

Local banks secure \$60 Million in PPP loans for Routt County businesses

Steamboat Springs, Colorado – April 22, 2020 – The Steamboat Springs Chamber has worked continuously with local banks to educate and provide resources to the business community during the COVID-19 pandemic. These resources have included the Paycheck Protection Program loans available to businesses that the banks have worked tirelessly on processing for local businesses.

These efforts have led to Yampa Valley Bank, Alpine Bank, Vectra Bank, and Mountain Valley Bank filing over 800 Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) applications for businesses and bringing in \$62MM of relief into Routt County.

"Many of us had staff that were working 16-hour days, 7 days a week to ensure our County received its fair share of the program, fulfilling the CARES Act spirit and intent," says Wade Gebhardt, Corporate President, Mountain Valley Bank. "That is the value community banks provide to the social and economic fabric of our community."

Routt County is a huge beneficiary of the PPP program and that is thanks to the community banks and bankers that continue to work tirelessly to ensure the health and vitality of local businesses and workforce.

The Paycheck Protection Program has been replenished and the Small Business Association (SBA) is currently accepting new applications for the PPP. For those who may have missed the first round of PPP loans, now is the time to work with your local bank to prepare your application.
