#### NYS RECEIVES \$21M IN FEDERAL FUNDING TO EXPAND EV CHARGING INFRASTRUCTURE

<u>Chargedevs.com</u>: This Federal Grant will focus on locations along the I-84, but will reach to the border of Canada and west of Buffalo. Requirements include the location being within 1 travel mile of an Exit, 24/7 public access, accessibility and ability to charge 4+ vehicles, and more.

#### HOCHUL MOVES AHEAD WITH OVERHAUL OF HOME CARE PROGRAM

<u>BlackChronicle:</u> A Georgia based company has been selected to takeover the \$9B industry of homecare and oversee everything to help avoid fraud/improve programs.

#### HOCHUL SIGNS BILL TO EXPAND HEALTHCARE ACCESS DURING. AFTER PREGNANCY

<u>Spectrum:</u> Pregnant women may enroll anytime outside of enrollment periods and HMOs are prohibited from charging fees.

CBS Albany: Hochul urges residents to avoid stockpiling like they did during COVID.

#### MANDATORY COMPOSTING BEGINS FOR ALL NYC NEXT WEEK

NY Post: Policy requires residents to separate compost from landfill garbage. Owners of rentals with 4+ units are responsible for providing a way to separate. Fines go into effect April 2025.

#### NY CHILDCARE PROVIDERS ARE BLEEDING WORKERS AS FEDERAL MONEY DRIES UP

NY Focus: Pandemic relief bill that put billions into childcare has been used up and advocates are sounding the alarm and urging the state to put in more money.
