SEA

- **Beach Volleyball** - If you'd rather run, jump, and dive across the sand, try your hand at one of HB's most popular sports: beach volleyball.
 - There are nearly two dozen nets on either side of the **Huntington Beach Pier**, with more at **Huntington State Beach** to the south and **Bolsa Chica State Beach** to the north.
 - The nets are free to use and available on a first-come, first-served basis, while balls are available for rent at beach concessionaires.

PATH

Experience the Huntington Beach coast from the 8-mile-long paved beach path, whether you prefer to cruise atop a bike seat, roller skates, or on your own two feet.

PARK

Fortunately, Huntington Central Park is just five miles from the beach and sprawls a whopping 350-acres. The largest city-owned park in Orange County, the park is home to paved paths, dirt trails, and a whole slew of amenities, including playgrounds, picnic areas, and a dog park.

- **Disc Golf** - The disc golf course in Central Park is among the most popular in Orange County. The 15-acre plot is the second oldest disc golf course in the world and is considered among the most beautiful and challenging courses in Southern California. The course is open daily and welcomes all players regardless of skill level!
- **Huntington Central Park Equestrian Center** - A true hidden gem within Huntington Central Park is the Equestrian Center, also known as HCPEC, where more than 150 acres of scenic trails are open for the public to explore from atop a four-legged friend. You can take lessons, learn training and riding skills, and experience a unique style of horseback riding just two miles from the ocean.
- **Vans Skate Park** - Vans Skate Park, located behind Bella Terra and next to Old World Village, is a 42,500-square-foot park that's free to the public with nearly three acres of ramps, bowls, and stairs to skate.
