- Cycle route on the south side of the Sognefjord to the quirky and unique Wilderness museum in Massnes or to the Ikkjefjord, where hiking routes are available.

The journey starts with a nice, low key bikeride from the centre of Skjolden and continues through the peaceful Mørkrid Valley. Here, our guide makes a stop to both show pictures and tell stories about every day life in the valley. You get to learn about herding cattle and goats to spring and summer pastures, and eco friendly use of land and animals.

After approx. 8km on our bikes we climb off and our journey now continues by foot. We follow a rocky, uphill path for 1,5 hours, taking breaks when needed. We make sure to walk as close to the rapids as is safe, and through varied habitats and landscape.

This hike leads up to Bølifossen, a place for fishing, exploring, tasting local cured meat on Norwegian flat bread.

Historic bike route from the mountains to the fjord

A classic bike journey that brings you from Europe's highest mountain plateau down through the natural and cultural landscape of Flåmsdalen.

Few bicycle trips beat Rallarvegen, also known as the "navvy road". This classic trip is 80 km long and runs from Haugastøl through Finse and Hallingskeid to Vatnahalsen and Flåm. It is possible to cycle shorter stages of the Rallarvegen, with some stages being highly family-friendly. Rallarvegen has been declared the finest bicycle road in Norway.

Arriving at Vatnahalsen Hotel by train provides the perfect starting point for your Rallar Experience. Enjoy a healthy meal and a quiet evening at this legendary mountain hotel, before waking up all rested in the middle of the great Skarvheim. After breakfast you depart by train at the hotel's own station, and go to either Haugastøl, Finse or Hallingskeid depending on the preferred length of your trip. From there on you spend the better part of the day cycling along Rallarvegen through its wild and beautiful landscape, with mountain streams, rivers, waterfalls and truly stunning vistas of the mountain region.

At the end of the trip you end up back at Vatnahalsen just in time for an après-bike in the afternoon sun, followed by a rich dinner made with local ingredients.

Private glacier hike

We aim to give you an unforgettable glacier hike experience. Assisted by our RIB boat, we take smaller, private groups to a non-touristic location of the Jostedal Glacier.

Our one day tour starts with a RIB boat tour on a glacier lake. Waterfalls and snow clad mountains surrounds the lake as we "fly" into the wilderness. From the boat we walk on a path alongside the powerful glacier river, entering the National Park.

Next to the glacier we have a rest in our tipi and the equipment necessary for the glacier hike is handed out. Equipped with crampons, ice axe, harness and rope, we are ready to explore the world of blue ice. We walk on the glacier searching for ice holes or small tunnels. If we are lucky, we will find a spot to enter into the ice.

After the glacier hike, we have lunch and warm drink in our tipi, before returning to the boat.

The Tunsbergdal Glacier is the longest arm of the Jostedal Glacier and the nature surrounding us on the tour is mighty. We are lucky to have "our own" glacier destination, and we seldom see other people on our adventures.

Hiking on a glacier, a day you will never forget

Big, massive and impressive the NIGARDGLACIER pulls down through the valley in Jostedal near by the Sognefjord.

With help of trained glacier guides, the right equipment and some expert instruction it is no big case to walk on the blue, hard ice.

This is not a very strenuous hike, but the route passes through the blue ice landscape - with towers, pinnacles and crevasses - is not flat and in some parts it climbs quite steep up and down.

Therefore you should be used to walk on easy mountain trails. From 2017 the entrance to the exhibition at Breheimssenteret - the Glacier Visitor Centre - is included as well (does not apply to groups).

This hike is suitable for all who want to experience, during a shorter hike, what glacier hiking really is like.

Hiking on the ice is cold. Wear warm, wind and water-proof clothing, sunglasses, lunch and solid shoes (trekking boots or sport shoes). The clothing must cover the whole body (no shorts or skirts).

It is a popular base for hiking in the western part of Jotunheimen. Svalheim Farm is located 3 km from the town of Øvre Årdal, and is the perfect place for the adventurous who like activities in the mountains, often in the mountain pioneer Slingsbys footsteps.

The area is also known for beautiful waterfalls, including Hjellefossen, Avdalsfossen, Hyljefossen and Vettisfossen, which is within easy reach from Svalheim Farm. The river Utle which flows close by, is a good seatrout / salmon river, and fishing licenses can be purchased at Utladalen Camping located next door. On Svalheim Farm we have room for 22 overnight guests. The farmhouse has a warm and cozy atmosphere with a total of 5 bedrooms, 2 large living rooms and 3 bathrooms with shower and WC. In addition there are 2 newly renovated guest rooms in the old storehouse located next to the farmhouse. We emphasize creating a pleasant atmosphere rather than luxury.
