FREE Greening of the Louisiana State Exhibit Museum

See Louisiana State Exhibit Museum dressed up with Christmas trees decorated by local elementary school students with ornaments they've created. Completed in 1939 as one of the New Deal's Public Works projects, the museum is an architectural jewel that displays more than 20 unique dioramas, Caddo Native American artifacts, a monumental fresco, dugout canoe, and more.

Enchanted Garden

Shop The Enchanted Garden's nine rooms of treasures including ladies' jewelry and accessories, collectibles, toys, Louisiana specialties, and hundreds of unique items.

Lunch at Glenwood Tea Room

A long-time Shreveport treasure, the Glenwood Tea Room was established in 1990 inside the old Glenwood Drugstore, which first opened in 1923. Today, the restaurant features a boutique offering exquisite ladies jewelry, accessories, British China, and fine gifts.

Davis Homeplace

Built in 1916 when Line Avenue was still a dirt road, Davis Homeplace has stood the test of time. Guests can tour the restored historic home dressed in its holiday finery.

Great Create at The Agora Borealis

Explore artistic creations of more than 300 local artists at the Agora Borealis, a local arts marketplace. Meet a local artist to learn about their work. Then unleash your creative talent for one of Agora's "Great Create" workshops such as mask making, candle making, body product making, and jewelry making.

Dinner at Ralph and Kacoo's

Enjoy a variety of Cajun cuisines such as Gulf Coast Seafood, shrimp, crab, crawfish platters, charbroiled fish and steaks.

Christmas in Roseland

Tour the Gardens of the American Rose Center while it is transformed into a winter wonderland featuring thousands of twinkling lights, dozens of lighted displays, giant Christmas cards and more.

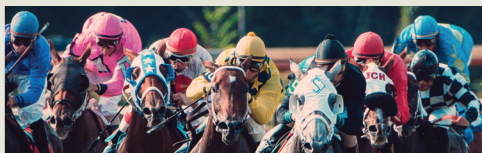
