The **Community Veterans Memorial** is the only war memorial that commemorates every U.S. conflict of the 20th century. It tells the story of courageous individuals who survived and those who died serving the United States of America.

The memorial was designed with a vision of peace around three goals: to remember those who served, to educate those alive today, and to challenge individuals who shape the future.

The unique landscape stretches across nine acres and resembles the geography of each war: World Wars I and II, Korea, Vietnam and Desert Storm. Displayed in the park are bronzed sculptures depicting soldiers in action, along with actual wartime artifacts such as a Vietnam-era helicopter, boots, guns and letters written from the home front.
