






Blooming on trails and in town



WINE COUNTRY

TO MINUTES AWAY IN EDNA VALLED

Pismo Beach offers the perfect pairing of wine and waves in a warm and inviting atmosphere. Visitors can learn about the local culture and discover new grape varieties produced here in the historic winemaking regions of Edna Valley, Arroyo Grande and Avila Valley all of which are located just 30 minutes outside of downtown Pismo Beach and local area attractions. Our wine country offers a refreshing perspective on artisanal winemaking by some of the most respected winemakers in California.





San Luis Obispo County is home to more than 250 wineries and many tasting rooms are just a short drive away from Pismo Beach including the wine regions of Edna Valley and Arroyo Grande Valley.

EDNA VALLEY

The region's rocky volcanic soils produce fruit with intense varietal character and complex flavors. It's best known for Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

ARROYO GRANDE VALLEY

This serpentine valley stretches 16 miles inland from Arroyo Grande and offers rich, concentrated flavors.

OTHER TASTING ROOMS CLOSE TO PISMO BEACH

Paso Robles is home to more than 200 wineries. Cabernet, Zinfandel, Merlot, Syrah and various Rhône varietals dominate the vineyard landscape.

York Mountain is higher, wetter, cooler and much smaller than the sprawling Paso Robles wineries. Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Grenache, Pinot Blanc, Pinot Noir and Syrah are grown here.

Santa Maria Valley is best known for Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, but vineyards also produce Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Grenache, Merlot, Mourvèdre, Sangiovese and Syrah.





Humpback whales migrate through Pismo Beach, California from April to November, with the best time to see them is August through October. Gray whales can be seen migrating through Pismo Beach from December to April.

Humpback whales

Humpback whales can be seen year-round, but are most commonly seen from April to November.

August through October are the best months to see humpback whales because of the weather and the number of whales in the area. Humpback whales are known for their single burst of spray.

Gray whales

Gray whales migrate south from Alaska starting in October, and then return from mid-February to May. December to April are the best months to see gray whales migrating through Pismo Beach.





Monarch Season is late October thru February

The Pismo Beach Monarch Butterfly Grove is one of only five sites in the state that has counts of over 10,000 butterflies annually. Each year thousands of vibrant orange and black Monarch Butterflies flock to Pismo State Beach, a location essential to their successful migration, seeking shelter from the freezing northern winters. From late October to February, the butterflies cluster in the limbs of towering, majestic Eucalyptus trees flanking a riparian estuary that flows to the Pacific Ocean. The grove is easily accessible from CA State Highway 1 at the south boundary of the city limits of Pismo Beach. The Monarch Butterfly Grove is an open

space that is open to the public at no charge, year-round.







Pismo Beach's commitment to clam conservation

A quick history

Pismo clams are a treasured species along California's coastline. For years, they supported thriving commercial and recreational fisheries in Pismo Beach until overharvesting led to their decline. The commercial fishery closed in 1947, and by the 1980s, populations had dropped so significantly that no



legal-sized clams had been found since 1993. In 2020, the Pismo Clam made a remarkable comeback and reappeared in large numbers across our beaches.

Pismo Beach's commitment to clam conservation

The City of Pismo Beach is dedicated to protecting its coastal ecosystem, ensuring that future generations can continue to enjoy magical coastal moments and wildlife. In hopes of better understanding the resurgence and supporting policies that protect the Pismo Clam, the City of Pismo Beach funds a portion of CalPoly's Ruttenberg Marine Biology Lab. This lab researches marine population dynamics and species recovery to inform sustainable management.

How to rebury clams

Dig a hole at least two inches deep and place the clam with its hinge ligament (the dark bump where the two shells connect) upward and pointing toward the ocean. You'll want to then cover the clam with sand. It's important to




rebury clams because it takes time for them to rebury themselves. Leaving them exposed on top of the sand can be harmful or even fatal. By properly reburying them, you're helping increase their survival and population.

Going clamming?

You must obtain a salt-water fishing license from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife. It's permitted year-round but they cannot be taken at night. You will need a clam fork and a caliper measuring device, which are available to rent by the pier. It is a good idea to bring a bucket and fill it with seawater, not fresh water. Each person needs their own bucket and clamming can take place from ½ hour before sunrise until ½ hour after sunset The limit for clamming is ten clams per day per person and the legal size is 4.5 inches in diameter.

Visitors can enjoy over 10 miles of trails, ready-to-use routes ideal for hiking, mountain biking, and horseback riding. The Dunes

Beach hiking is elevated to new heights of wonder at the Dunes located just south of Pismo Beach. A staggering expanse of white, undulating sand dunes create a stunning backdrop for hikers of all ages. The Oceano Dunes Preserve walking trail is the most notable way for visitors to explore this otherworldly landscape and is easily accessible from the Pismo Beach side. Clocking in at approximately 2.4 miles in and back, this unique coastal trail is both easy and fruitful, affording dramatic dune-swept views of the sea as well as native plant and wildlife.


The Cliffside Trails

Typical Pismo Temperatures

Mild Central California coastal weather conditions usually prevail year-round. Here's what you can usually expect in each season.

Summer (June-August)

Early morning fog and overcast skies, which usually clear by midday.

Fall (September-November)

Sunny skies, warm temperatures and calm winds are the norm most days.

Winter (December–February)

Conditions are similar to those in the fall, but with occasional rain showers and cool temperatures.

Spring (March-May)

Occasional showers, sunny skies and mild to warm temperatures are standard.




