CLIMATE

Atascadero has what's known as a "hot-summer Mediterranean climate," which accounts for the area's strong agricultural history. This climate also serves well as wine country, and indeed, the city is surrounded by the popular Paso Robles American Viticultural Area, or AVA. Average high temperatures in the summer months tend to run in the low 90s, while average highs in the winter typically range in the 60s.
