Executive Director Laci Laperouse and Commissioners welcomed Mike and Keisha LeBlanc, Owners of the Duchamp Opera House. Mr. LeBlanc shared with us his upbringing, including details about where he was born and raised, and educational history. He gave us the history of the Opera House and the Carriage House Suite, and his plans to have more short-term rental property upstairs. The Opera House was built in 1830 and is the oldest surviving opera house in the country and one of the oldest buildings in the south.

Executive Director Laci Laperouse informed the Commissioners that they need to complete Ethics and Sexual Harassment Training before December 31st and reminded them that they must complete and file their Financial Disclosure Report before May 31st for the prior year.
