

Here you'll find Wisconsin's oldest farmers market (still held in the same spot) and **Stevens Point Brewery** – a community staple since 1857 – along with the other breweries, distilleries, and winery that make up the Central Wisconsin Craft Collective. Come for a tour and a taste! Then test your knowledge at the **World's Largest Trivia Contest**, or visit the home of the first refrigerated salad bar at Sky Club (in a classic Wisconsin supper club, of course!). Order up at **Ruby Coffee**, named the best coffee in Wisconsin by Food & Wine magazine, then explore more local makers from Tapped Maple Syrup to Siren Shrub Company.

No matter the season, head outdoors in the Stevens Point Area! Venture out on the popular 27-mile **Green Circle Trail**, complete with a view. Bike one of Wisconsin's best mountain biking trails at **Standing Rocks County Park** – a mix of old-school and flow trails. Golf **SentryWorld**, which is one of the best public courses in the nation. Explore by paddle or try your hand at fly-fishing the **Tomorrow River**. You can't forget to explore the local art and Insta-worthy spots, with everything from vibrant murals to the **Stevens Point Sculpture Park**.



# Getting Here & Getting Around

## Getting Here


**BY CAR:** Drivers can get to the Stevens Point Area via two major highways: **Highway 10** (east-west) and **Interstate 39** (north-south).

**BY PLANE:** **Central Wisconsin Airport**, out of Mosinee, is just 15 minutes north of Stevens Point. Service is available from major domestic airlines, with connections through Chicago and Minneapolis. Car rentals are available directly at the airport, though reservations are recommended.

**BY BUS:** Ground transportation is available through **Lamers**, with northbound and southbound stops in Stevens Point daily. The bus offers connections to Wausau, Waupaca, Appleton, Oshkosh, Fond du Lac, and Milwaukee. **Coach USA/Van Galder** runs daily to and from Madison with multiple stops along the northbound and southbound route.

## Getting Around

It is easy to get around the Stevens Point Area by car, by bike, or on foot. Public transportation is available through **Stevens Point Transit**, with most of the urban area included. The normal bus fare is only \$1.25 and late-night routes are available. Taxi service and ride-sharing are also available. 🌲



# What's New in the 715



Adding to the vibrancy of downtown is a brand-new mural located behind **Guu's on Main**. Created by local artist Jeni Lila, the piece honors our aviation history in the Stevens Point Area.

Downtown Stevens Point has welcomed some fresh new faces recently and, in 2026, a few will be marking their first years in business.

**Sister's Corner Store** brings locally owned convenience to the neighborhood, **Caed Confections** delights with handcrafted sweets, and **Retro Central** blends vintage charm with modern finds.

Together, these exciting additions bring more personality to the heart of downtown.

On campus, **UW-Stevens Point** continues to grow and evolve. The new **Health and Wellness Center** opened in 2025, offering both students and the community a welcoming space that is focused on well-being.

Looking ahead, the former **Albertson Hall**, a beloved campus landmark, is being reimaged from the ground up. The new **Library and Student Resource Center** will reopen in 2026 with a grand celebration, ready to inspire and serve the next generation of learners.

Thirsty? **Point Brewery**, in partnership with UW-Stevens Point Athletics, introduced **Pointers All-American Beer**. Additionally, in a nod to its history, Point Brewery, which survived Prohibition by adding sodas to its menu, is now producing non-alcoholic options of your favorite brews.

Another local favorite brewer is making moves – **Central Waters** is stirring things up with the launch of a new spirits line,

debuting its Great Blue straight bourbon whiskey.

The **Food + Farm Exploration Center** recently added an educational **Greenhouse** to its property, offering a year-round haven for families, garden enthusiasts, and food lovers to experience the magic of growing food up close!

From educational programs to hands-on experiences, the space is designed to highlight the roots of local agriculture and inspire new conversations around sustainability.

Now you can enjoy twice the mental, physical, and social benefits of Stevens Point's **Nordic Night Sauna**. That is because the first authentic wood-fired public sauna in the

area is adding a second sauna to its original location downtown.

Happy anniversary! 2026 marks milestone years for events and businesses alike.

For instance, the **Stevens Point Area Convention & Visitors Bureau** has now been serving the local visitor economy in the area for 40 years.

Speaking of big anniversaries, don't miss the 100<sup>th</sup> year of the **Portage County Fair** in Rosholt. One of the region's most beloved traditions, the fair continues to honor its rich history while bringing people together.

This year also marks the **20th Annual River Run**, a community favorite that combines fitness, fun, and (of course) beer. 🍷

### WHAT IS THE BEST BUILDING ON CAMPUS AND WHY?

**Stevie Pointer (SP):** “The Chem Bio Building is hands-down one of the coolest spots on campus! It feels like a mini tropical getaway where you can see plants from all over the world.”

Venture to the **Chemistry Biology Building** for a tropical oasis, no matter the season. Here you'll find the **Tropical Conservatory**, featuring a variety of biomes, water features, and a green wall.

### IF SOMEONE COULD ONLY SEE ONE THING ON CAMPUS, WHAT SHOULD THEY SEE?

**SP:** “You've got to check out the programs at the **Allen F. Blocher Planetarium** or the **Arthur J. Pejsa Observatory!**”

On clear nights, the observatory offers a close-up view of the night sky. Regardless of weather and atmospheric conditions, the planetarium offers a better understanding of our universe. Don't miss the annual laser light shows set to music.

### WHERE'S THE FIRST PLACE YOU TAKE YOUR FRIENDS AND FAMILY WHEN THEY VISIT?

**SP:** “I love taking friends and family for a walk around **Schmeckle Reserve**. It's such a beautiful spot right by campus.”

More than half of the campus is devoted to the 280-acre Schmeckle Reserve, a great spot to explore nature. The reserve offers five miles of trails, a visitor center, and the **Wisconsin Conservation Hall of Fame**.

### WHERE'S THE BEST PLACE TO GRAB A BITE ON A BUDGET?

**SP:** “My favorite place to grab a snack and coffee would either be **Basement Brewhaus** or **Zest Bakery**, which is just off campus.”

Visiting campus can work up an appetite. In the **Dreyfus University Center**, check out Basement Brewhaus, which doubles as a coffee shop and bar, with an array of coffee drinks, beer, and wine. For a meal on wheels, check out **Stevie's Food Truck!** Most commonly found at Point Brewery, it has a rotating menu that serves snacks, beverages, or even full-course meals.

### WHAT EVENT DO YOU LOOK FORWARD TO EVERY YEAR?

**SP:** “The **World's Largest Trivia Contest** is a fun, unique event!”

Each year, there is an event that seeks to challenge the minds and endurance of all who dare to play. Hosted by 90FM, UW–Stevens Point's student-run radio station, the

World's Largest Trivia Contest is a 54-hour competition, taking place every April, that keeps players searching for answers. Or check out local trivia nights at **Guu's on Main**, **Graffiti's Sports Pub**, **District 1 Brewing Company**, and more!

### WHAT'S YOUR FAVORITE HIDDEN GEM ON CAMPUS?

**SP:** “The awesome art exhibitions at the **Edna Carlsten Art Gallery!**”

When school is in session, stroll through rotating exhibits at the Edna Carlsten Art Gallery within the **Noel Fine Arts Center**, with work by students and other community artists. Keep enjoying the arts on campus – from music to theater and dance – in **Jenkins Theatre** or **Michelsen Hall** throughout the year.

UW–Stevens Point is also home to “**E Pluribus Unum**,” a massive mural made with over 200,000 individual tiles, on the **Trainer Natural Resources Building**. Another public memorial mural, “**The Ancestors Buried Below Us**,” by Christopher Sweet, features words and imagery to recognize where Native Americans from Ho-Chunk, Menominee, Ojibwe, and Potawatomi were buried on campus grounds before UW–Stevens Point was established. 🌲





## 1 BUTTERCUP THE COW




## 2 THE NEON WALL





# Annual Fests Worth a Visit

Love fun, quirky, and unique events? Here are a few that call the Stevens Point Area home that you won't want to miss.

Learn more about the culture of the Stevens Point Area through immersive events hosted in the region. Plan to attend the popular **AIRO PowWow**, **Juneteenth**, **Portage County Cultural Festival**, **Stevens Point Pride**, and more events held throughout the year.

Want to stay active? **Walk Wisconsin** offers the opportunity to walk a full, half, or quarter marathon along the Green Circle Trail in June.

Want an adventure instead? Check out **PaddleQuest**, a paddling-based challenge that provides new obstacles around every corner. Geared to all skill levels and ages, the event blends canoeing and Comic-Con with a side of conservation.

Potatoes grown in the region (known as the golden sands) are not just your ordinary spuds. At the **Almond Tater Toot** held in July, potatoes, in all their varieties, are the honored guests of the celebration parade.

Get your motor running to attend the Midwest's largest car show, the **Iola Car**

**Show**, hosted in July. For more equipment, don't miss the **Rosholt Thresheree** featuring antique machinery.

In the fall, get in the spirit of the season with Point Brewery's **Pointoberfest**, complete with lederhosen and pints. Just before the festivities begin, the event kicks off with the **Blubber Run**, a 5K fun run that starts at the brewery.

Travel along the nooks and crannies of the Ice Age Trail as it weaves its way through central Wisconsin for the **Hidden Studios Art Tour**. This event features the studios of working artists who open their doors for the public each fall.

See history come alive with **Heritage Days** at the history museum known as Heritage Park, one of four historical sites in the Stevens Point region. 🌲



### FRIDAY EVENING: SLOW DOWN & SETTLE IN

Start your weekend with something truly special: a private sauna session at **Nordic Night Sauna**, tucked into a vacant lot filled with wildflowers. Inside the traditional cedar sauna – powered by a wood-

fired Finnish stove – you'll have the space all to yourself (a minimum of two people and up to eight), with a host nearby tending the fire and ready to guide you if needed.

After your sauna glow, grab dinner from **Point After Pub** or **Arbuckles**, and curl up with a

book from **Bound to Happen Books** for a cozy night in.

If you're visiting from out of town, book a stay at **The Inn at SentryWorld**, a boutique hotel perched on the championship golf course's 18th fairway. The rooms are as comfortable as they are charming, and the

outfitter shop in the lobby rents bikes, fishing poles, cross-country skis, and snowshoes, depending on the season.

### SATURDAY: DOWNTOWN, NATURE, AND ICE CREAM

**Morning and Afternoon:** Start your day with a latte from **Ruby Coffee Roasters**, then follow

the irresistible aroma next door to **Father Fats Public House**. On Saturday mornings, Chef C's Om Noms food truck dishes out brunch favorites; by night, Father Fats transforms into a small-plates haven with global flavors rooted in local ingredients.

From there, wander the **Stevens Point Farmers Market** on the square, then pop into some downtown shops: **PROCESS**, **Fall Line Outfitters**, **Gepetto's Workshop**, **Bound to Happen Books**, and **Turquoise on Main**. Don't skip a self-guided mural scavenger hunt or a stroll through **Pfiffner Park** to see the lamppost art installations along the **Wisconsin River**.

The **Stevens Point Sculpture Park** blends 20 acres of wooded trails with artwork from local, regional, and national artists. It's an outdoor gallery like no other. Then head south to Plover for the **Food + Farm Exploration Center**, an interactive hub

with more than 60 exhibits, a cafe and even the world's largest potato masher.

From the center, you can walk the trail to Lake Pacawa Park, where you'll find an ADA-compliant playground, splash pad, story walk, and miles of walking paths.

**Evening:** End the day the Stevens Point way — with a stop at **King Cone**. The handmade flavors (including several award winners) make it impossible to choose just one scoop.

### SUNDAY: A RELAXED WRAP-UP

Keep Sunday simple. Stroll through **Schmeckle Reserve**, a serene escape filled with trails, boardwalks, and wildlife. Then depending on your appetite, you have two stellar brunch options. You can brunch on the farm at **Lonely Oak Farm** in Milladore or enjoy a cocktail-infused brunch at **Knowlton House Distillery** in nearby Mosinee. 🍷

If you're looking for some of Wisconsin's best beer, head to **Central Waters Brewing & Distilling**, which is known for its bourbon barrel-aged beers, in Amherst.

Take a seat in **District 1 Brewing Company's** modern taproom with a huge tap list, from lagers to stouts, and pair its sips with pinball or a board game.

Don't miss **Sunset Point Winery** located in downtown Stevens Point. Take a tour where you'll get to go behind the scenes, and get a souvenir glass and wine-tasting flight.

Next, head to **Great Northern Distilling** and its upscale mixology bar! The cocktails are crafted to perfection and ready to impress.

Don't skip **Honey Bee Good Meadery**! Inside, learn more about the buzz around mead, fermented with local honey, and grab a sample while you're there!

Covering more than 800 square miles in central Wisconsin and dotted with small communities, most of Portage County is rural with year-round recreational opportunities. Uncover the vibe of our communities, then venture out to see them for yourself!*

## STEVENS POINT

When Stevens Point was founded in 1858, it was a community of loggers, fur traders, and brewers. Known for outstanding beer, a surplus of public murals, and a strong connection to outdoor recreation, here you'll find one of Wisconsin's oldest **farmers markets** (still held in the same location) and **Point Brewery** – a staple since 1857. Whether you're exploring the **Green Circle Trail**, golfing **SentryWorld**, or paddling the backwaters and sloughs of the **Wisconsin River**, adventure is calling your name. **UW-Stevens Point** is also a community gem – the 400-acre campus includes popular spots like the **Wisconsin Conservation Hall of Fame**, **Schmeckle Reserve**, **Edna Carlsen Art Gallery**, and **Allen F. Blocher Planetarium**.

## NELSONVILLE

A seven-minute drive from downtown Amherst, Nelsonville is a small but mighty village nestled along the **Tomorrow River**. Whether you're an angler or a paddler, the Tomorrow River is a narrow and intimate stream that features crystal-clear water, a nice current, a couple of boulders to dodge, and a sense of solitude. In Nelsonville, you'll find the **Rising Star Mill** – a well-maintained gristmill originally built in 1868 – as well as the world headquarters and main roastery for **Ruby Coffee Roasters!**

## PLOVER

Explore Plover, a vibrant community just south of Stevens Point that blends local flavor with small-town charm. Grab a classic Wisconsin supper at the iconic **Sky Club**, known for the first refrigerated salad bar, then treat yourself to a scoop (or two) at **King Cone**, a local favorite for homemade ice cream. Discover the **Food + Farm Exploration Center**, where visitors can dig into the region's agricultural roots through hands-on exhibits, and don't miss the **Colorful Plate Cafe** inside, serving up fresh, seasonal bites and local coffee, no admission ticket required.

## AMHERST

On the banks of the Tomorrow River, you'll find Amherst, a quaint and vibrant community with a strong sense of place. It is home to the **Tomorrow River State Trail**, **Jensen Community Center**, **Central Waters Brewing & Distilling**, **Central Wisconsin Environmental Station**, **Wild West Campground & Corral**, and more. Outdoor recreationalists, take note! There's an abundance of biking routes that connect Amherst to surrounding communities like Plover and Nelsonville, or routes that venture into rural Portage County. Don't miss exploring the bounty of Portage County parks in the region!

## ROSHOLT

Nestled in eastern Portage County, Rosholt is home to the **Wisconsin Lions Camp**, the **Bluegrass in the Pines** music festival, unique locally owned businesses like **Refuah Coffee & Remedies** and **Rustic Raven's Antiques**, the **Rosholt Fair Park** (host to one of two fairs held in the region), and more. Spend a day in Rosholt to experience its charm!

## OTHER GEMS

The countryside in the region is dotted with communities like **Junction City**, **Almond**, **Park Ridge**, and **Whiting**. The rural **Lake DuBay** area in northwestern Portage County offers recreational opportunities, and encompasses most of the townships of **Eau Pleine**, **Hull**, and **Dewey**. Additional municipalities that call Portage County home are **Custer**, **Polonia**, **Buena Vista**, **Lanark**, **Stockton**, **Alban**, and more. 🌲



# Guide to the Green Circle Trail

Ready to explore the Green Circle Trail? This 27-mile, multi-use recreation trail loops around the Stevens Point Area and offers endless opportunities for outdoor fun. Whether you're planning to wander a single segment or take on the whole trail, we've rounded up some of the must-see spots — on and off the path — to help you make the most of your day outside.

## INSTAGRAM-WORTHY VIEWS

Bring your wide-lens camera to **Moses Creek Trail**, where you'll find yourself elevated above the wetlands and surrounded by towering white pines on the longest boardwalk of the Green Circle Trail. The winding wooden path is as photogenic as it is peaceful, making it one of the most memorable stops along the route.

For more breathtaking views, head to the **Plover River Segment**. Here the trail's longest footbridge stretches across the river, offering sweeping panoramas in every direction and the perfect spot to pause for a photo. Continue your journey on **Whiting Crossing Trail** where wooded paths lead you through Mainland Meadows before opening up to sweeping river overlooks.

Don't miss the **Stagecoach Trail** where views of the stunning Wisconsin River unfold along a route rich in natural beauty and history. Whether you're snapping photos or simply soaking it all in, these segments showcase some of the most picturesque corners of the Green Circle Trail.

## WILDLIFE SIGHTINGS

The Green Circle Trail meanders through **Schmeckle Reserve**, a 280-acre natural conservancy area located on the UW-Stevens

Point campus. This segment, known as **University Trail**, is home to numerous wildlife species. It's likely you'll see deer along the trail so have your camera ready! Hike the one-acre loop around **Lake Joanis** for a chance of spotting geese, ducks, or painted turtles. Great opportunities for birdwatching also await in Schmeckle Reserve, with a 218-species bird list. Another hotspot for birdwatching is along the **Paper Mill Trail**, where you can see waterfowl year-round.

## LOCAL FLAVOR

Every adventure deserves a good break and the Green Circle Trail is never far from tasty options. Near University Trail, **Rock 'N' Roll Cafe** is a local favorite, whether you are craving coffee, ice cream, or a hearty bite to refuel. Cool off with a legendary cone at **Belts' Soft Serve** or swing by **Sunflower Cafe** for a fresh and flavorful stop just off **River Pines Trail**. If a glass of wine sounds more your speed, **Sunset Point Winery** pairs cozy charm with beautiful views and is perfect for toasting a day well spent on the trail.

The best part? Many of these spots are just steps from downtown, making it easy to pair a trail outing with shopping, murals, and riverfront views. Don't overlook **Iverson Park Trail**, where wooded paths and family-friendly

spaces connect you to even more local flavor. Nearby, **Hilltop Pub & Grill** is a community staple, perfect for burgers, brews, and a laidback bite before or after your trek.

## HIDDEN ART

Don't miss the opportunity to capture local art. Along **Riverfront Trail**, find unique light poles, which were turned into sculptures, that celebrate the character of the area. Tucked under the County Road HH bridge, where the **Westside Loop** breaks off to cross the Wisconsin River, you'll find a mural of Cuban-American-French writer Anais Nin.

Not quite as hidden is the **To the Point sculpture**, a large metal piece designed by local artist Boleslaw Kochanowski that welcomes people to town.

Speaking of sculptures, **Brickyard Trail** offers access to the **Stevens Point Sculpture Park**. With outdoor artwork from local, regional, and national artists, it is a favorite spot connecting to the Green Circle Trail. 🌲

## Paddle Guide

From beginner to advanced paddlers, the region has a variety of options to choose from. Not sure where to start? Canoe or kayak **Lake Joanis** in Schmeckle Reserve near UW-Stevens Point, which is perfect for beginners. Explore **McDill Pond** — part of the **Plover River Flowage** — and the expansive range of wildlife nearby. Or wind along with the crystal-clear **Tomorrow River**, tucked in the gentle hills of central Wisconsin. View a variety of paddling options along the Blue Heron Island Loop, taking in the scenery and wildlife.

If standup paddleboarding is more your style, venture out to **Jordan County Park**, featuring a 24-acre pond with glassy water surrounded by lush forests. Or visit **Sunset Lake**, known for its clear, pristine water. To immerse yourself in nature, view local birds at **McDill**

**Pond.** Explore the lower section of the pond by starting at **Lower Whiting Park** or venture through the upper portion at **Kozickowski Park**. For paddling and a picnic, find a sandy beach at **Lake Emily**. This 96-acre tranquil spot is great to spend the whole day on or near the water.

Not a paddler? Opt for a tube!

The **Tomorrow River** is perfect for a gentle tube ride. The best tubing routes skip the pond. Put in at Otto Road and take out at County Road DD for a memorable trip.



# On the Line

Looking for a true Wisconsin fishing experience? We've got you covered with what to expect on the Stevens Point Flowage of the Wisconsin River and beyond!

The Stevens Point Area offers some exceptionally diverse fishing for multiple freshwater species. Running along downtown Stevens Point, the **Wisconsin River** provides fantastic fishing for walleye, smallmouth bass and musky. Mix in good populations of bluegill, crappie, largemouth bass, northern pike, and sturgeon, and you find yourself in an angler's paradise.

The Stevens Point stretch of the Wisconsin River flows roughly 12 miles and can be broken into three major sections. The upstream portion, from the **Lake DuBay Dam** downstream to the Highway 10 bridge, provides classic river fishing focused mostly on current, rock, and shoreline wood.

As you head south from the Highway 10 bridge, the river deltas into numerous secondary channels, creating a maze of islands that allows anglers to fish almost any imaginable way, while feeling like they are in a pristine wilderness area far from civilization. All these channels eventually flow into the lower basin of the **Stevens Point Flowage**, which looks and fishes more like a natural lake. Much of this area is surrounded by city parks and provides excellent shore-fishing opportunities.

The Wisconsin River is not the only hotspot in the area. Other nearby waters that provide great fishing and boating opportunities



include **Lake DuBay, Biron Flowage, McDill Pond, Plover River, and Tomorrow River**. All these waters are located only a few minutes from downtown Stevens Point and provide anglers with the opportunity to chase everything from brook trout to musky!

# Take a Hike

Whether you lace up or roll out, here's a guide to trails worth trekking in the Stevens Point Area.

## GREEN CIRCLE TRAIL

The popular 27-mile Green Circle Trail offers 12 segments to explore year-round. With plenty of paths to choose, linking scenic natural areas, along the Wisconsin and Plover rivers, through towering cathedral canopies, parks and wetlands — here are a few suggestions to start.

### Brickyard Trail

**Length:** 1.2 miles

**Surface:** Crushed granite, some sidewalk

**Activities:** Hiking, jogging, biking, pets, snowshoeing

**Parking:** Zenoff Park (west) and Schmeeckle Reserve Visitor Center (east) parking lots

The Brickyard Trail travels through a forested area, following a small stream and along meadows. Make a detour and extend the journey by half a mile to explore the Stevens Point Sculpture Park.

### Moses Creek Trail

**Length:** 2.4 miles

**Surface:** Crushed granite, boardwalks

**Activities:** Hiking, jogging, biking, pets

**Parking:** Wilshire Dr. (west) and Hwy. 66 Plover River Trail (east) parking lots

Head to Moses Creek to walk or ride on the longest boardwalk in the Green Circle. Then keep exploring the segment as it meanders through woodlands and pristine sedge meadows, perfect for wildlife watching.

### Plover River Trail

**Length:** 3.6 miles

**Surface:** Crushed granite

**Activities:** Hiking, jogging, biking, pets, cross-country skiing

**Parking:** Hwy. 66 parking lot (north) and at the end of Hofmeister Dr. (south)

The scenic Plover River Trail spans from Hwy. 66 (north) to Hofmeister Dr. (south). The towering trees, flowing water, and ample wildlife — and not a single road crossing — make this trail a favorite.

## ICE AGE TRAIL – New Hope-Iola Segment

**Length:** 5.5 miles **Surface:** Natural

**Activities:** Hiking, snowshoeing

**Parking:** 10651 County Rd. Z, Amherst Junction

Make your way through one of the largest and least disturbed dry-mesic forests in the region. Tackle a section of this expansive 1,000-mile footpath as it winds through eastern Portage County, linking history, cultures, and geological features.

## LAKE EMILY TO CUSTER ROAD

**Length:** 10.2 miles **Surface:** Crushed limestone

**Activities:** Hiking, biking, snowmobiling, horseback riding, pets

**Parking:** Lake Emily County Park, Amherst Junction

Start at Lake Emily to explore the 5.1-mile, one-way section of this popular crushed limestone trail, then head west toward the trailhead at Custer Rd. Along the way, enjoy serene country views. Passes are required.

## SCHMEECKLE RESERVE – Lake Loop Trail

**Length:** 1 mile **Surface:** Crushed granite

**Activities:** Hiking, jogging, biking

**Parking:** Maria Dr. (south) and Schmeeckle Reserve Visitor Center (north)

The Lake Loop Trail is an easy one-mile trail, which loops around Lake Joanis within Schmeeckle Reserve. The trail is handicap accessible, with benches and an accessible fishing pier.

## STANDING ROCKS PARK

**Length:** Varies **Surface:** Natural

**Activities:** Hiking, biking, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, pets

**Parking:** 7695 Standing Rocks Rd., Stevens Point

Boulders and gorgeous — but challenging — hills are common sights here, known as one of the best spots for mountain biking trails in Wisconsin. But don't stop there! The park offers plenty of other options, including hiking, snowshoeing, downhill skiing, and a dog park.

## STEINHAUGEN RECREATION AREA

**Length:** 4.3 miles **Surface:** Natural

**Activities:** Hiking, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, pets

**Parking:** 3485 Bentley Rd., Custer

Steinhaugen Recreation Area has 270 acres to explore, featuring a diverse mix of wetlands, upland hardwood forests, pines, and open fields, for silent sports throughout the year.

## TOMORROW RIVER STATE TRAIL

**Length:** 29 miles **Surface:** Crushed stone

**Activities:** Hiking, biking, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, horseback riding, pets

**Parking:** Twin Towers Rd., Cate Park, Hwy. 49

Don't overlook this expansive rails-to-trails option. Tomorrow River State Trail spans 29 miles as it cuts through the rural landscape in central Wisconsin. It is open all year-round to outdoor enthusiasts who enjoy everything from biking to horseback riding. 🏇

## WINTER

➔ **One Hour:** Visit the **Iverson Park Winter Sports Area** (complete with a warming house and hot cocoa) to snowshoe along the Plover River or hit the family-friendly sledding hills.

Skating rinks can be found throughout the area (weather permitting), including the rink in downtown Stevens Point. Beginners can check out **K.B. Willett Ice Arena** for open skating times and rentals.

**One Day:** Head out to **Standing Rocks Park** for snowshoeing, fat-tire biking, and downhill or cross-country skiing.

Start near Behnke Olson Outdoor Recreation Center and hit the trails – including a lighted loop. Rentals are available.

Call 715-824-7250 for conditions.

## SPRING

➔ **One Hour:** Arm yourself with a local birding guide and a pair of binoculars before heading over to the **Godfrey & Maybelle Erickson Natural Area**.

The 5.5-acre park is known for birding with more than 170 species documented. Explore the half-mile trail, which is part of the larger **Birding Trail** on the **Green Circle**, or venture out on the trails at **Schmeckle Reserve**.

**One Day:** Make a day of it! Enjoy a picnic before you start for the water or take a hike. Spend some time at **Mead Park**, home to the **Kids Are Special Here (K.A.S.H.) Playground**, perfect for families to explore.

Then, head north to hike the **Rocky Run Spillway** that runs along the Wisconsin River.

## SUMMER

➔ **One Hour:** Cast a line in the **Wisconsin River**, from expansive **Lake DuBay** to the backwaters and sloughs full of musky, channel catfish, northern pike, and panfish. No boat? No problem. Shoreline fishing is abundant at **Jordan Pond** and **Lake Joanis**. More options include the **Stevens Point Flowage** (off Highway HH W), **River-in-Between Flowage** (off W. River Drive), and **Lake Emily**.

**One Day:** Explore the natural habitats and trails within the 33,000-acre **George W. Mead Wildlife Area**. The wildlife area is one of the largest in the state with over 80 miles of trails to explore. For more adventure, bike some of Wisconsin's best mountain biking trails at **Standing Rocks Park** with a mix of flow and single-track trails.

## FALL

➔ **One Hour:** Get in the saddle and try horseback riding in Wisconsin. Trail rides are amazing on the 90-acre **Wild West Campground & Corral** in eastern Portage County.

**One Day:** Hit the road and enjoy some seasonal leaf peeping.

Many of the rural areas in Portage County offer spectacular viewing of the fall colors. To experience the best that the region has to offer, try a car tour of northern Portage County.

Don't miss more fall fun, including pumpkin patches, corn mazes, and fresh cheese curds, with a stop at **Feltz's Dairy Store** or **Mullins Cheese**. 🌲

# Antique Finds

Uncover history through antiquing in the Stevens Point Area, where vintage finds tell the story of local brewing, farming, and outdoor traditions that shaped the region.

The area's rich history is alive in attractions like the **Rising Star Mill** in Nelsonville, which dates back to 1855, or the **Beth Israel Synagogue** in Stevens Point, established in 1905. Other places to check out include Plover's **Heritage Park**, which explores Portage County's history with restored buildings from the past, and the **Historic Firehouse No. 2 Museum**, which preserves the firefighting history of Stevens Point.

Step through the doors of a local vintage consignment or antique store in the Stevens Point Area and, chances are, you'll also find an item rooted in local history. While the stock is never guaranteed in this setting, the following pieces are common finds.

The influence of Wisconsin's beer culture is apparent at most antique stores, where you'll find wooden crates, bottles, and faded vintage cans that were once used to haul, store, and drink locally brewed beer. According to the Wisconsin Historical Society, by the 1890s, nearly every community had at least one brewery. When Prohibition changed the landscape, many of the breweries went out of business and, locally, only **Stevens Point Brewery** survived.

Driving through the Stevens Point Area, agriculture is on full display with fields, barns, and livestock dictating the rural landscape. Influenced by Wisconsin's farming roots, you'll commonly see agricultural nods in antique stores – from wagon wheels and hay bale hooks to milk cans and vintage potato planters. For more context about agricultural history, don't miss the exhibit at Heritage Park.

In one of Stevens Point's oldest parks, **Iverson Park**, there was once a 40-foot-high ski jump built in the 1930s, near where the toboggan runs stand now. The love for the outdoors runs deep in Wisconsin, which should be no surprise in a state that values natural resources. Vintage finds connected to outdoor recreation are common while antiquing here, too. Discover vintage fishing gear, metal roller skates, hand-laced snowshoes, skis, and more. 🌲
