ACTIVITIES

EVANGELINE OAK PARK (30 MIN.)

The park centers on an ancient live oak tree on the Bayou Teche that has been the most visited spot in St. Martinville since the late 19th century.

ST. MARTINVILLE CULTURAL HERITAGE CENTER (45 MIN.)

Houses the African American Museum and the Museum of the Acadian Memorial. The museums illustrate the uprooting of people who helped found Louisiana. It is also home to the Heritage Acadian Odyssey Quilt.

ACADIAN MEMORIAL (30 MIN.)

The Memorial honors the 3,000 Acadian exiles who found refuge in Louisiana. View the 30 ft. mural, the Wall of Names, and the courtyard that houses the Eternal Flame and the Deportation Cross.

HISTORIC TOWN SQUARE (30 MIN.)

Historic area which is home to the St. Martin de Tours Catholic Church, one of the oldest Catholic Churches in Louisiana, and the tomb/statue of Evangeline. Guided tours are available.

DUCHAMP OPERA HOUSE (10 MIN.)

Built in 1830, it's the oldest opera house in the country. Now it serves as an event space and short-term rental. Scan the QR code on the building and take a virtual tour.

LONGFELLOW-EVANGELINE STATE HISTORIC SITE (1-2 HOURS)

Explore the cultural interplay among the diverse people along the famed Bayou Teche.
