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DAY ONE

Begin your Getaway in Paso Robles at the spectacular **Allegretto Vineyard Resort**, with its Tuscanstyle architecture, stunning hotel suites, museum-caliber artwork, an onsite vineyard, and an excellent restaurant; or at **Hotel Cheval**, an intimate 16-room boutique luxury hotel, offering its well-traveled guests a truly unique and memorable stay.

Once settled, venture to the Paso Robles Plaza, where you'll find outstanding restaurants such as **The Hatch Rotisserie**, a gourmet wood fired rotisserie and bar featuring small batch whiskey. Across the Plaza, you'll find **Buona Tavola** offering a remarkable selection of Northern Italian dishes and an extensive list of Central Coast and Italian wines.

DAY TWO

In the morning, enjoy loaded avocado toast, acai bowls, ricotta pancakes, breakfast tacos, or a fried BLT at **Kitchenette** in Templeton; or grab a table at **Bramble Pie Company** in Atascadero, which serves freshly homemade pies, pastries, quiche, empanadas—prepared with hyper-local, organic, and sustainably sourced ingredients.

Continue south for 30-minutes to **Sycamore Mineral Springs Resort & Spa**, located on over 100 acres in the lush Avila Valley. The menu includes a wide selection of massages and facials—and every treatment includes a half-hour soak in a private hillside mineral springs hot tub! There are also a variety of mind/body classes offered in its Yoga Dome.

After your treatments, take a five-minute drive to the seaside village of Avila Beach. Alongside the expansive beaches, you'll find numerous oceanfront restaurants, such as **Blue Moon Over Avila**, **Ocean Grill, Custom House** in the quaint downtown area or Mersea's Seafood Restaurant on the beautiful Port San Luis Pier about a half-mile north. And Avila also has a number of excellent tasting rooms, including Alapay, **Sinor-LaValle**, and **Peloton**.

After returning to Paso and relaxing at your hotel, and then eventually finding yourself in the mood for dinner, check out the popular the **Catch Seafood Bar & Grill**, known for its masterful seafood dishes, prepared in an open-style kitchen.

Or go to the Cane Tiki Room for an exotic escape and enjoy a fabulous selection of tropical rum



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drinks and a delicious small bites menu of chef-inspired Polynesian and Hawaiian Pu Pu plates. It also features a large collection of rums from all over the world.

Then go listen to live music and dance at the California Coast Beer Company in Paso Robles.

DAY THREE

Start your day in Paso Robles with excellent gourmet coffees and teas at the popular **AMSTERDM** or **Spearhead** coffeehouses. Just around the corner, you'll find the **Paso Robles General Store** which sells a vast array of local goods and provisions for pantry and home.

Next, visit **Hambly Lavender Farm**, located just a few miles north of Paso Robles in San Miguel where one can wander among acres of lavender or take a guided tour. Outside the marvelous gift shop—which sells everything lavender—there is a patio, with tables and a fountain. So, feel free to bring your own lunch and a bottle of wine and relax amongst the purple fields and the magical scent of lavender.

While you're in San Miguel area, do not miss the historic Spanish-era Mission. Founded in 1797, **Mission San Miguel** is a National Historical Landmark that has been an important part of Central Coast history for over 200 years. Or if you feel like getting to the ocean, take a lovely 35-minute and unhurried drive to the artisan community of Cambria.

For lunch, check out **Linn's Restaurant**, a SLO CAL favorite. It serves hearty farm breakfasts, as well as lunch and dinner. Or head to **Linn's Gourmet Goods** located just down the street to pick up a freshly baked pie, berry preserves, Linn's farmed produce, and a few gifts. On your way out to Linn's Farm Store, stop by **Stolo Family Vineyards** to taste its "cool climate" wines and enjoy its large lawn, surrounded by vineyards and farms.

After returning to Paso, visit one—or more—of almost 20 tasting rooms in and around downtown Paso Robles, such as **Alpha Omega**, **Derby**, **Hoyt Family Vineyards**, and **Diablo**. After your wine wanderings, try **La Cosecha Bar and Restaurant**, with its focus on Spanish and South American cuisine; or the **Alchemist Garden**, featuring fantastically creative cocktails and an eclectic share-plate menu in a lively bar setting.
