Mexican favorites such as tacos, carne asada, skirt steak asada, ancho chile chicken, oak-roasted chipotle chicken, house carnitas, red chile borracho beef, and wood-grilled wild fish are prepared in an open oak-fired grill and smoker for original flavor.
- **Kathy May's Lakeview Cafe** - Kathy May's serves the best quality food in the beautiful surroundings of Lake Huntington in Central Park. Enjoy your meal inside the restaurant or outside on the patio while taking in the scenic views. Or take your meal to-go and enjoy a picnic in the park. The menu offers a variety of omelets, salads, sandwiches & wraps, burgers, pasta, soups, and many options of delicious desserts.

What to Do

What to Do

 - Huntington City Beach, Huntington State Beach, and Bolsa Chica State Beach all have bonfire pits on them - they are free to use and available on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - **The Huntington Beach House** on Huntington State Beach also offers an exclusive bonfire pit with food and bar access.
 - Enjoy a private firepit experience at the **Hyatt Regency Huntington Beach**, where they offer rooms with private patio pits.
 - **The Waterfront Beach Resort** gives you the option of a firepit by the pool, courtesy of Driftwood Beach Club, or on the beach with Waterfront Adventures.
