FOLLOW THESE DIRECTIONS: From Saltery Bay Ferry, take Hwy. 101 to downtown city core of Powell River. The Hwy turns into Marine Ave. Follow Marine through downtown, turn right at Alberni St. Turn left on Manson Ave. and then right on Cassiar St. Cassiar Street veers left and turns into Yukon Street. Stay on Yukon until you reach Haslam Street, and turn right on Haslam. Follow Haslam and veer left on Inland Lake Rd. Continue on gravel road and follow the signs to reach the park.
