
All Shook Up

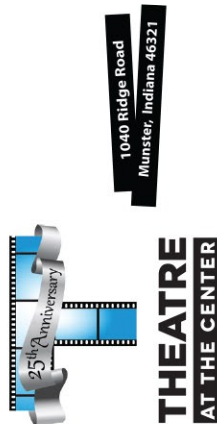

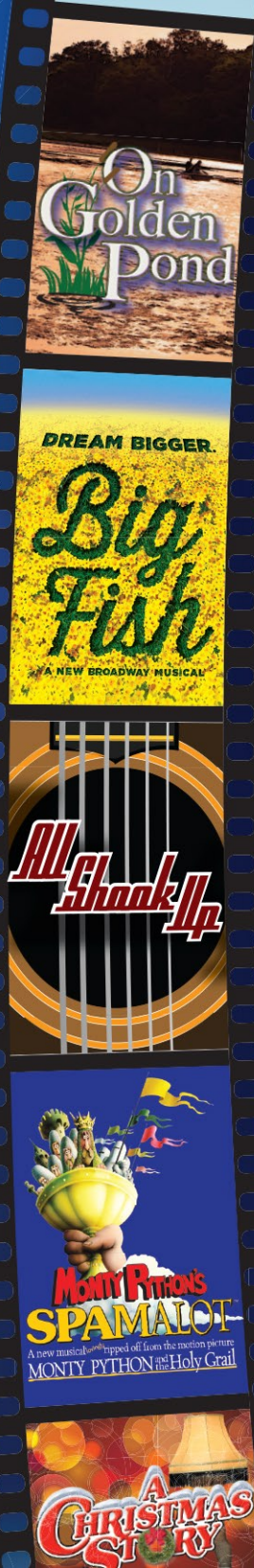
