



Getting to SLO CAL

Location

SLO CAL is located in the center of California's Central Coast. The land of picturesque beaches, rolling vineyards, small-town charm and a thriving culinary scene. SLO CAL is made up of lots of different regions, expanding landscapes of turquoise waters to spectacular dunes, each offering something unique. Known for its lively downtown of San Luis Obispo, this historic county is home to countless hiking trails, museums and art galleries, wineries and more!

How to Get There

UK passengers can fly direct into key California gateways including San Francisco, Los Angeles and San Diego, and then drive to SLO CAL.Other gateway cities from the UK include Dallas (DFW), Denver (DEN) and Seattle (SEA).

Los Angeles to SLO CAL is a 3 hour drive, San Francisco is 3.5 hours and San Diego is 5 hours. SLO CAL is conveniently located on the iconic Highway 1, that runs along most of the Pacific coastline of California making it ideal for fly drive holidays.

Travellers can also access SLO CAL through the AMTRAK's Coast Starlight and Pacific Surfliner train that offer a daily service.







Key Regions

The Land of SLO CAL is split into three distinct regions that surround San Luis Obispo, and are all within an hour's drive. The North Coast is home to the largest population of elephant seals, stunning views and seaside towns including San Simeon, Cambria, and Morro Bay to name a few. The North of SLO CAL is made up of vine draped hills, majestic oaks, world-class wines and farm-to-table produce. Paso Robles and Atascadero are two of the areas that make up the Northern region of SLO CAL. Further down in the South is miles of sandy beaches and farmland, here is where you will find areas such as Pismo & Shell Beach, Arroyo Grande, Grover Beach and Oceano.

San Luis Obispo




Atascadero





Hearst Castle, located in San Simeon is considered a jewel in the county, and is a decadent and meticulously preserved hilltop estate that brings history to life. Founded in 1772 is one of the historic Spanish California missions, Mission San Luis Obispo de Tolosa the still active Mission church lies at the centre of modern-day downtown San Luis Obispo city centre. Sensorio is a stunning multi-acre outdoor exhibit dedicated to the intersection of art, technology and nature. SLO CAL's aquariums and zoos capture the attention of all family fun enthusiasts, and the tours on offer range from boating, to adventure, wine & food, historic and cultural.

Beaches

SLO CAL offers beach lovers a plethora of stunning shores to discover, whether it's surfing or sunbathing they're after. Pismo & Shell Beach are some of Central Coast's most sought-after beaches, and just a stone's throw away from Highway I and a few miles from San Luis Obispo.
