All from unique backgrounds, their passion for brewing transcended from homebrewing in 2014 to a fullservice brewery in 2021. It's obvious that beer is strictly for the 21-and-up crowd, but the Seventh Tap Brewing Project taproom can accommodate every age range. See how you and your entire family can enjoy Shreveport's newest brewery, no matter your age or beer expertise.

0-10 age range ____

You'll amble next to your family and enjoy a casual, family-friendly environment.

Usually, you're too young for spaces that require clinking glasses and adult conversations, but here you can order a non-alcoholic beverage, eat some goodies from the food trucks, and hangout amongst adults.

21-30 AGE RANGE

You'll appreciate the Instagrammable space, for sure.

Although their tap room has traditional elements to its design, the space is a professional and amateur photographer's playground. You'll want a group photo in front of their indoor murals, a patio pic near the gardens, or an ice-cold pint of beer with a bold background. Have fun and use **#PressPlaySB** in your posts.

You'll take advantage of day drinking in a mature atmosphere.
