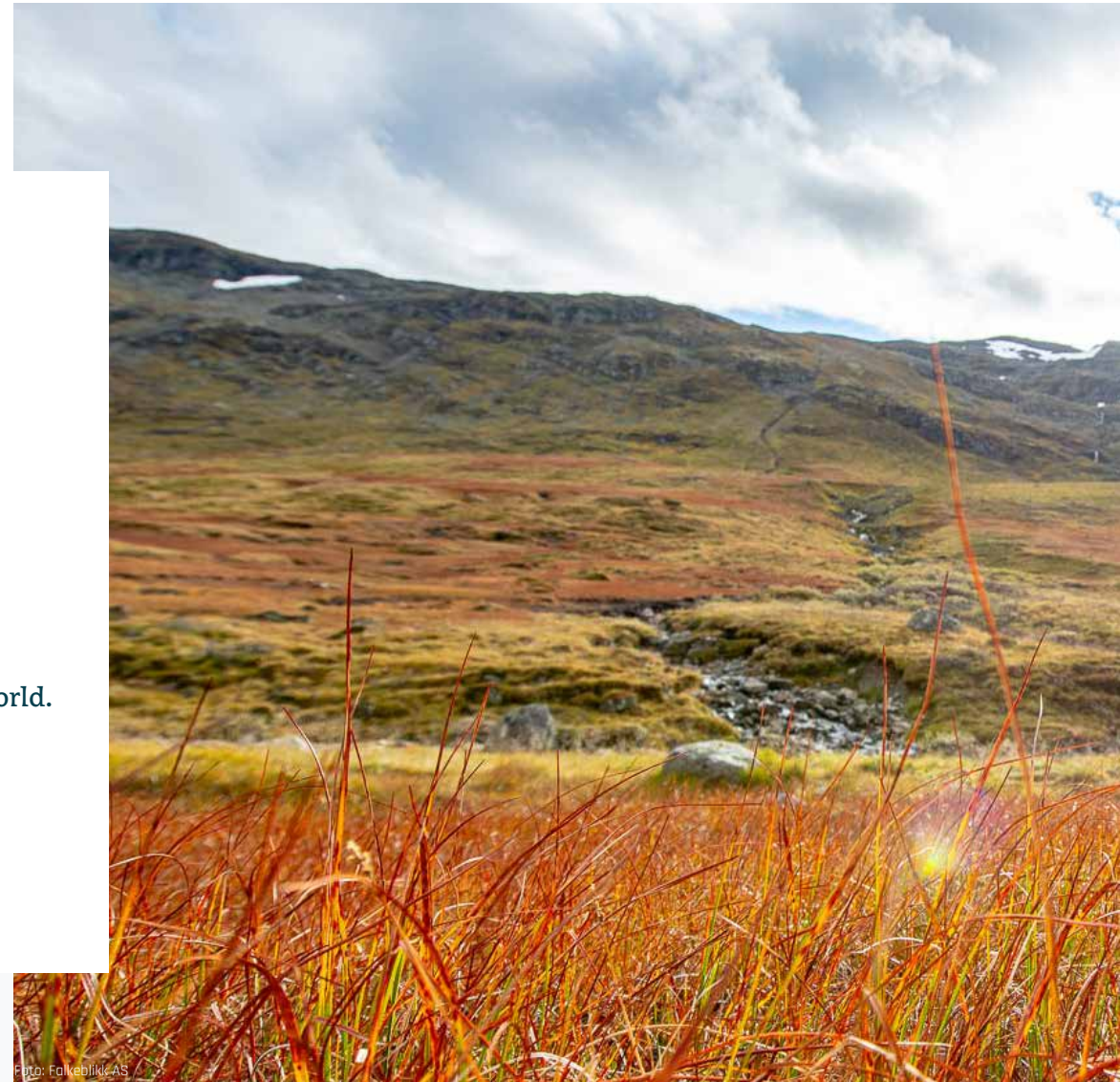

OUR STAVE CHURCHES

In the Sognefjorden area you are able to visit four national treasures and an important part of Norwegian cultural heritage.

BORGUND

Built around 1180 and dedicated to the Apostle Andrew, The church is exceptionally well preserved and it is the most distinctive stave church in Norway.

HOPPERSTAD

The richly decorated Hopperstad Stave church in Vik would have been lost if it weren't for the intervention of cultural conservationists, who managed to save it just in time.

URNES

Urnes Stave church is the oldest and most highly decorated stave church in the Sognefjord area. UNESCO World Heritage listed in 1979.

KAUPANGER

This church is the largest stave church in the region. The church has the largest number of staves to be found in any one stave church.

OUR SKI CENTERS

In the heart of the winter fjord you will find two ski centers, each one a 15min drive from Sogndal. Known widely for their amazing combination of being family friendly and having some of the most awesome powder skiing and backcountry skiing in Norway.

SOGN SKI CENTER - HAFSLO

This humble ski center has Norway's longest button lift, and probably some of the best lift accessible freeride areas in Norway. With 700m of vertical drop and large areas designated for freeride and family friendly off-piste, this is not an unpolished gem, it is unpolished granite.

Get away from the hustle and bustle of larger ski resorts and enjoy the quiet luxury of untouched snow.

There are two shorter uplifts in the large and safe family area, a sledding slope and of course, XC-skiing for both the active skier and the smallest kids.

The center is open every weekend and offers "night-skiing" two nights a week. Close to Sogn Skisenter you will find Jotunheimen national park with some of the most well-known ski touring in Norway, accommodation and an indoor waterpark, perfect for those family weekends.

SOGNDAL SKI CENTER - HODLEKVE

Situated in the Sogndal Valley, this ski center is close to some of the most epic backcountry peaks in the Sogndal Valley.

Hodlekve has a 1200 meter long ski lift, that will take you up about 290 meters with four slopes. 3,5 km of groomed slopes and off-piste is waiting for you!

With plentiful snowfall, generally quiet slopes and a warm welcome, Sogndal skisenter Hodlekve, has huge attractions for all type of skiers and snowboarders of all ability levels, including families with kids.

The ski resort has 5 ski lifts and 13 slopes, offering 5 km of lighted cross-country slopes and an additional 5 km slopes for daytime use. In the weekends we make sure to groom the 25 km xc-slope accessing beautiful high altitude skiing and views.

For those interested in snow activities without skis, walking across the plateau with snow shoes is an experience not to be missed.

CIDERHUSET - Cider tasting

BALESTRAND

The Cider House is a family run micro cidery (winery) in an organic orchard with a range of different fruits. We make beverages all made of 100 % fruit or berries with and without alcohol – juices, ciders and fruit wines under the brand Balholm. Some of them are award winners in international competitions.

Meet with one of the family members and learn about the process of growing and fermenting fruit, or how we treat the cider and the bottles to make sparkling cider the traditional Champaign way. In our distillery you may also taste different handcrafted fruit brandies.

In May, the orchard is in bloom if you are lucky. In September/October you may join us picking plums or apples, or even apricots a few miles from the glaciers.

Welcome to a cultural experience in Vik

Vik is a village rich in history and cultural treasures. Join in on a magical and memorable journey through history and beautiful landscape, in the heart of Sogn.

Vikøyri 1,5-hour walk in cultural history:

Visit the old village center with small picturesque homes and boat houses that makes up the beach dweller settlement at Vikøyri. We also enter one of the small houses that still stands untouched as when it was abandoned many years ago. The tour will include a taste of the local speciality “Gamalost”.

Sylvringen historical 3,5 hour tour.

We visit Hopperstad stave church and Hove stone church with its famous Madonna sculpture. On our way we pass several burial mounds and other interesting sights. We also have the pleasure to introduce you to the local cheese, “Gamalost”. The tour includes the protected beach dweller settlement at Vikøyri.

Hovsåsen, 4,5 hour Sunday hike.

Typical Norwegian medium level hike. Packed lunch included. The hike is approximately 12 km (7,5 miles) with an ascent of 300 meters (984 ft) Good shoes are mandatory! The hike takes You from village center by the burial mounds and churches up in the hills where you will have a magnificent view of Vik.

Balestrand Fjord Sightseeing

BALESTRAND

A thrilling sightseeing trip showing and explaining Balestrand's sights from the fjord

Start at the Balestrand Tourist Information Office, near the harbor. Here you will be met by your guide, and you will be given a flotation suit and life jacket.

Before the tour starts, safety instructions are given on board. The boat goes first to Esebotn, an landscape popular among National Romantic painters.

The tour then goes to Kvinnafossen, a 120 meter high waterfall. The next stop is near the Fritjof Statue, a historical curiosity donated by Kaiser Wilhelm II from Germany.

The tour continues to Kvamsøy, a small island with a stone church from the late 1200s. Finally, the boat passes along Balestrand's row of dragon-style villas before stopping at the harbor again.

Welcome to one of the oldest and largest cultural heritage museums in Norway!

Through our exhibitions and open-air museum, we aim to provide insights into the lives of the people who have lived by the Sognefjord from the Middle Ages until today.

During the summer season, the museum manages a full-scale farm, using authentic late 19th century tools and methods. The open-air museum has almost 40 historical buildings, ranging all the way from medieval times to various decades of the 1900s.

Our guides will take you on a journey through these centuries: Feel the atmosphere inside the houses, and hear stories about the work, family life and traditions of the people who lived there.

We can also offer tours focused on specific themes or time periods.

The Norwegian Booktown in Fjærland

FJÆRLAND

This is the remarkable booktown in Fjærland.

What is a book town? Whatever the name: Bokby – village du livres – book town – kirjakylä, they are all small villages dominated by the sale of second-hand books.

Fjærland is a small town of 300 people and several charming bookshops, containing more than 150.000 secondhand books. The small town centre is called Mundal.

The Norwegian Book Town in Fjærland started out very modestly in 1995, and now stocks about 2.5 miles of shelving, filled with books, in a variety of abandoned buildings – from ferry waiting rooms, stables and local banks to post office and grocery shop.

By the Kaupanger ferry dock, you'll find the Sogn Fjord Museum. The fjord has always been an important source of food, income and communication, essential to the Sogn settlements and way of life.

We have a unique collection of boats from Sogn. You'll also find a reconstructed boat workshop, including many boat-building tools. There is also a diverse selection of traditional fishing tools.

The fjord used to be the very lifeblood of the Sogn villages. It was their highway. Amongst the steep mountain sides lining the Sognefjord, boats were in some places the only sensible way to get around. Even where the land was traversable for people, it was much easier to use the fjord as a road, whether you were transporting people, animals or goods. The museum contains examples of all the common Sogn boats, from the «færing», which remained the most common, to the «Storebåt» – a small Jekt.

The history of Sogn cannot be understood without including the fjord as a central element. This makes Sogn Fjord Museum especially important to the people of Sogn.

The King's Road across Filefjell

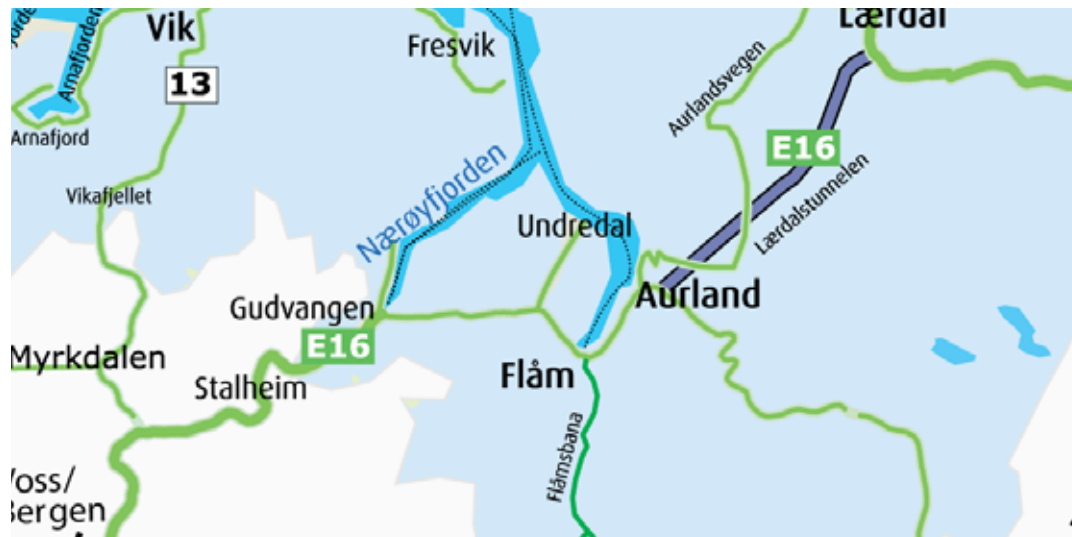

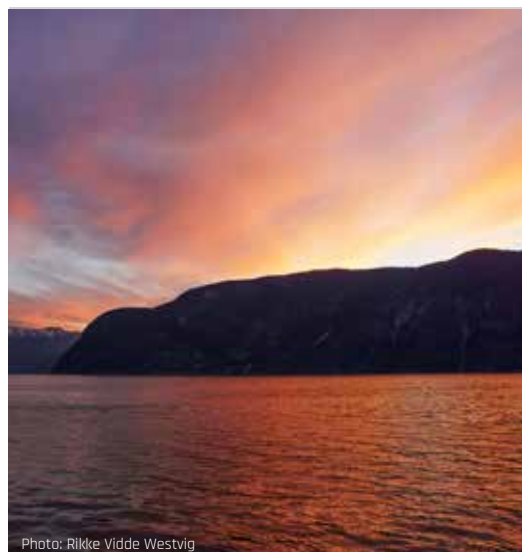
