Located in London's northeast, Fanshawe Conservation Area's 20 km Lake Trail is a directional loop (clockwise on even numbered days, counter-clockwise on odd ones) around Fanshawe Lake. With a number of technical features and great views of the lake, riders shouldn't miss the flowy single track.

Trails: 20 km lake trail. Intermediate, Advanced. [View Fanshawe Lake Trail Map.](#)

Parking: Entrance on Clarke Road, North of Huron Street. Permit parking around the lake is available.

Hours of Operation: Front gates are open 24/7 during camping season.

Fees: \$15 per vehicle for day use pass or \$8 per individual arriving by bike. Permits required.

Onsite conveniences: Washrooms, drinking water, bike wash station and camping.
