





Shreveport-Bossier has always been a border town of musical culture, where Texas roadhouse blues and Louisiana jazz blend together. This cultural crossroads has set the stage as a jumping off point for musical legends such as Huddie "Lead Belly" Ledbetter, Kitty Wells, Hurricane Chris, and Mitchell Parish.

Shreveport Municipal Auditorium has always been center stage in Shreveport's music history. The venue was once home to the radio broadcast program titled Louisiana Hayride from 1948 to 1960. The Louisiana Hayride helped launch the musical careers of some of the greatest names in American rock and roll and country music history including Hank Williams, Elvis Presley and Johnny Cash. Today, visitors can take the Backstage Music Tour of the Shreveport Municipal Auditorium.

"Shreveport's music history is America's music history," said Winston Hall, tour guide at Shreveport Municipal Auditorium. "For a brief time during the days of the Louisiana Hayride, Shreveport was the epicenter for a kind of musical revolution that mirrored the change in American culture."

From the days of Lead Belly and Elvis Presley to today's rock, blues and hiphop, Shreveport-Bossier's unique blend of musical influences continue to live on and thrive.
