The restaurant industry work group continue to meet weekly and work on your behalf.

I have a few updates to share.

Postings –In contrast to prior communications, the County would like for restaurants to post the Variance (attached), preferably on the door or window near the entrance or if that’s not feasible in a visible location for both employees and patrons.

To-go Alcohol Online Orders – See attached an update on online orders for to-go alcohol and the food requirements that accompany online orders.

Open Containers - See attached two maps of open container areas and hours in which it is allowed. Please help to clearly communicate with your customers the boundaries and timeframes.

Sidewalks - Reminder that maintaining 6’ of clearance is important so the public has safe access along our sidewalks.

Performances – Below are links to state guidelines on events. Note the current CDPHE Variance for Routt County restaurants prohibits live music. The indoor and outdoor event guidance from the state would not apply the Routt County Retail Food Establishments at this time.
