



Important Notification

Attention:

One of the employees from your establishment has tested positive for COVID-19. It is important for the outlined steps to be taken immediately to mitigate spread of COVID-19. The establishment will need to follow the sick employee and cleaning guidance outlined in this CDC document:

If you/your staff came in close contact (defined by the CDC as less than 6 feet for prolonged period of 15 minutes or more) with this employee it is important that you/your staff self-quarantine for 14 days. If you/they develop symptoms, contact your/their healthcare provider by calling ahead. Please notify your/their healthcare provider when contacting them that you/they have been exposed to the COVID-19 virus. It is also strongly recommended that employees at your establishment are tested for COVID-19.

Some individuals may not experience symptoms or very mild symptoms with COVID-19, however, higher risk people risk getting very sick from COVID-19 including: older people (over the age of 60), especially those over the age of 80; people who have chronic medical conditions like heart, lung, or kidney disease or diabetes and older people with chronic medical medications are at the highest risk.
