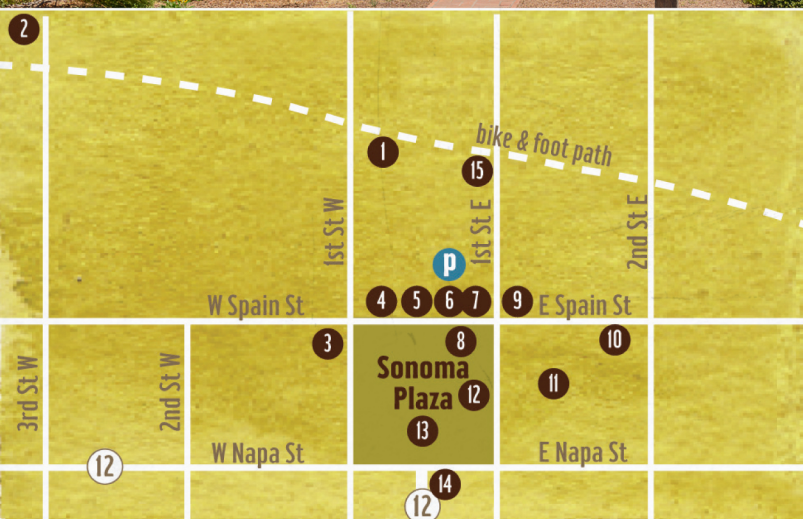


# SONOMA PLAZA HISTORICAL SITES



The Sonoma Plaza, heart of the town's historic district, offers a variety of fine dining and unique shopping experiences. **p free parking** (enter north of #7)

- 1 DEPOT PARK MUSEUM** • First St W in Depot Park • Sonoma Valley History Museum • Open Friday to Sunday 1-4 pm • 707.938.1762 • free • [depotparkmuseum.org](http://depotparkmuseum.org)
- 2 "LACHRYMA MONTIS"** • Home of General M.G. Vallejo, built in 1851-52 • call 707.938.9559 or visit [parks.ca.gov](http://parks.ca.gov) for hours and fees.
- 3 SALVADOR VALLEJO HOME** • 415 First St W • Built by General Vallejo's brother in the early 1840's.
- 4 SWISS HOTEL** • 18 W Spain St • Built in the late 1830's by Salvador Vallejo as his home and converted to a hotel in the late 19th century.
- 5 "CASA GRANDE" SERVANTS QUARTERS** • Site of the first adobe home of General M.G. Vallejo. Built in 1836 while Sonoma was a Mexican pueblo.
- 6 TOSCANO HOTEL** • 20 E Spain St • Built as a general store in the 1850's and converted to a hotel in 1886.
- 7 SONOMA BARRACKS** • Constructed in 1836 by General M.G. Vallejo. • 707.938.1519 • call 707.938.9559 or visit [parks.ca.gov](http://parks.ca.gov) for hours and fees.
- 8 BEAR FLAG MONUMENT** • On June 14, 1846, American horsemen rode into Sonoma, proclaimed the "California Republic", and raised the original Bear Flag.
- 9 MISSION SAN FRANCISCO SOLANO DE SONOMA** • The last of California's 21 missions, built in 1823. • 707.938.9560 • call 707.938.9559 or visit [parks.ca.gov](http://parks.ca.gov) for hours and fees.
- 10 BLUE WING INN** • Built in 1840 by General Mariano Guadalupe Vallejo.
- 11 GENERAL JOSEPH HOOKER HOUSE** • First St E in El Paseo complex • Built in the 1850s for General 'Fighting Joe' Hooker of civil war fame. Now open as a museum of Sonoma Valley history. Open Sat, Sun & Mon, 1-4pm • 707.938.0510
- 12 CARNEGIE LIBRARY** • 453 First St E • First built in 1913, retrofitted in 1997 • Currently the Sonoma Valley Visitors Bureau • Open Daily • 707.996.1090
- 13 CITY HALL** • #1 the Sonoma Plaza • Built in 1908 • 707.938.3681

- 15 MAYSONNAVE HOUSE** • 291 First St E • Built in 1910, Sonoma Heritage Center, Historic Research Library and Museum • Open Wed 11-4 and by appt • 707.938.0169 • free • [sonomaleague.org](http://sonomaleague.org)
