

July 2024

July 2024 showed increased paid occupancy over the past several years. Several key events drew visitors in July, including the July 4 parade and holiday offerings, Art in the Park, Tour de Steamboat, and the Yampa Valley Balloon Rodeo.

July saw the first year-over-year increase in paid occupancy since April 2024. Several months have seen an increase in owner or unpaid stays, which may result in increases in total (paid & owner) occupancy, but don't contribute to accommodations tax or STR collections.

The data in the following tabs reflects the most current data as of August 1, 2024. Some data takes two-three months to populate.


