing the eclipse
- Projectors/TVs to watch livestream of eclipse locations before Rochester
- Backup plans for multiple weather possibilities
- Space themed music playlist


