



## City of Huntington Beach Film, Video and Still Photography Permit Fees 2022

**APPLICATION SUBMITTAL CHARGE:**

\$159.00 Government projects and same-day breaking news are exempted.  
 \$ 50.00 Student Project with verification.

**BUSINESS LICENSE FEE:**

\$129.88 Required of all commercial agencies filming on public or private property.  
 Solicitation, including prompted interviews and potential modeling videotaping is NOT PERMITTED

**PERMIT ISSUANCE CHARGES:**

Exemptions from daily fees include, student course work with instructor verification, government agencies, and same day "breaking" news.

### ADDITIONAL PERMITTING FEES

<b>Fee</b>	<b>Details/When Required</b>	<b>Amount</b>
<b>Marine Safety Officer</b>	Filming in water Driving on sand or beach path Obstructing public access to beach space Filming on the Pier	\$96 per hour per officer +1 hour (i.e. 2 hour reservation is charge for 3 hours)
<b>Police Officer</b>	Driving shots (as needed) Fight scenes Road closures (as needed) Large, attract set pieces, pyrotechnics, etc.	\$96 per hour per officer
<b>Beach Parking Spaces</b>	When reserving parking at the beach	\$15/day per space
<b>Application of Parking Restrictions</b>	Used when marking off "No Parking areas on street	\$140
<b>Location Use Fee</b>	When filming on public points of interest: beach space, Central Park, Pier, Library, etc.	Determined on case by case basis by scope of permit
