#### 4) EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT - Annie Wise, Executive Director

- a) **Presentation Overview**: Annie Wise, Executive Director of Sunshine Coast Tourism, delivered a detailed update on the organization's achievements, challenges, and strategic priorities for 2024 and beyond, emphasizing the importance of collaboration among stakeholders to achieve collective success.
- b) **Key Achievements Highlighted**: Annie reviewed the success of the "It's Time to Shine" campaign, reporting over 660,000 unique website visitors, 280,000 direct business referrals, and significant media exposure, including features in major outlets like *The New York Times* and *Outside Magazine*.
- c) Research and New Initiatives: Annie announced the completion of the Sunshine Coast Visitor Study, which provides updated insights into visitor behaviour and volume, and introduced the new "Spark" Mentorships & Grants Program to foster innovative tourism ideas in the region.
- d) Call to Action: Annie concluded with a call for unified action among businesses, residents, and visitors to collaboratively steward the environment, enhance residents' quality of life, and strengthen the Sunshine Coast's position as a sustainable and thriving tourism destination.
