

Bus

Bluestar connects surrounding towns with single fares from £2.60 in the daytime and just £1 after 6pm! Contactless and paperless options available.

Train

Direct links from Bournemouth, Portsmouth, Winchester, and more. Southampton Central is a 10-minute walk to the heart of the city.

Car

Easy access via the M3 and M27, with parking conveniently located around the city centre. Plus, the city's new Park & Ride service at Adanac Drive runs on Saturdays, Sundays, and Bank Holidays (parking just £3). The PR1 shuttle takes you straight to Southampton Central and Westquay, making your trip easier than ever!

Regular Red Funnel crossings from the Isle of Wight for pedestrians and vehicles, both day and night.

E-bikes & scooters

Voi bikes and E-scooters offer eco-friendly rides around town.


