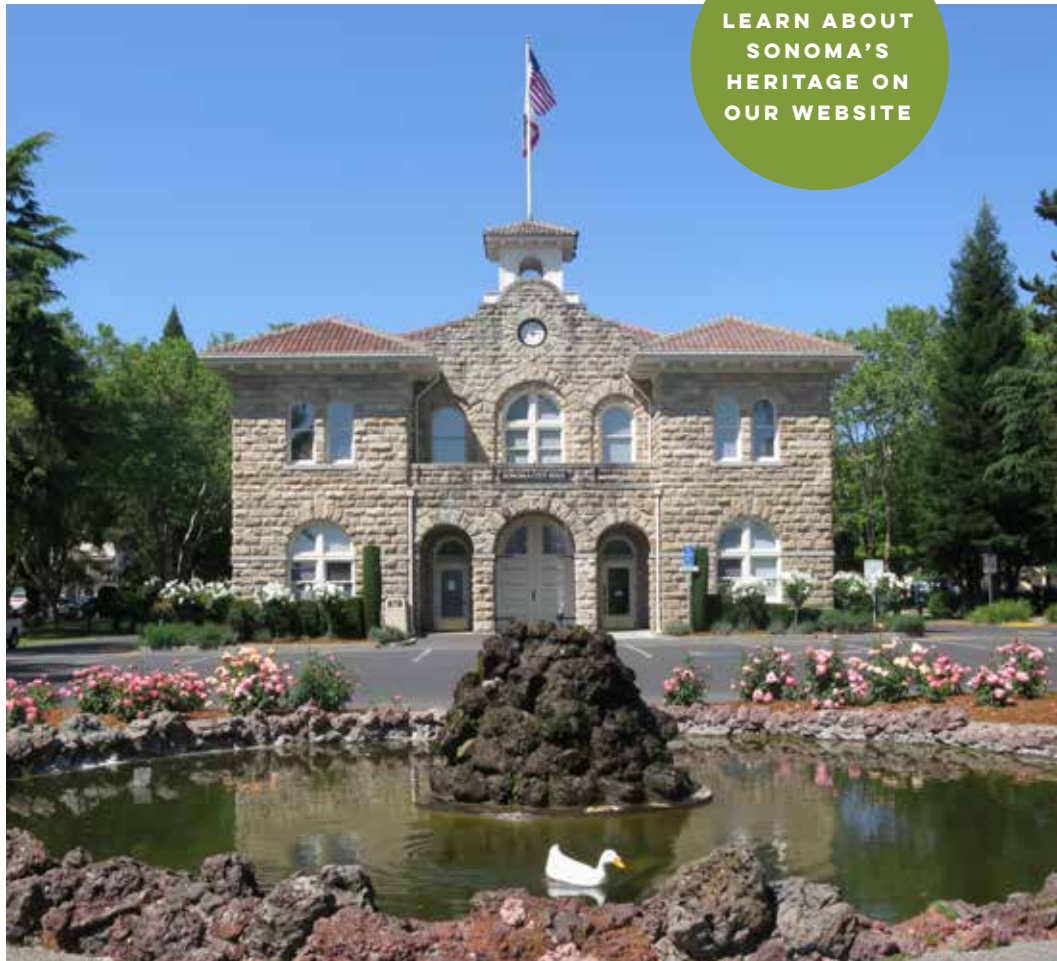


SONOMA'S HISTORIC PLAZA

Where else could California become its own country? Sonoma Plaza is a glittering microcosm of the West's colorful past — from its days as a Mexican outpost to its role as a Spanish Mission town and fleeting frontier republic. At one point or another, Miwok Indians, Spanish Missionaries, Mexican generals, American adventurers, outlaws, farmers, fortune seekers and eccentrics all called Sonoma home.

Now a gorgeous historic landmark, Sonoma Plaza is a one-of-a-kind gem that radiates romance around every corner, cafe and cobblestone. This is where small-town authenticity, old-world ambience and cosmopolitan sophistication truly intertwine—a setting where horses graze near an artisan cheese shop, four-star chefs pick their own tomatoes and world-class winemakers picnic in the park.

Adding to the appeal is the fact that Sonoma was recently named one of the “friendliest” cities in America by Conde Nast Traveler. It's a destination that's as gracious as it is gorgeous. And Sonoma Plaza's pedestrian paradise isn't just friendly—it's family friendly, so ditch the car keys, grab the kids and discover Sonoma Valley's historic heart on foot, bicycle or playground swing.

SONOMA'S BELOVED MISSION

It's a time-worn treasure worth visiting on the northeast corner of Sonoma's Plaza—the Mission San Francisco Solano de Sonoma.

It was founded in 1823 and marked the northern end of “The King's Highway,” El Camino Real. The Sonoma Mission was the dedicated goal of Padre Jose Altimira, who found his ideal location in Sonoma.

He blessed the site on July 4, 1823. The new mission was named San Francisco Solano in honor of the missionary to the Indians of Peru.

The padres' quarters, attached to the right of the present adobe church, is the oldest structure in Sonoma, dating back to approximately 1825.

The present adobe church was built by General Vallejo in 1840.

The historic Sonoma Mission is now part of the California State Parks system. This site is still in use today, offering historical and educational tours and hosting both public and private events and ceremonies.

SITE OF THE BEAR FLAG REVOLT

American settlers swarmed into California during the early 1840s, but the Mexican government prohibited them from owning land or holding office. Tension mounted, and during the summer of 1846, a rag-tag band of Americans set out to change things.

Thirty rough-and-ready horsemen from the Sacramento Valley rode into Sonoma at dawn on June 14. They arrested General Vallejo and his men, hoisted a hastily made Bear Flag of the Republic at the northeast corner of the Plaza and declared California an independent republic—all without firing a shot.

But the fledgling republic was to last only 25 days. On July 7, an American naval vessel captured the Mexican capital at Monterey and claimed all of California for the United States. The Bear Flag came down, and up went the Stars and Stripes. In 1911, the Bear Flag officially became the California State Flag. The monument to the Bear Flag Revolt can be found in the northeast quadrant of the Sonoma Plaza park.

THE HOME OF GENERAL VALLEJO

General Mariano Vallejo's "Lachryma Montis" is a tribute to the indomitable spirit and adaptability of this remarkable man.

With the coming of American rule, the former Mexican commandante embraced a new way of life. He built this classic, Yankee-style, two-story Gothic as his permanent home in 1851.

Abundant springs on the hillside gave the place its name. The Indians called it "Chiucuyem" after an ancient legend. Vallejo

translated this into Latin, Lachryma Montis, meaning "Tears of the Mountain."

With a steep-pitched roof and dormer windows, the Vallejo home stands at the end of a long, lovely lane bordered by shade trees. It is a prefabricated structure, built of spruce and shipped around the Horn.

HOME OF JACK LONDON

Here at Jack London's beloved Beauty Ranch in Sonoma Valley, the famed author spent his final years.

2016 marked the 100th Anniversary of Jack London's passing and the park hosts events throughout the year.

His land became his passion. He loved exploring the Valley on horseback and, as he put it: "When I first came here, tired of cities and people, I settled down... on some of the most beautiful, primitive land to be found in California."

Today, 800 spectacular acres comprise the state historic park. Here you can hike, picnic or bike among the trees; examine Jack London memorabilia and historic sites; or ride on horseback up a three-mile trail to the summit of Sonoma Mountain for a magnificent view.

London brought new fame to the region in *The Valley of the Moon* (1913), in which he perpetuated an Indian legend that claims Sonoma means "many moons."

The park is a continuing memorial to a remarkable author, farmer and adventurer.

- Merge onto US-101 S via the ramp to San Francisco6.4 miles
- Take the State Hwy 12 exit toward Sebastopol/Sonoma0.2 miles
- Keep right at the fork to continue toward CA-12 E. 381 ft
- Keep left at the fork, follow signs for State Hwy 12/Sonoma
and merge onto CA-12 E 1.9 miles

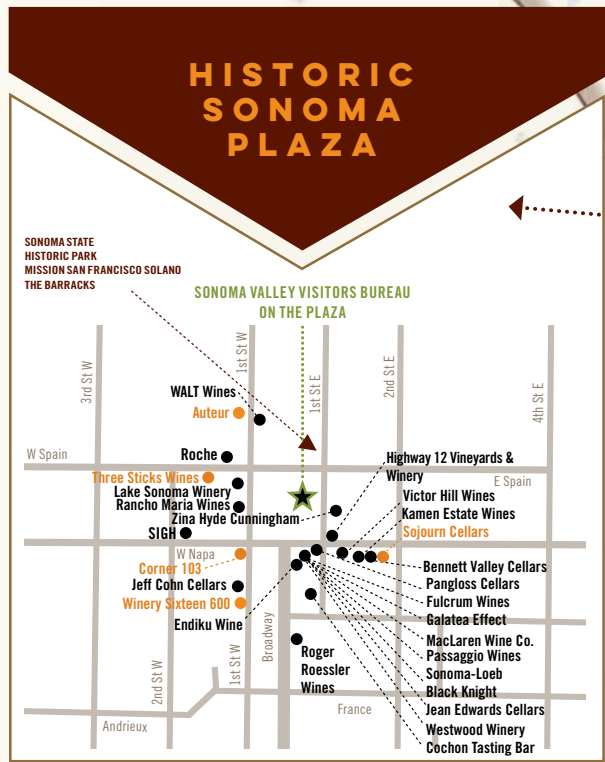

WHY/WHEN DID YOU OPEN CORNER 103, AND HOW DID YOU COME UP WITH THE CONCEPT?

I opened Corner 103 on April 20, 2015. Too many people rely on their “wine expert” friends to tell them what is good. I want my guests to understand that they are a “wine expert,” because everyone knows what they like and don’t like.

WHAT IS INVOLVED IN A TASTING AT CORNER 103?

You will enjoy seven multiple award-winning wines, six of which are paired with a two bite food item. All of our wines are served in the “appropriate” wine glass and we explain why glassware makes a difference in how you smell and taste wine. We take you through how to taste wine and demonstrate how food can change the flavor profile of wine and how wine can change the flavor profile of food. We teach you how to best pair wine and food for your palate! Our goal is to make sure that when you finish this experience, you will be able to impress yourself and friends with the depth of your wine knowledge.

WHY DO YOU THINK PEOPLE ENJOY THE FOOD/WINE PAIRINGS YOU LEAD?

Because we make it fun! We do our best to make our guests feel relaxed and comfortable. There is no tasting bar at Corner 103, all of our tastings are seated and one-on-one. We never have large groups. We try to keep the size of our groups to 4 or less. This ensures a more casual and intimate wine tasting experience.

TELL US ABOUT YOUR WINES

I produce approximately 2,000 cases of wine per year. All of my wines have won multiple wine competition awards and come from vineyards located in Sonoma County. I grow my grapes in the AVA (American Viticultural Area) where the grapes grow best. This ensures that I have amazing fruit, which translates into making amazing wines.

TELL US ABOUT YOURSELF

I am originally from New York City. I spent over 30 years in the financial service industry where I provided capital for my clients to buy and build companies. I came to Sonoma in 2006 to fix an investment that went bad. In doing so, I fell out of love with my financial life and fell in love with wine country and the art of wine making! Many people tried to get me to leave New York but it took “wine country living” to make me move west!

I immediately understood the potential to create brilliant wines in Sonoma – and it was the perfect fit for us. In 2003, my wife Laura and I started our brand, Auteur, and the roots were laid. We are raising our two daughters here in the valley ever since and couldn't be happier.

YOU HAVE QUITE A REPUTATION IN THE VALLEY, HOW DO YOU MAKE WINES THAT CONTINUE TO RISE ABOVE THE CROWD?

For me, it's embracing all the nuances from each vineyard, that's where individuality comes from and that's what differentiates our wines. We start from the ground up, sourcing from geologically diverse sites looking for distinctive soils planted with the right clonal selections for each micro-coastal climate. It's actually quite technical – and a unique blend of art and science. It's also imperative we work with our winegrowers and vineyard managers to ensure each subplot reaches its full potential. In the cellar we show restraint, keeping the lots small to extract the personality from each site. It's tedious building the framework piece by piece, but that's what I believe makes our wines stand out.

Kenneth collaborates with several premium brands in Sonoma, including Blue Farm, Dunstan and Attune Winery, each having a strong and unique influence on the wine style they produce.

Winemaking is at its most impressive when it begins with site-specific farming, this is the commonality with all my clients in Sonoma. The relationships work because we listen and trust one other. The wines truly capture story and time.

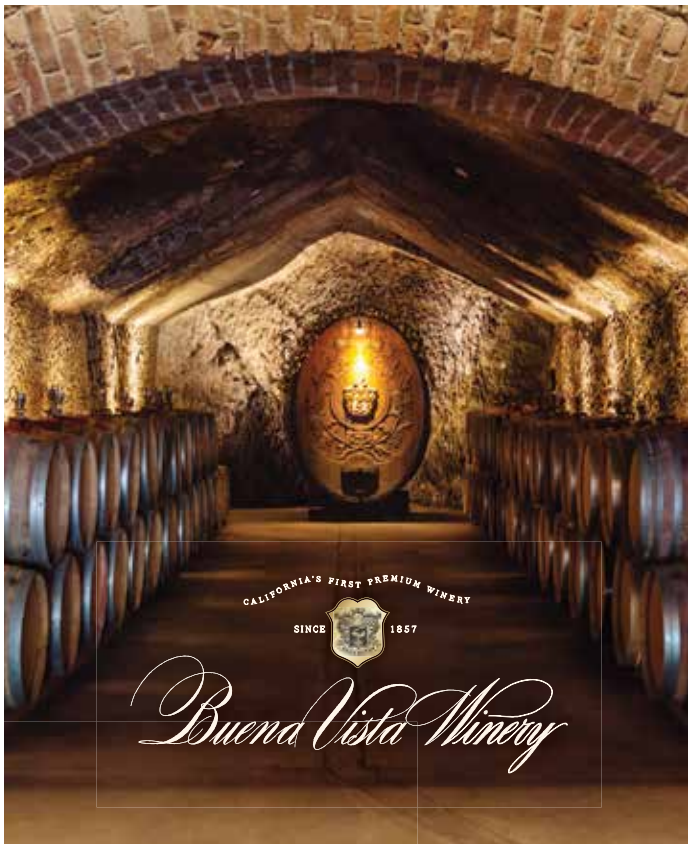

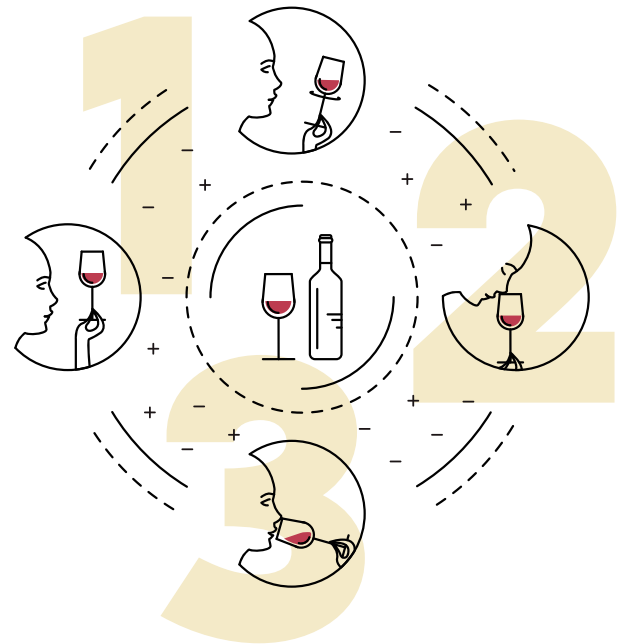

HOW TO TASTE

**BECOME A WINE EXPERT
IN SONOMA VALLEY**

Learning how to taste wines will deepen your appreciation for the deep care given by the winemakers.

LOOK: Take a good look at the glass of wine. Tilt the glass and note the color of the wine against a white background. What color is it? Look for more than red, pink or white. Is the wine watery or dark, translucent or opaque, dull or brilliant, cloudy or clear?

SMELL: Swirl your glass for 10 seconds and then take a quick whiff to gain a first impression. Then bring the glass back up to your nose and inhale. What do you smell? Oak, berry, flowers, vanilla, citrus?

TASTE: Start with a small sip and roll it around your mouth and across your tongue. Ideally alcohol content, tannin levels, acidity and residual sugar will be well-balanced and meld together. What initial impression does the wine make on your palate? Soft or firm, light or heavy, crisp or creamy, sweet or dry?

Next, what is the wine's actual taste on the palate? Do you note fruit, perhaps some spice, or maybe oak, cedar, or earthiness? Finally, how does the wine finish? Can you taste the remnant of the wine on the back of your mouth and throat? What was your last flavor impression – fruit, butter, oak? However, everyone's palate is different!

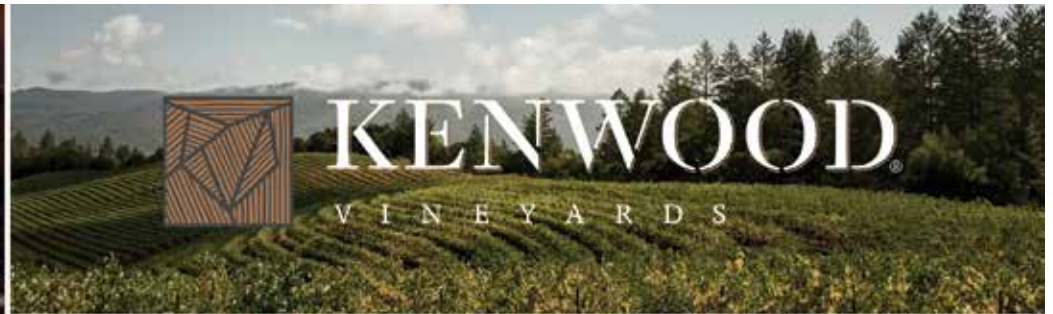

KENWOOD VINEYARDS

The Sonoma spirit of discovery runs deep through Kenwood Vineyards, a spirit defined by an insatiable curiosity, a love for the land and, above all else, a belief that there is always something new to discover.

Kenwood Vineyards stands on the site of one of Sonoma's first tasting rooms. Opened in 1906 by the Pagani brother, the winery was one of only a handful that remained opened throughout Prohibition. In 1970, the winery was sold to brothers Mike and Marty Lee, and their friend John Sheela. They had a deep passion and drive to demonstrate the potential for the Sonoma region to produce premium, expressive wines. Fig & Arugula Salad
serves 6

For the vinaigrette:

- Or order online!
- 3 dried Black Mission figs
- 1 cup ruby port
- ¼ cup red wine vinegar
- ½ tablespoon minced shallots
- ¼ cup blended oil
- Salt and pepper to taste

To prepare the vinaigrette:

Pour the port in a bowl, add the figs, and rehydrate until soft. Transfer the port and figs to a saucepan. Reduce the port over medium heat to ½ cup, about 5 to 7 minutes. Transfer the port mixture to a food processor and add the vinegar. Purée until smooth. Add the shallots and slowly whisk in the oil. Season to taste with salt and pepper to taste.

For the salad:

- ½ cup pancetta, diced
- 12 fresh figs, halved
- 6 bunches baby arugula
- 1 cup pecans, toasted
- 1 cup goat cheese, crumbled (preferably Laura Chenel Chèvre)
- Freshly ground black pepper to taste

To prepare the salad:

Sauté the pancetta in a small sauté pan over medium heat until the pancetta is crisp. Set the pancetta aside, reserving the “oil.” Brush the figs with the pancetta “oil.” Grill the figs for 45 seconds on each side. In a stainless-steel bowl, toss the arugula, pecans, pancetta, and goat cheese with the vinaigrette.

To serve:

Divide the salad among 6 chilled plates and surround it with the grilled figs. Grind the pepper over each salad.

Food For Thought: If fresh figs are not in season, substitute good-quality, moist dried figs. Grilling dried figs is not recommended; just cut them into small pieces and toss with other ingredients.

A Q&A WITH OWNER SAUL GROPMAN

WHY DID YOU OPEN CAFÉ LA HAYE AND HOW LONG HAS IT BEEN OPEN?

Cafe La Haye opened July 3, 1996. I had moved to Sonoma in the first half of 1995 with no intentions of opening a restaurant. I had been a partner in a restaurant South of Market in San Francisco and still teaching half time in the Music Dept. at San Francisco State University. So... opening another restaurant was the last thing on my mind. However, the opportunity arose and I made the jump.

DID YOU HAVE A BACKGROUND IN FOOD?

Although I never had a background in food prior to opening restaurants, I always had a taste for fine foods. Even as a young music student in New York City, I saved up to dine out at wonderful restaurants. Also, my mother was a fabulous cook and baker and I was surrounded by her Gourmet Magazines in the '60s.

HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE THE STYLE OF THE RESTAURANT?

It took years of people asking how I described our cuisine and finally I came up with the description of American Bistro. That is kind of what I had in mind in developing this space and menu. Small, intimate, with a menu that was inspired by the foods of France and Italy. I always wanted it to be the kind of restaurant that you could

easily be comfortable coming on a regular basis.

DO YOU HAVE A FAVORITE DISH THAT ARE ALWAYS ON THE MENU?

Where the core menu is rather concise, we might have 6 to 8 specials on any given night. Our menu is changed seasonally but our specials change daily. My favorite is the Wolfe Ranch Quail. They are beautiful plump birds and the preparation with sourdough stuffing reminds me of my own personal Thanksgiving. Almost everyone raves about our daily preparation of Risotto. And, Executive Chef Jeffrey Lloyd is a master with fish.

WHAT IS YOUR SECRET FOR A SUCCESSFUL RESTAURANT?

If I had to come up with one word that defines a successful restaurant, it would be CONSISTENCY! Restaurants are defined by three areas; Food, Atmosphere and Service. But, the most important aspect is consistency. If you have a dish that excites you, you want to relive that same experience every time you order it again.

IS THERE ONE PERSON THAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO EXPERIENCE CAFÉ LA HAYE WHO WOULD THAT BE?

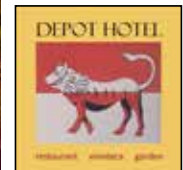

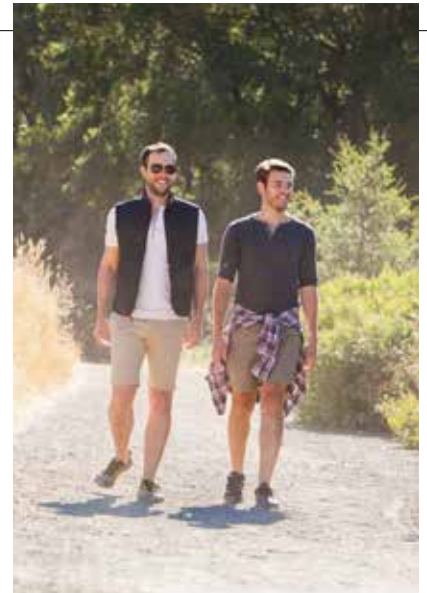

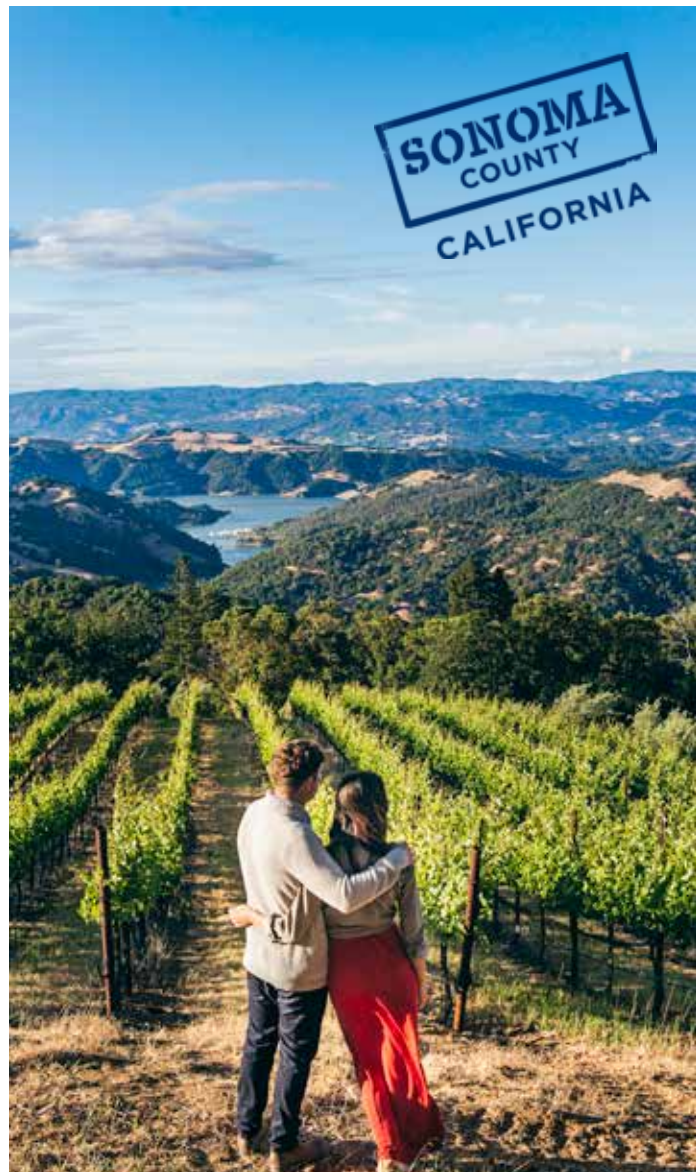
