Ride along Penns Creek

Start at Bucknell University

Parking: At traffic light on Rt. 15, turn into Bucknell University Campus. At .1 mile, there is a wooden pedestrian bridge to your L. Park nearby.

- 0.0 Cross wooden bridge and bear L to tunnel under Rt. 15. Turn L at end of tunnel.
- 0.3 Turn R and go to stop sign.
- 1.0 L at stop sign onto Hardscrabble Rd.
- 1.2 R onto Jonathan Rd.
- 1.5 R onto Stein Ln, then quick L onto Pheasant Ridge Rd.
- 3.7 L at T and go to stop sign.
- 3.8 L onto Salem Church Rd.
- 4.8 R at T onto Furnace Rd.
- 6.9 L onto Ridge Rd, then curve R.
- 8.4 Straight onto Tower Rd.
- 9.2 Bear L at intersection with Brouse Rd.
- 9.8 Bear R on Tower Rd.
- 11.6 L at T onto State Rt 304.
- 12.3 R onto Zimmerman Rd, bearR at bottom of hill; crossbridge.
- 13.6 R at T onto Wildwood Rd.
- 14.3 Cross St Rt 104; Penns CreekPottery is across the bridge.Go straight on Penns CreekRd. from there.
- 17.4 R at T onto Boop Rd.
- 17.8 L at T onto 3004; continue straight until arrive at covered bridge.

- 20.6 Arrive at Red Covered Bridge. (Return to the last intersection you passed.)
- 21.4 L on Road 3003; enter Millmont. Go straight towards Hartleton.
- 23.2 R onto Route 45; quick left onto Cold Run Road (later becomes Grand Valley Rd.) Curve R, and then L, to stay On Grand Valley Rd.
- 27.1 R at T onto N. 8th Street. Cross Creek & then Rt. 45.
- 30.8 Turn L onto Market Street.
- 31.7 R onto East St., L on Maple St. (turns into Furnace Rd.)
- 37.3 L onto Salem Church Road.
- 38.3 R onto Pheasant Ridge Rd. L at Y onto Smoketown Rd. Great downhill coming!
- 40.3 L at T onto Fairground Road; Cross Rt 45. If it's Wedneday, stop at the Farmers Market!
- 41.0 R at St. Mary's Street.
- 41.7 Cross Route 15.
- 41.8 R on 7th Street at next stop sign.
- 42.0 Cross Market Street.
- 42.4 R on Moore Avenue and return to your car.


