# THIS WEEK'S HEADLINES

#### NY BUDGET INCLUDES INCREASE IN FUNDING FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 15 YRS

Spectrum: "AIM" (Aids & Incentives for Municipalities) had a \$50 M increase this year. \$415,766 was sent to Seneca County in 2023; average of \$32K went to each municipality, Seneca Falls receiving the most at \$148K. Everyone should expect an increase this year.

#### STATE CAMPAIGNS ABOUT TO RAKE IN \$100M OF PUBLIC FUNDING WHILE ALSO SPENDING ALL THE

#### PRIVATE MONEY THEY WANT

<u>The City:</u> A new statewide public financing program for election campaigns has been created. Candidates must opt in and are given a formula to deem if their race is competitive; they then receive public funding and can still use private funding.

#### NY CITIES PLAGUED BY BLACKOUTS DUE TO CLIMATE, STUDY FINDS

The Hill: Study released by the Columbia School of Public Health cited blackouts are a result of the climate. Study looked at blackouts from 2017-2020 and saw they lasted on average 20 hours. Smaller cities in NY lasted 18 hours and rural areas or small towns lasted an average of 12 hours.

#### SCHOHARIE COUNTY TOWNS SUE NY OVER SOLAR, WIND FARM PROPERTY TAXES

<u>Times Union:</u> Lawsuit filed in Albany County over solar and wind farm property taxes. Schoharie claims the state's method for taxation is unconstitutional and results in shortchanging. They have requested a restraining order to halt the taxation process.

#### **GOV HOCHUL LAUNCHES NYS HEALTHCARE WORKERS SCHOLARSHIP**

<u>Gov. Hochul:</u> A new scholarship program will give a two year scholarship to 500 students looking for their associate or bachelor's degree as a Registered Nurse, Respiratory Therapist, Clinical Laboratory Technologist, Radiologic Technologist, or Surgical Technologist. It will be given using a lottery system and students must agree to work in an underserved area for two years.

#### WATERLOO OR SF

<u>FL Times:</u> State law requires the largest municipality in a county to set up early voting; in Seneca County it's Seneca Falls, but there is a push to have it in the Seneca County building located in Waterloo.

#### NEW FIRE DEPARTMENT MAY BE INCORPORATED IN TYRE

<u>FL Times:</u> The Magee Fire Department was disbanded, and the Tyre Town Board will discuss creating the Tyre Fire Company in the old building where Magee Fire Dept. was.
