




REGIONS

WHERE IS SONOMA VALLEY?

It can be a bit confusing to find "Sonoma Valley" — not that the picturesque valley tucked between two mountain ranges about 45 miles north of San Francisco is hiding from the world. The roughly 17-mile long valley is next to Napa Valley, and is one of the main attractions in Sonoma County.

But defining the *where* is a lot easier than nailing down the *what*.

Is it the birthplace of modern California and the cradle of "wine country" cuisine? Or is it a place for urban chic, starry-eyed bohemians, and farmers with mud falling off their flatbed trucks?

It's all of those — and more.

Sonoma Valley is taking selfies in the giant sunset-orange Adirondack chair at Cornerstone Sonoma and next to the statue of Gen. Mariano Vallejo sitting on a park bench in Sonoma Plaza.

Sonoma Valley is marveling at the 2,000-year-old, 14-foot-wide Grandmother Tree in Jack London State Historic Park. It's a three-block-long Fourth of July parade that lasts two hours, and a serene walk through neat rows of grapevines that seem to curl over the hills and into the sky.

Here's a quick overview of Sonoma Valley's many parts, from south to north, to help you get started discovering the crescent shaped area known as "the Valley of the Moon."




CARNEROS Feel the cool breezes from San Pablo Bay as you gaze out over the gently rolling hills and the flat plain that form the southern end of Sonoma Valley. Life slows down in these wide-open spaces, and there's plenty of time to explore, to taste fine wine and gourmet olive oils, and to stroll through vineyards, boutique shops, and designer gardens. Wineries here specialize in cool-weather varietals like Pinot Noir and Chardonnay as well as sparkling wines.

SONOMA Sharing a name with the neighboring Valley and the entire county, the town of Sonoma is a charming wine-country community known for its eight-acre Plaza.

Relax at a picnic table under a shady tree with a picnic, take a leisurely stroll along the charming streets, discovering boutiques, restaurants, and wine tasting rooms. You'll find old adobe buildings and other historic sites almost everywhere you turn, and don't forget to spend a moment in the quiet serenity of the last Spanish/Mexican mission built in California.

THE SPRINGS You can't miss the brightly colored building façades — including a giant, multi-colored metal chicken outside a local grocery store — and the cool, Mission-style lines of the Fairmont Sonoma Mission Inn, a historic luxury resort. Both are highlights of this dynamic area, consisting of four adjacent communities and nicknamed for its underground hot springs. Variety and diversity are the watchwords here, with family-owned eateries and businesses, boutique shops, and wine-country fab thrift shops.

GLEN ELLEN "Quaint" will undoubtedly come to mind as you explore this wine country village, with its western chic vibe. Dine on delicious farm-to-table cuisine and taste wines crafted from grapes grown in the surrounding vineyards. Hike scenic trails and discover the life and times of famed author Jack London in the state park bearing his name, and then wander through acres of beautiful Asian plants in the botanical gardens east of town.



KENWOOD Bite into a just-picked strawberry at the strawberry patch, and smile at the incredible collection of colorful metal critters outside the feed store. Tucked into northern Sonoma Valley's vineyards, rolling hills, and wide meadows, this tight-knit community offers a variety of delightful experiences, from wine tasting to hiking and camping at the nearby state park, or relaxing in Mediterranean-style luxury at Kenwood Inn & Spa.

FURTHER AFIELD Heading northwest, Sonoma Valley ends with a rise in the land that marks the boundary with the Santa Rosa plain and the watershed that feeds not into the San Pablo Bay but rather into the Russian River and Pacific Ocean. The communities of Santa Rosa, Windsor and Healdsburg are to the north, while Petaluma lies to the southwest and the beaches of Bodega Bay are to the west. All these areas of Sonoma County provide more adventures when you have finished exploring Sonoma Valley.

Gay Wine Weekend is a celebration of food, wine and the ambience of our Valley and has been named as a top LGBTQ event of the summer season.

And of course, fall brings the grape harvests – our most important time of the year. Enjoy the bustle of the wineries and the historic Vintage Festival. You can even pick and crush your own grapes and blend your own wine.

WINE TERM GLOSSARY



FROM VINOLOGY

SO YOU WANT TO TALK THE TALK? CHECK OUT SOME OF THESE COMMONLY USED WINE TERMS TO HELP YOURSELF LOOK LIKE A CERTIFIED SOMMELIER (WINE EXPERT) AMONGST YOUR FAMILY AND FRIENDS!

ACIDITY — the liveliness and crispness in wine that activates our salivary glands

AGING — holding wine in barrels, tanks, and bottles to advance them to a more desirable state

APPELLATION — a delineated wine producing region particular to France

AROMA — the smell of wine, especially young wine (different than "bouquet")

BLEND — a wine made from more than one grape varietal

BODY — a tactile sensation describing the weight and fullness of wine in the mouth. A wine can be light, medium, or full bodied.

BREATHING — exposing wine to oxygen to improve its flavors

BRUT — French term denoting dry champagnes or sparkling wines

CRUSH — another term for harvest

DRY — a taste sensation often attributed to tannins and causing puckering sensations in the mouth; the opposite of sweet

EARTHY — an odor or flavor reminiscent of damp soil

ENOLOGY — the science of wine and winemaking

FERMENTATION — the conversion of grape sugars to alcohol by yeast

FULL-BODIED — a wine high in alcohol and flavors, often described as "big"

MALOLACTIC FERMENTATION — a secondary fermentation in which the tartness of malic acid in wine is changed into a smooth, lactic sensation. Wines described as "buttery" or "creamy" have gone through "malo."

NOSE — a tasting term describing the aromas and bouquets of a wine


OAK/OAKY — tasting term denoting smells and flavors of vanilla, baking spices, coconut, mocha or dill caused by barrel-aging

SOMMELIER — a wine steward, often employed at a fine restaurant; also used to denote a certified wine professional.

TANNINS — the phenolic compounds in wines that leave a bitter, dry, and puckery feeling in the mouth

TERROIR — French term for geographical characteristics unique to a given vineyard

VINTAGE — the year a wine is bottled. Also used to denote the yield of wine from a vineyard during a single seasonyeast — a microorganism endemic to vineyards and produced commercially that converts grape sugars into alcohol



O TASTE

BECOME A WINE EXPERT IN SONOMA VALLEY

Learning how to taste wines will deepen your appreciation for the deep care given by the winemakers.


LOOK: Take a good look at the glass of wine. Tilt the glass and note the color of the wine against a white background. What color is it? Look for more than red, pink or white. Is the wine watery or dark, translucent or opaque, dull or brilliant, cloudy or clear?

SMELL: Swirl your glass for 10 seconds and then take a quick whiff to gain a first impression. Then bring the glass back up to your nose and inhale. What do you smell? Oak, berry, flowers, vanilla, citrus?

TASTE: Start with a small sip and roll it around your mouth and across your tongue. Ideally alcohol content, tannin levels, acidity and residual sugar will be well-balanced and meld together. What initial impression does the wine make on your palate? Soft or firm, light or heavy, crisp or creamy, sweet or dry? Next, what is the wine's actual taste on the palate? Do you note fruit, perhaps some spice, or maybe oak, cedar, or earthiness? Finally, how does the wine finish? Can you taste the remnant of the wine on the back of your mouth and throat? What was your last flavor impression - fruit, butter, oak? However, everyone's palate is different!

Flights make it easy to explore the variety you might find a unique limited edition recipe like the HazyCaliFrajilisticHoppyaladocious that's a fruity, New England-style IPA punch of citrus, pine and the bitter finish that hopheads adore. Or, it might be the lighter sensations called Women Are Smarter Saison/Farmhouse Ale, imbued with fresh rose petal, star jasmine, hibiscus and cardamon.



THE OLIVE PRESS IMPRESSES

Did you know that America's best olive oil often comes from Sonoma, not just Europe? In fact, the sprawling Olive Press in Sonoma Valley consistently takes home gold medals from the prestigious New York Olive Oil Competition each year, beating out more than 900 entries from 27 countries around the world.

As the very first olive mill in Sonoma, the facility now produces house-made olive oil infused with dozens of different flavors like lemon, ruby red grapefruit or jalapeno, plus local herbs like sage, garlic or basil. Visit, take a tour and taste all the gourmet products.


HANSON DISTILLERY Most people think vodka and think potatoes or grains. Yet this family-owned company has been crafting small batch vodka from certified organic grapes since 2012, and opened a new distillery in Sonoma two years later. Small batch, indeed - each bottle is hand-stamped and signed, and you can tour the distillery to see how the spirits are carefully crafted by real people.

Start by sampling the Original Organic vodka. The 80-proof delight is crisp, smooth, and crystal clean, with such silkiness it's easy to drink straight up. But the Hansons also infuse their vodka with organic ginger, mandarin, cucumber, boysenberry, espresso or habanero. The flavors are fabulous. That ginger, for example, leads with a somewhat fiery pepper-lime ginger kick, while the habanero intrigue with a bit of sweetness and lemongrass beneath the flames.

WHAT'S IN SEASON -When

Sonoma Valley is rich in agricultural history.

In the two centuries of settlement by Europeans, Mexicans and Americans, wheat, barley and corn, onions, cabbage, peppers, squash, melons, flax, apples, grapes, strawberries, cheese, olives, cattle, sheep, lavender, and cotton have all been grown here.







Vineyards and wine grapes have become by far the top driver of the regional economy. Also, locally and regionally produced fancy organic cheese, olive oil and produce have become wine-associated agricultural products. And with the bounty of the Pacific Ocean nearby, the area is spoiled for choice when it comes to seafood.

Toulze opened the restaurant in its original location in Glen Ellen in 1997 and moved it to its current location in 2000. Over 21 years later, they reflect on being proud to be part of a thriving community in Sonoma and on what they feel is an incredible place to live and do business in. Their other business include the fig café in Glen Ellen, the girl & the fig CATERS!, a pop-up space called Suite D and a Food Truck called the fig rig.

If you haven't already eaten at the girl & the fig, don't wait, you will be welcomed into a busy, comfortable restaurant and meeting spot with muted yellow and green tones, great tunes that fill the air, the smell of something delicious coming from the kitchen and a smile from the staff that reinforced your decision to eat here.

We were able to catch Sondra and John for a few minutes between events and a busy lunch service to listen to some of their dialogue regarding their past 25 years working together. Here is a small snapshot of what we learned.

How did the two of you happen to meet and work together?

SONDRA: We met at Viansa Winery when we were both working there. We had a connection and a shared work ethic. When I decided to venture out on my own. I asked John to come help me open the restaurant and work with me to create something fun.

JOHN: She needed my special talents (he laughs) and since I was still getting my accounting degree, I figured why not give it a try.

What is your favorite menu item?

JOHN: Our charcuterie plate is really a highlight for me. We have been making charcuterie for as long as we have been open. Over the past ten years, we have fine-tuned our cured meat program and I am really proud of our techniques and the results we are able to offer our guests. Knowing that we are starting with the best ingredients doesn't hurt either.

SONDRA: That's a tough question. It really depends on my mood and cravings, but there are a handful of menu items that never come off like our Pernod scented mussels, or our duck confit and of course the fig and arugula salad. I really believe that when we are using the best ingredients, we just need to step out of the way and let the flavors shine. Less is best.

What would you recommend to a first time guest?

SONDRA: I would suggest that they try to get a full experience and by that I mean, sample a Rhône -Alone wine flight, taste some of our local cheeses, a signature menu item like the steak tartare or the flounder and finish it off with some lavender creme brulée. I would also encourage them to sit outside on a beautiful

JOHN: I agree with Sondra but if they are in the mood for a quick meal or something more casual, I may suggest our burger with bacon and an egg. The beef comes from one of our neighbors. And for sure our french fries. I would encourage them to have a pint of Pliny too.

What is next for you two?

JOHN: Well, you never know. We love being busy, being able to show off the Sonoma bounty and putting people to work. We are doing our share to contribute to the local economy.

SONDRA: After 21 years, I am content enjoying what we have created and if another tempting project comes our way, well you just never know!



The Sonoma Valley offers a cornucopia of farmer's markets, from the year-round Sonoma Valley Certified Farmer's Market on Fridays in the Arnold Field parking lot to Sonoma's Tuesday Night Market on the Plaza (May-October) and The Springs Community Farmers Market in Boyes Hot Springs on Sundays (June-December). It's a pleasure to support these hardworking farmers and to buy our food locally. You'll have a lot more fun if you understand a few basic do's and don'ts, the farmers will appreciate your savvy, and you'll be able to build a great relationship with the neighbor growing your food.

Given all the fun that surrounds Sonoma Valley's farmers markets—particularly the Tuesday Night Market on the Plaza—there may be a temptation to treat the market like it's a party. Just remember that this is a work night for the farmers, and they really appreciate people customers who navigate the market with these seven simple rules, all endorsed by Sonoma's beloved Hilda Swartz, longtime Manager and Fairy Godmother of the Sonoma Valley Certified Farmers and Valley of the Moon Certified Farmers Markets.

1. BE AN EARLY BIRD, BUT NOT TOO EARLY:

Early in the morning, farmers are busy setting up their tables and displaying their goods before the market's start, but if you arrive on the earlier side of the official market hours, you're guaranteed to get the first pick of all the beautiful produce. "It's worth the effort to come early," said Hilde, "but the customers are really pushing us on Friday mornings," said Hilda. "We're grateful for their enthusiasm, but we really need to make sure the farmers are set up first."

2. COME PREPARED: For easy and speedy transactions, come prepared with cash (small denominations, please!) and reusable shopping bags or baskets. Farmers are bound to their tables

for the entirety of the market, so leaving to get change or search for a bag is a big inconvenience. Forgot yours at home? No worries. Hilda mentioned that mesh vegetable sacks will soon be available for purchase for cost at the Friday market.

3. SEASONAL MEANS OF THE SEASON: Our farmers always bring the freshest, seasonal California-grown produce to the market, so when you ask for acorn squash in May or tomatoes in December, just be warned: you may get a few strange looks. Check out CUESA's Vegetable Seasonality Chart for some ideas before you go.




- 4. SAMPLE WITH DIGNITY: We all know the people who use confuse food samples with lunch. The farmers do, too—too many, in fact. Ask politely for a sample before grabbing one, and please treat it as a taste of their goods, not a meal. That means no seconds or double-dipping—we see you!
- 5. ASK GOOD QUESTIONS: Curious about one of those crazy Buddha Hand citrons? Never tried cranberry beans before? Don't know the difference between sustainable and organic farming? Just ask. But please be mindful of your timing. Having a table full of customers is a tough time for farmers to answer too many questions.
- 6. HAGGLING IS BAD MANNERS: Farmers work hard to set their pricing. If you wouldn't haggle in a supermarket, you shouldn't haggle at a farmer's market. However, if you show up in the last few minutes of the market, some farmers may be willing to give you a discount—at their discretion, of course.
- 7. KEEP YOUR KIDDIES ON THEIR BEST BEHAVIOR AND KEEP YOUR DOGS AT **HOME:** Got a sick toddler who loves touching things? Please keep their hands off the table. Have a puppy who wants to come along for the adventure? Unless they are a leashed and certified service dog, the law says they aren't allowed on market grounds-and this includes the Plaza, too.

"Remember, support your local farmers!" Hilda said. "We are fortunate to have a lot of small local farmers in Sonoma County. And if you haven't tried our dates yet, come sample the 27 different varietals of organic dates we now have at the Friday market. They're delicious!"





SONOMA OVERLOOK

TRAIL: A local's favorite, the Overlook Trail is walking distance to Sonoma's historic Plaza, with Valley views rolling all the way out to Mount Tamalpais in neighboring Marin County. Hike the three-mile (roundtrip) trail and take a break at one of the stone benches. For a slightly longer hike, connect to the Valley of the Moon Trail in neighboring Montini Open Space Preserve.



SUGARLOAF RIDGE STATE PARK: This

3,900-acre haven straddling the Sonoma and Napa valleys offers spectacular panoramas of both-and beyond, with views as far as San Francisco and the Sierra Nevada mountains. A waterfall and nearby wineries are a bonus!

SONOMA VALLEY **REGIONAL PARK:** Oak

woodland, wildflowers, and a large reservoir with trails all around it are just a few features that make Sonoma Valley Regional Park so special. The 202-acre park has miles of hiking options, with hidden picnic spots under oaks and high on ridges overlooking the rolling landscape.

JACK LONDON STATE HISTORIC PARK:


Named after the legendary adventure writer who once lived here, Jack London State Park has miles of hiking trails up to fantastic vineyard vistas rolling right down to San Pablo Bay. There's also a short hike under redwoods to the ruins of Jack London's dream home, Wolf House, which mysteriously burned down before he could move in. Bonus audio-tour available!

QUARRYHILL **BOTANICAL GARDEN:**

Hidden away on the western slope of Sonoma Valley's Mayacamas Mountains, Quarryhill's 25 acres of gardens sprawl over the hillside connected by a variety of trails and include flowering shrubs, exotic shade trees, tranquil ponds, and two waterfalls. Picnic tables are hidden throughout and the view from the topmarked by Himalayan prayer flags—overlooks Sonoma Valley.

HOOD MOUNTAIN **REGIONAL PARK:**

Hiking to Hood Mountain's Gunsight Rock Overlook (2,730 feet) is a rite of passage, offering an amazing view of Sonoma Valley's crescent shape, all the way out to the bay and San Francisco's Golden Gate Bridge. But you have to work for it! The 3.5-mile (one-way) hike to the top is all about the climb—nearly 2,000 feet of it.



town of Sonoma was founded in 1835 by General Mariano Vallejo, and his

home is now a California State Park that will reward history lovers with its beauty, well-displayed artifacts of the General's life, and it's calm and peaceful setting against the Mayacamas Mountains. (I should note that two of General Vallejo's daughters married two of my sons in the wedding of the century, or at least the wedding of the century as far as Sonoma was concerned.)

It's only a few blocks from the Sonoma Plaza, where the San Francisco Solano Mission was begun on its north-east corner in 1823. Also a California State Park (and accessible on the same \$3 ticket for adults) the Mission is a must-see for heritage and cultural tourists. Of the 21 Franciscan Missions in California, there are only two State Parks, and ours does an excellent job of explaining why the Mission was founded, what life was like for the Native Americans who became "neophytes," and why it closed just 12 years later.

Across the street is the Barracks, the last of the trio of California State Parks in our history-rich city. This is where General Vallejo kept his troops; make sure you visit the gift shop, in the back is the best selection of local history books in town. Of course the Plaza itself is a historic destination, laid out by General Vallejo; it is largest Plaza of any city in California.

This is because the General himself was a larger-than-life character, and did almost everything BIG. Born with the horse and candle in 1807, and dying with the automobile and the electric light in 1890, Vallejo was the link between a pastoral and calm Mexican California, and a modern future as the 31st American state.

And of course, the Sonoma Valley has historic wineries as well. Just four blocks east of the Plaza is Sebastiani Winery, founded in 1904 by an Italian immigrant, Samuele Sebastiani. Another half mile east will take you to Buena Vista Winery, founded in 1857 myself, Count Agoston Haraszthy. This winery features the first wine caves in California, and the first stone winery buildings built in front of them. Another half mile will take you to Gundlach Bundschu Winery, founded by a German, Jacob Gundlach, just a year later in 1858. Amazingly, the same family owns the winery to this day; and its beautiful surroundings and historic cave will reward both wine and history lovers.

Heading back to the Plaza, you could stop in at the Plaza Bistro, where you may enjoy a beer at the oldest bar in town. It came around Cape Horn in 1874; Jack London hoisted more than a few at this ornate beauty. His historic Beauty Ranch is only a 20-minute drive from the Plaza; it is now called Jack London State Historic Park, where fortunate visitors may hike, bike, ride horses, watch birds, paint pictures, picnic, relax, learn, and enjoy the serene beauty of surrounding Sonoma Mountain.

While our town has 200-year-old adobe buildings and weathered clapboard saloons, Sonoma's present is tomorrow's history, with new waves of innovators, farmers and artists making their mark. Maybe in 100 years we'll be writing about your accomplishments in the Valley of the Moon? That history remains to be written...

The Sonoma Barracks

4 HISTORIC SITES YOU CAN WALK TO FROM SONOMA PLAZA

As the birthplace of both California wine country and the state of California, the town of Sonoma offers a lot of history that can be enjoyed in a short amount of time. Here's a fun walking tour to four historic sites in Sonoma. It's about two miles round trip, which can also be an easy bicycle ride.

Start on the northeast edge of the Sonoma Plaza, at the corner of East Spain Street and First Street East:



Founded July 4, 1823, this was the last mission built in California. Now part of Sonoma State Historic Park, it offers exhibits on mission life, religious paintings, and beautiful framed watercolors of all the California missions. An altar decorated in the style of the mission era fills one end of the chapel. Admission is \$3, which includes same-day entry to other state park sites.

Moving on: Leaving the Mission, turn right and go west on Spain Street, passing the Sonoma Barracks, the Toscano Hotel, and an open courtyard with signs explaining local history (all of which are worth exploring). Walk a little over two blocks to Third Street West and turn right onto the long, tree-shaded driveway leading to General Vallejo's home.

GENERAL MARIANO GUADALUPE VALLEJO'S HOME

The beautiful two-story, Gothic-style, Victorian house in the center of this property was imported from New England in 1851. A half-timbered building at the entrance serves as a museum, with fascinating displays of photos and everyday items, including the family carriage. The main house and several outbuildings are decorated as if the family and staff have just stepped out, and a printed guide sheet makes it easy to explore the property on your own. Admission is \$3, but a receipt from the mission gives you sameday entry here.

Moving on: Go part-way back down the driveway, and turn left (east) on the paved hiking/biking trail. After you cross First Street West, you can't miss the three train cars on the right, which are parked behind the next destination.







DEPOT PARK MUSEUM This small gem of a museum by the Sonoma Valley Historical Society offers permanent and temporary exhibits exploring Sonoma's rich and vibrant history. Housed in an authentic train depot, it displays just a portion of the society's rich collection of local artifacts. It includes a permanent exhibit of the history of Sonoma's railroads and hosts an annual model train show in December. Free admission; donations welcome. Note: Only open 1-4 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. You might catch some locals playing pétanque at the courts near the train cars outside.

Moving on: Continue east on the hiking/biking trail to where it ends on Fourth Street East, and turn right.

SEBASTIANI VINEYARDS

& WINERY Founded in 1904, this winery offers a lively and casual tasting bar inside a historic high-ceilinged stone building. You can purchase crackers, cheese, and other gourmet nibbles, and the shady circular courtyard out front is lined with tables and chairs, making it a perfect place to relax, eat, and sip. Don't miss the barrel room, with its beautifully carved antique redwood barrels. A variety of other tour and tasting experiences are offered.

Moving on: From the winery, go left (south) on Fourth Street East and then right (west) on East Spain Street; it's three blocks back to the starting point.



OTHER POSSIBILITIES The eight-acre Sonoma Plaza includes a monument to the Raising of the Bear Flag on June 14, 1846 (declaring Sonoma a short-lived independent republic) and a statue of General Vallejo sitting on a park bench (a popular spot for selfies). Restaurants, tasting rooms, and intriguing stores surround the Plaza, offering something for everyone.

About two miles east of the Plaza, Buena Vista Winery is California's oldest premium winery, and about three miles southeast of Sonoma Plaza, Gundlach Bundschu Winery is California's oldest family-owned winery.

And about nine miles northwest of the Plaza, Jack London State Historic Park offers insights into the celebrated author's life on his beloved Beauty Ranch, plus 29 miles of hiking trails.

NICK BRANDT: Inherit the Dustm, June 29 - September 8, 2019 Photographer Nick Brandt presents a series of epic panoramic landscapes in Inherit the Dust. Brandt photographs animals in their natural habitats and then returns a few years later to shoot the same sites. But with rapid

industrial development taking place, these lands have already been laid to waste, and the animals that once roamed freely are gone. In a feat of rephotography, Brandt photographs the site again, this time with one

of his monumental portraits standing in for the animal. Brandt's work serves as a potent reminder of the effects of rampant industrialization, habitat loss, and climate change.

BINGO: The Life and Art of Bernice Bing, September 21 - January 5, 2020

San Francisco native, Chinese American artist, and community activist, Bernice Bing was a bridge between many worlds She came of age during the Beat era and entered the San Francisco arts landscape in the 1960s with paintings that synthesize abstract expressionism with Chinese calligraphy. Bing drew on both her Chinese background and her American upbringing, "to find what is good within both the cultures," resulting in work that resonates on several levels. As a Chinese American artist reclaiming the style of Abstract Expressionism, and redefining its ties to non-western philosophies and aesthetics, she brings to light connections which have too long been overlooked.





Over the years, Sonoma's arts community has been the cultural heartbeat of the Valley, having nurtured artists, actors and musicians.

The Sonoma Valley Museum of Art, just off the Plaza, has a collection of fine art and interactive educational programs that make the intimate venue a must-see

But it's not just the museum that nurtures the arts. Sonoma itself plays muse yearly as renowned painters flock to the valley for Sonoma Plein Air, a celebration of the centuries-old technique of painting on an easel outdoors. During the weeklong celebration distinguished artists can be seen in fields and vineyards with brush in hand, capturing the splendor of Sonoma Valley.

You can find art every day in the Valley of the Moon: Discover local artists' unique galleries and art shops, or participate in a workshop to paint, mold, photograph or weave your own creation. 



On the wine side, Larson Family Winery is fun for the entire family, perfect for a picnic and a round of bocce. You may even be greeted by one of the winery's three brand ambassadors, who also happen to be the family's three pet Labrador retriever dogs.





The Sonoma Plaza is a good spot to let the kids run in the eight-acre park, playing on the playgrounds and watching the ducks swim in the duck pond. Lay out a blanket, grab some food or snacks (cheese, chocolate and ice cream aplenty) from one of the nearby shops, pop open a bottle of wine, and enjoy a family afternoon in wine country.

Families can also participate in bike tours (parents can taste wine and kids can enjoy the cheese samples), or spend time in any number of state parks just a stone's throw from the Historic Sonoma Plaza.

Speaking of wine and history, give the kids an educational tour of the California missions at Cline Cellars, an historic display of all 21 California missions, that were built in 1939 for the World's Fair in San Francisco.
