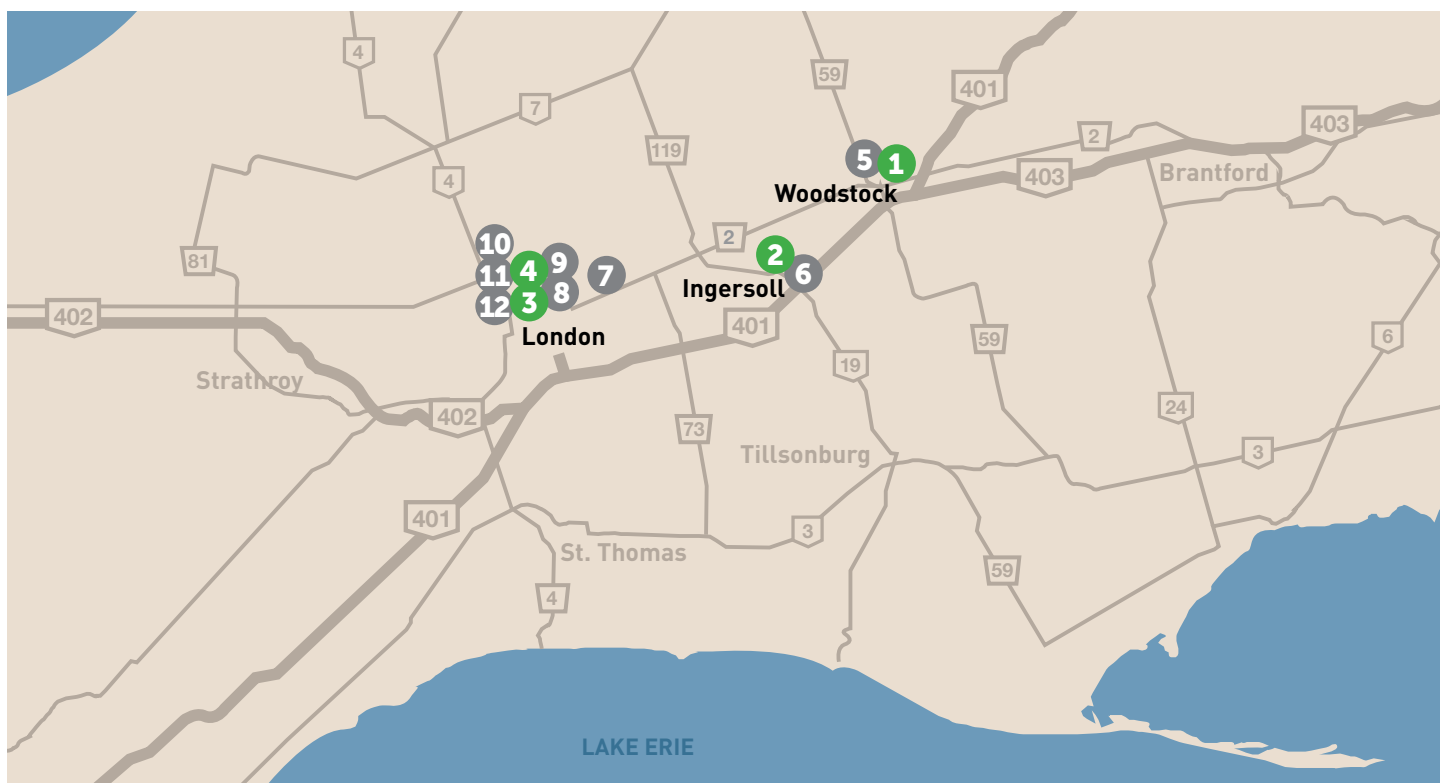

Browse and sample their delicious honey and meads and be sure to take a look at the display beehive where you can watch the bees work their honey-making magic.

Arriving at the winery you'll meet a passionate husband and wife team who have taken a very hands-on approach to building a winery from the ground up. Each harvest season when the grapes are ready, the winery sends out the word and volunteers arrive to pick, bottle and label in return for a delicious home cooked meal. 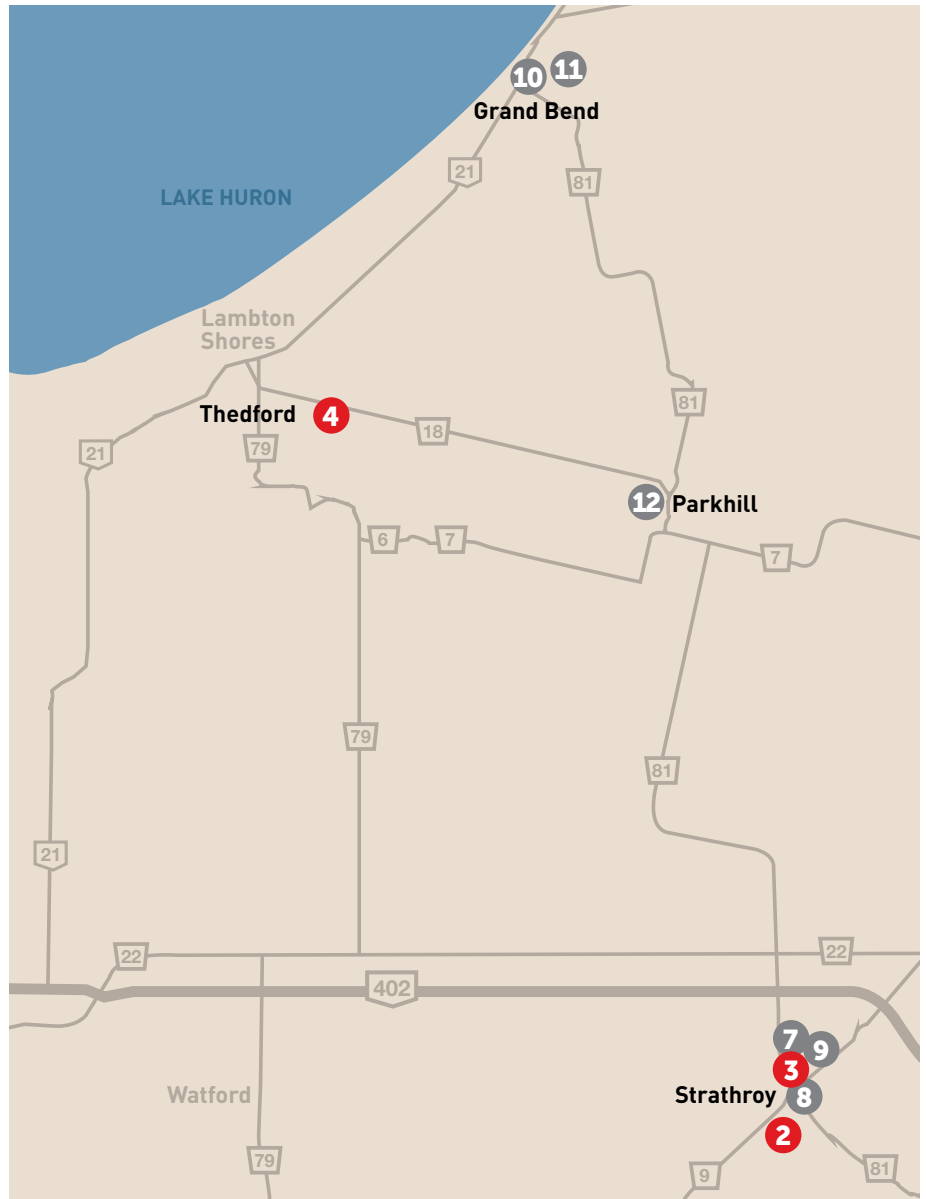

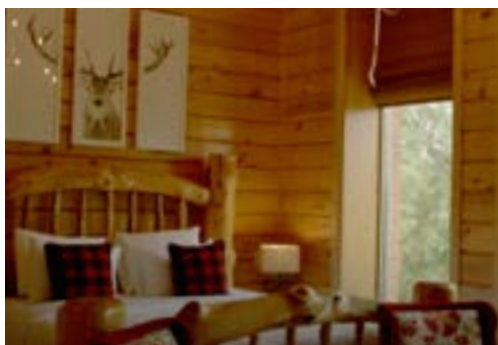
