Our guides (50,000 copies) will be distributed throughout Northern California, and to travelers, and meetings and wedding planners, as well as digitally on sonomavalley.com.

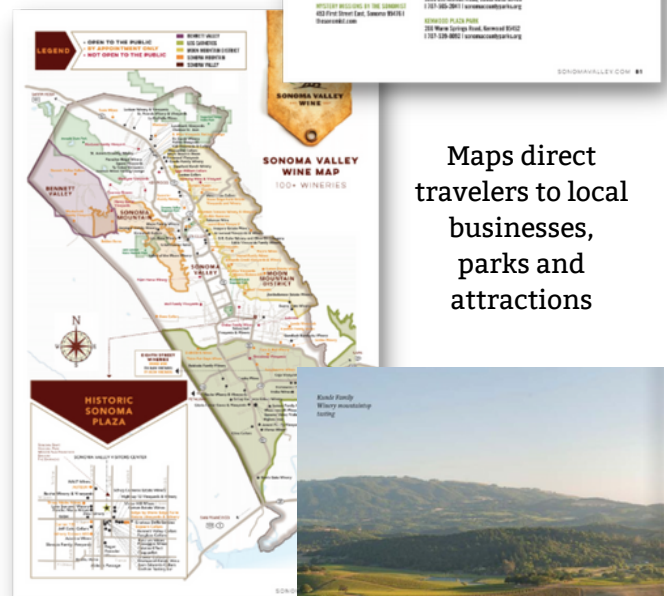
