Next, head to <u>Fleur de Lis Brew Works</u> or <u>Watershed Brewing Company</u> for a variety of craft beverages, outdoor games, and stunning scenery.



If you're looking for an eclipse-related activity, participate in <u>Sips to the Eclipse</u>, with 10 participating wineries! You'll get a bingo card with 10 spots, and you can fill one at each winery when you buy a bottle. The event is happening today and tomorrow, so be sure to check it out!

Hungry for a snack before dinner? Visit <u>Muranda</u> <u>Cheese Company</u>. Take part in a unique tasting experience in their refurbished barn, where you'll sample a variety of artisanal cheeses and discover which wines pair best with each.





After your tasting, head to <u>Sackett's Table Restaurant and Market</u> for dinner. Featuring local goods with a butcher on site, you're sure to have a mouthwatering and fresh farm-to-table meal.

For a sweet treat after dinner, stop by <u>Connie's Diner</u>, a '50s-style local gem, and try one of their one-of-a-kind loaded milkshakes!




In the afternoon, hit the casino at <u>del Lago Resort &</u>
