- **Old Hokonui Moonshine Museum & Distillery**
 - Gore's rich history of illegal whiskey production is showcased in this unique museum within the heritage precinct, with the Gore Visitor Centre as its front-of-house entrance.
- **Croydon Aviation Heritage Centre**
 - Mandeville, located about 10 minutes from Gore, is home to Croydon Aircraft Company, known for restoring vintage wood and fabric aircraft from the late 1920s to the 1940s.
