Hello, and thank you for being part of the 2024 unPAved of the Susquehanna River Valley!

We are so looking forward to getting you out on those beautiful farm & forest roads, and seeing your smiling faces back at the DONEpaved Party in Lewisburg. In order to help you get there safe, sound, and happy here are some things to know, and be sure to delve into the details on each at unpavedpennsylvania.com:

- Sign in (with your Picture ID) at the Lewisburg Fall Festival on Saturday or on Sunday morning at the Miller Center or RB Winter (depending on which course you are riding).
- Place your race number for your bike carefully, keeping it flat. The timing chip is on the back of the number and bending or curling your number could cause it to break and then your times will not be read.
- The Lewisburg Fall Festival on Saturday is in downtown Lewisburg, at the Hufnagle Park and along Market Street. The unPAved HQ will be next to Bull Run Taphouse.
- There are different start times (or times for you to start within) and places to start from depending on which ride you are doing:
 - SlumberPARTiers start on Saturday, either from the Miller Center after dropping off their gear or at the SlumberPARTy Send-Off at Noon at the unPAved HQ during the Lewisburg Fall Festival.
 - Big Lick 200 will start at 2:30pm on Saturday at the unPAved Tent during the Lewisburg Fall Festival.
 - unPAved Full-120, Plenty-90, and Proper-50 riders start at the Miller Center on Sunday morning. Do you think you need all day & into the evening to finish? Start early. Want to wait 'til it warms up a little? Start later on. The time frames to start within are on the website.
 - Burly-30 has a remote start & finish at RB Winter State Park, which is a half-hour from Lewisburg. There is a mass-start for the Burly-30 at 10am.
- There are multiple Aid Stations on the routes, and most are not within timed segments. So use them to your advantage by refueling properly, taking care of your bike and body, and connecting with your fellow unPAvers.
- All riders, friends, family, neighbors, and volunteers should join us at the DONEpaved Party at the Miller Center on Sunday afternoon to cheer everyone in, enjoy food & drink, and all riders can win valuable prizes from our sponsors!
- In case of emergency: Call 911 first (if you have coverage), work with fellow riders and moto support, and get the word of the situation to the Aid Station where communications can be established.

Those are some of what you need to know, and there's much more detail to delve into on unpavedpennsylvania.com. Study up because the more you know, the more fun you'll have!
