**GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS**

- P-12 Schools**  
In-person, hybrid, or remote as appropriate
- Higher Education**  
In-person, hybrid, or remote as appropriate
- Places of Worship**  
INDOORS: Unseated: 50%, 50 people without calculator; up to 100 with calculator; Seated: 50%, 100 people  
OUTDOORS: 6ft between parties per local zoning
- Restaurants**  
INDOORS: 50% capacity or 50 people for up to 100 with calculator  
OUTDOORS: 6ft between parties outdoors, per local zoning
- Offices**  
50% capacity
- Bars**  
Closed
- Gyms/Fitness**  
25% capacity or 50 people
- Group Sports**  
25 person cap per activity
- Retail**  
50% capacity
- Personal Services**  
50% capacity or 50 people
- Indoor Events**  
Unseated: 50%, 50 without calculator or up to 100 with calculator  
Seated: 50%, 100 people
- Outdoor Events**  
Unseated: 50%, 175 people with calculator  
Seated: 50%, 175 people with 6ft distancing
- Outdoor Guided Services**  
50% capacity or 10 people

**LEVEL YELLOW / SAFER AT HOME  
CONCERN**

**Does your county qualify for this level?**

<b>≤10%</b> 10% positivity rates or less	The percent positivity is defined as the percent of tests that come back positive, out of the total number of tests performed. The global standard to ensure that we are doing enough testing is a percent positivity of less than 5%.
<b>75-175</b> cases per <b>100,000</b>	The 2-week incidence, per 100,000 population, helps us understand how much the virus is circulating in a community. This is the number of cases for every 100,000 people in the past two weeks.
<b>No more than 2 NEW</b> Covid-19 hospital admissions per day	One of our key goals is to ensure that every person who needs hospital care can receive it. This metric ensures that there is sufficient hospital capacity available. Stable is defined as no greater than a 25% increase in the county's referral hospitals or no more than 2 new hospital admissions with COVID-19 on a single day, in the past 14 days.
