

# NORTHERN SUNSHINE COAST SALTERY BAY TO LUND



## POWELL RIVER

Located on the traditional territory of the Tla'amin Nation, the Powell River region is a cycling favourite with smooth roads and ocean views. Outdoor adventure, water based exploration, and relaxing coastal days are easily achieved on two wheels with amenities never far away. Follow Marine Avenue as it parallels the ocean offering unique views of this coastal community. Once you arrive, you'll find art galleries, unique dining, fantastic coffee, and a cycling scene that locals are proud to share.

## TOWNSITE & LUND

Over 400 buildings remain intact from the 1910 plan for Powell River Townsite, including the Patricia Theatre and the post office,

which is now home to Townsite Brewing! Stop in at Townsite Market and visit local vendors, or simply tour the town and learn about its rich history. Continuing up the winding highway you'll find the northernmost town of Lund - Mile 0 of Highway 101. Reward yourself with a bite to eat and enjoy the views from a patio at the entrance to Desolation Sound, the Copeland Islands, Okeover Inlet, the Sunshine Coast Trail, and Savary Island.

## INLAND LAKE

Inland Lake Provincial Park is located 12 km north of Powell River and is ideal for hiking, camping, swimming, cycling, fishing, canoeing and more. A fully accessible, crushed limestone path with boardwalks and bridges loops 13 km around the entire lake

and is ideal for cyclists. Make sure to take a break at the hand-crafted park benches and picnic tables to capture the view and fuel up or rest your legs and relax.

## TEXADA ISLAND

Texada is the largest of BC's Gulf Islands and offers long, smooth roads gently winding toward viewpoints and ocean beaches for a perfect rest stop. Affectionately known as "The Rock" by its friendly residents, it has an abundance of trails, wonderful marine bays and coves, ten lakes to cool-off, and is home to Shelter Point Regional Park - a unique campground surrounded by ocean and forest. Cozy up in a quaint island cabin, grab a bite to eat, and soak in Texada's chill vibes.

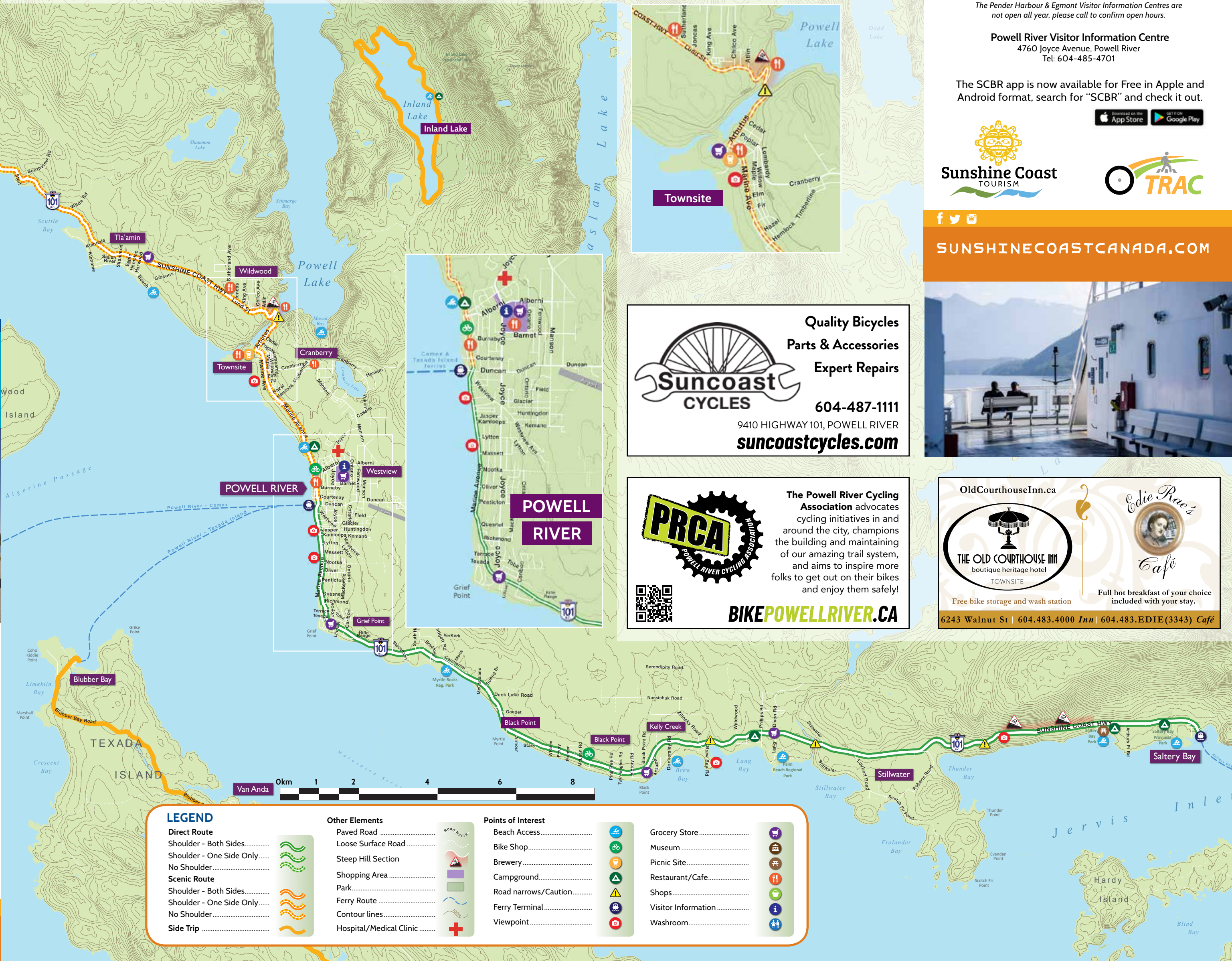

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## ROBERTS CREEK

DAVIS BAY

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27km past the Langdale ferry terminal, Highway 101 leads you into the seaside town of Sechart. Home to the the shishalh Nation, this artisan community sits on a sandbar and can serve as a central hub for exploring the southern Sunshine Coast. As laid-back as it is scenic, Cowrie Street runs through the centre of downtown and is host to local coffee shops, brunch spots, boutiques and galleries, providing the perfect excuse to spend time getting to know the community. Whether you're passing through or it's your final destination, it's the perfect place for outdoor explorations such as paddling, hiking or simply enjoying a day on the beach.

## HALFMOON BAY

Halfmoon Bay boasts some of the most stunning coastline and beach access points. Make sure to stop at Sargeant Bay Provincial Park, Welcome Beach, Coopers Green and Halfmoon Bay General Store; all accessed via Redroofs Road - a far more scenic stretch that parallels the highway. Up for a hike? Smuggler Cove Marine Provincial Park is a local and visitor favourite!

## PENDER HARBOUR


The small communities of Madeira Park and Garden Bay wrap themselves around this water-centric region known as Pender Harbour. Smooth roads around smaller bays give a tour-like feel to these communities which offer the perfect place for an overnight or two. Take a detour and enjoy a refreshing dip in one of the five freshwater lakes, or arrange for a spa treatment to refresh your body and soul before continuing your cycling tour.


## EGMONT

Gateway to the Skookumchuck Narrows Provincial Park, Egmont is the perfect place to rest and recuperate . Choose from accommodations including a campground, luxury resort, an A-frame cabin or geodesic dome - all with delicious food close by.
